## TODAY'S GAME:

- The Cavaliers continue their six-game homestand today vs. Elon
- Today's game is the first meeting between the schools since the 1999-2000 season


## ABOUT THE CAVALIERS (8-2, 0-0 ACC):

- The Cavaliers are 8-2 after a 79-65 win over Hampton on Wednesday
-Virginia entered the week leading the nation in rebounding margin at +14.6 per game
- UVa has seven different players averaging at least 5.0 points per game


## CAVALIERS IN THE MIDST OF A SIX-GAME HOMESTAND:

- Virginia plays the fifth game of its longest homestand of the season, six games, against Elon
- It is Virginia's longest homestand since an eight-game homestand in the 1998-99 season
-The Cavaliers had their 12-game home winning streak snapped with the 70-68 loss to Syracuse on Dec. 5


## ABOUT THE PHOENIX (5-6, 3-1 SoCON):

- Elon is in the middle of a five-game road trip, having played at Chattanooga Tuesday and at Penn Thursday
-The Phoenix are coming off a 67-64 loss at Penn on Thursday
- Ola Atoyebi leads the team, averaging 15.0 points per game


## SERIES VS. ELON:

- Today's game is the sixth all-time meeting between the schools, with UVa winning the first five games -Virginia won three games in the series from 1918 to 1922 and won games in the 1998-99 and 1999-00 seasons at University Hall following Elon's transition to Division I

## AGAINST THE SOUTHERN CONFERENCE:

- Today's game is the first and only game for the Cavaliers this season against a school from the Southern Conference
-The Cavaliers are 22-5 against current members of the SoCon (2-1 vs. Appalachian State, 1-0 vs. College of Charleston, $2-0$ vs. The Citadel, $10-4$ vs. Davidson, $5-0$ vs. Elon, $1-0$ vs. Furman, $1-0$ vs. Wofford)


## LAST TIME OUT:

-Virginia returned from its 12-day exam break with a 79-65 win over Hampton on Wednesday

- The Cavaliers' 79 points were the most allowed by the Pirates this season, who entered the game ranked 13th nationally in scoring defense (55.9 ppg allowed)
- Adrian Joseph led Virginia with 19 points and Mike Scott added a career-high 15 points against Hampton


## VIRGINIA RANKS FIRST NATIONALLY IN REBOUNDING MARGIN:

- The Cavaliers entered the week with a rebounding margin of +14.6
- That mark ranks first nationally, followed by Stanford (+13.1), Southern Miss (+12.8), Sam Houston State (+12.7), and Texas A\&M (+11.7)
-Virginia has out-rebounded its opponent in nine of 10 games this year, including three times by 20 or more rebounds


## REBOUNDING SUCCESS COMES FROM MANY SOURCES:

-The Cavaliers' strong performance on the boards this season has been a team effort

- In Virginia's first 10 games this year, six different players (Mamadi Diane, Calvin Baker, Laurynas Mikalauskas, Adrian Joseph, Mike Scott, and Jerome Meyinsse) have led the team in rebounding in a game


## CAVALIERS RECORD HISTORIC BIG TEN/ACC CHALLENGE WIN:

- Virginia's 94-52 win over Northwestern helped the ACC win its ninth consecutive Big Ten/ACC Challenge, 8-3 -The Cavaliers' 42-point victory over the Wildcats is the biggest margin of victory in the history of the event - In the game, the Cavaliers made 16 three-point field goals


## SINGLETARY ASSISTS IN WIN OVER NORTHWESTERN:

- Sean Singletary had a double-double with 14 points and a career-high 10 assists vs. Northwestern
- He became the first Cavalier with a double digit assist game since J.R. Reynolds had 12 assists vs. Virginia Tech in 2006


## JOSEPH HAS CAREER REBOUNDING HIGH AGAINST SETON HALL:

- Against Seton Hall, Adrian Joseph had a career-high 16 rebounds
- His 16 rebounds are the single game high in the ACC this season
- Joseph has had double-digit rebounds in five of the last seven games


## SCOTT ON THE BOARDS AGAINST PENN:

- Against Penn, first-year Mike Scott had 13 rebounds
- It was the most rebounds by a Cavalier freshman since Travis Watson had 15 rebounds against NC State (Jan.

