TODAY'S GAME:

- The Cavaliers look to remain unbeaten on the young season as they visit Arizona
- Virginia is coming off a pair of home wins against Vermont and Howard
- The game is the Cavaliers' first road game and first against a ranked opponent this season

ABOUT THE CAVALIERS (2-0, 0-0 ACC):

- The Cavaliers are 2-0 after a 92-53 victory over Howard on Wednesday
- Sean Singletary had 23 points and eight assists to lead Virginia against the Bison
- 13 different players scored in the game against Howard

ABOUT THE WILDCATS (1-0, 0-0 PAC-10):

- Arizona opened the season with a 76-69 win over Northern Arizona on Tuesday
- Chase Budinger led the Wildcats with 25 points and six rebounds in the victory
- Arizona is ranked No. 17 this week in both the AP and ESPN/USA Today rankings

AGAINST RANKED FOES:

- Tonight's game is the first for Virginia against a ranked opponent this season
- Last year, Virginia had a 4-1 record against teams ranked by The Associated Press
- The Cavaliers were 1-1 against ranked opponents on the road last season, losing 79-69 at No. 1 North Carolina on January 10 and posting a 64-63 win at No. 19 Clemson on January 28

SERIES VS. ARIZONA:

- Fifth ever meeting between the teams with the series tied at 2-2
- This year marks the fourth consecutive season the teams have met, with the home team winning each of the games in the previous three seasons
- Last year Mamadi Diane and Sean Singletary each had 25 points to lead Virginia to a 93-90 win over 10th ranked Arizona in the inaugural game at the John Paul Jones Arena
- In last season's matchup, Arizona led by as many as 19 points in the first half before Virginia rallied in the second half to erase a 13-point halftime deficit

SERIES AGAINST PAC-10

- The Cavaliers are 8-8 against current members of the Pacific-10 Conference (2-2 vs. Arizona, 1-0 vs. Arizona State, 1-5 vs. Stanford, 0-1 vs. UCLA, 1-0 vs. USC, 1-0 vs. Washington, 2-0 vs. Washington State)
- Virginia is looking for its first ever road win against a Pac-10 school (0-4)
- Last year the Cavaliers were 1-1 against Pac-10 schools (93-90 win vs. Arizona, 76-75 loss vs. Stanford)
- Arizona is the only Pac-10 school on Virginia's 2007-08 schedule

LAST TIME OUT:

- Virginia is coming off a 92-53 win against Howard on Wednesday at John Paul Jones Arena
- Sean Singletary had his 28th career 20-point game (23) and eight assists (one shy of his career high)

SPREADING THE WEALTH:

- Against Howard, 13 different Cavaliers scored
- It was the most different players to score in a game for UVa since 14 different players scored in a 93-47 win over Winthrop on December 1, 1990

JOSEPH SHINES AGAINST VERMONT:

- Adrian Joseph led Virginia with 19 points in the season-opening win over Vermont
- He tied career-highs with five 3-point field goals and three assists in the contest
- His 19 points were his most since scoring 19 against Clemson during the 2005-06 season

OFFENSIVE START TO THE SEASON:

- The Cavaliers have scored at least 90 points in their first two games of the season, the first time since the 2000-01 season they have accomplished that feat
- Virginia has never scored at least 90 points in the first three games of a season

SINGLETARY APPROACHING MILESTONE ASSIST:

- Sean Singletary's next assist will be his 400th career assist, becoming the eighth Cavalier to reach the mark
- Singletary enters the game two assists shy of Cory Alexander (401 assists from 1992-95) for seventh on UVa's career list

ABOUT THE SCHEDULE:

- The Cavaliers will play 29 regular season games, including 17 games at home at John Paul Jones Arena
- Of those 29 games, 14 will come against 2007 NCAA Tournament teams
- Additionally, six games will be against teams that were in the 2007 NIT
- 23 games this season will be televised, including 15 of 16 ACC contests

HEAD COACH DAVE LEITAO:

- 2007 ACC Coach of the Year
- First Virginia coach to win the honor since Terry Holland in 1982
- 38-26 record at Virginia, including an 18-14 mark in the ACC
- First Virginia coach to have a winning ACC record over first two seasons as coach

CAVALIERS FIFTH IN PRESEASON ACC POLL:

- UVa was fifth in the preseason ACC poll, voted on by media members at last month's Operation Basketball
- It is the highest the Cavaliers have been in the poll since they were picked fifth in 2002-03

SEAN SINGLETARY RECEIVES PRESEASON ACCOLADES:

- First-team Collegehoops.net preseason All-American
- Third-team CBSsportsline.com preseason All-American
- Colleagueinsider.com preseason All-American
- Top 50 preseason candidate for the John R. Wooden Award
- Preseason Watch List for the Naismith Trophy presented by AT&T
- Bob Cousy Award presented by The Hartford (nation's top point guard) preseason list
- Preseason All-ACC
- No. 4 on Luke Winn's Top 15 Seniors on SI.com

SINGLETARY TOP RETURNING SCORER IN THE ACC:

- Sean Singletary averaged 19.0 points per game last year, which ranked third in the ACC (behind Florida State's Al Thornton and Boston College's Jared Dudley - both first round NBA Draft picks)
- Following Singletary on the ACC returning scorers list are North Carolina's Tyler Hansbrough (18.4) and Boston College's Tyrese Rice (17.6)

DOUBLE FIGURE STREAK FOR SINGLETARY:

- Sean Singletary enters the game having scored in double figures in his last 24 games
- It is the longest active streak in the ACC

STAFF CHANGES FOR 2007-08:

- Drew Diener, UVa's Director of Basketball Operations the last two years, was named Assistant Coach in Sept.
- Replacing Diener as Director of Basketball Operations is Rick Brunson. A former standout at Temple, Brunson played nine seasons in the NBA

SINGLETARY, JOSEPH ARE VIRGINIA'S CAPTAINS:

- Seniors Sean Singletary and Adrian Joseph are co-captains for the 2007-08 season
- Singletary is a captain for the third consecutive year while Joseph is a captain for the first time
- Singletary joins Donald Hand (a captain from 98-99 through 00-01) as the only three-year captains in Virginia history

AT HOME AT JOHN PAUL JONES ARENA:

- Virginia has an all-time record of 18-1 at John Paul Jones Arena
- The Cavaliers posted a 16-1 home record last year in the first season in John Paul Jones Arena
- Virginia was the only ACC team to go undefeated at home in conference play last year (8-0)
- The Cavaliers averaged 13,521 fans per game last year in the debut season at JPJA

BASKETBALL SEATING FIGURE FOR JPJA CHANGES:

- After completing the first year in the John Paul Jones Arena, the Virginia athletics department has made an adjustment to the arena's seating figure for basketball. During the 2006-07 season, several seating areas were altered to accommodate needs within the arena. This led to an overall reduction of seats. These accommodations include seats converted to accessible seating and press tables for the media area. Additional seats have been removed from the usable inventory in an effort to improve sightlines and comfort. As a result of the changes, the arena's seating for men's basketball is now 14,593.

SOROYE HAS KNEE SURGERY:

- Tunji Soroye, a senior center on the Virginia men's basketball team, had arthroscopic surgery on Nov. 8 to correct cartilage damage in his left knee
- Soroye is expected to be out 6-8 weeks
- "We will miss Tunji while he rehabilitates his knee," Virginia head coach Dave Leitao said. "We look forward to having him back in action when he's recovered from his surgery."
- The 6-11 Soroye has lettered three times for UVa and started 34 games the last two seasons
- He averaged 2.1 points and 3.2 rebounds a game in 28 games last season
- He has blocked 78 shots during his Virginia career and has led Virginia in blocked shots the last two seasons

UP NEXT:

- Virginia will return home to host Drexel on Tuesday, Nov. 20
- The game is the Cavaliers' second in the Philly Hoop Group Classic
- It is the first ever meeting between the schools