12,2000 )

## SINGLETARY NAMED ACC PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

- Senior guard Sean Singletary was named ACC Player of the Week on Nov. 19 after leading Virginia to wins over Howard and at Arizona
- Singletary had 23 points and eight assists against the Bison and followed with 24 points and eight assists in the upset of the No. 17 Wildcats
- It is the fourth ACC Player of the Week honor of Singletary's career

SPREADING THE WEALTH:

- Against Howard, 13 different Cavaliers scored
- It was the most different players to score in a game for UVa since 14 different players scored in a $93-47$ win over Winthrop on December 1, 1990

## JOSEPH SHINES AGAINST VERMONT:

- Adrian Joseph led Virginia with 19 points in the season-opening win over Vermont
- He tied career-highs with five 3-point field goals and three assists in the contest
- His 19 points were his most since scoring 19 against Clemson during the 2005-06 season


## ABOUT THE SCHEDULE:

-The Cavaliers will play 29 regular season games, including 17 games at home at John Paul Jones Arena

- Of those 29 games, 14 will come against 2007 NCAA Tournament teams
- Additionally, six games will be against teams that were in the 2007 NIT
- 23 games this season will be televised, including 15 of 16 ACC contests


## HEAD COACH DAVE LEITAO:

- 2007 ACC Coach of the Year
- First Virginia coach to win the honor since Terry Holland in 1982
- 44-28 record at Virginia, including an 18-14 mark in the ACC
- First Virginia coach to have a winning ACC record over first two seasons as coach


## LEITAO HONORED BY DICK VITALE:

- ESPN's Dick Vitale named Dave Leitao his national coach of the week on Nov. 19
- Leitao led Virginia to a $75-72$ win at №. 17 Arizona that week


## TUCKER A "SOPHOMORE TO WATCH":

- Jamil Tucker was named one of 10 "Sophomores to Watch" by Seth Davis of Sports Illustrated
-The list features players who didn't have a large impact as freshmen but are expected to have break out seasons in their second season


## CAVALIERS FIFTH IN PRESEASON ACC POLL:

- UVa was fifth in the preseason ACC poll, voted on by media members at Operation Basketball in October
- It is the highest the Cavaliers have been in the poll since they were picked fifth in 2002-03


## SEAN SINGLETARY RECEIVES PRESEASON ACCOLADES:

- First-team Collegehoops.net preseason All-American
- Third-team CBSsportsline.com preseason All-American
- Collegelnsider.com preseason All-American
- Top 50 preseason candidate for the John R. Wooden Award

## SINGLETARY TOP RETURNING SCORER IN THE ACC:

- Sean Singletary averaged 19.0 points per game last year, which ranked third in the ACC (behind Florida State's AI Thornton and Boston College's Jared Dudley - both first round NBA Draft picks)
- Following Singletary on the ACC returning scorers list are North Carolina's Tyler Hansbrough (18.4) and Boston College's Tyrese Rice (17.6)


## DOUBLE FIGURE STREAK FOR SINGLETARY:

- Sean Singletary enters today's game having scored in double figures in his last 32 games
- It is the longest active streak in the ACC


## STAFF CHANGES FOR 2007-08:

- Drew Diener, UVa's Director of Basketball Operations the last two years, was named Assistant Coach in Sept. - Replacing Diener as Director of Basketball Operations is Rick Brunson. A former standout at Temple, Brunson played nine seasons in the NBA

## SINGLETARY, JOSEPH ARE VIRGINIA'S CAPTAINS:

- Seniors Sean Singletary and Adrian Joseph are co-captains for the 2007-08 season
- Singletary is a captain for the third consecutive year while Joseph is a captain for the first time
- Singletary joins Donald Hand (a captain from 98-99 through 00-01) as the only three-year captains in Virginia history


## AT HOME AT JOHN PAUL JONES ARENA:

- Virginia has an all-time record of 22-2 at John Paul Jones Arena
-The Cavaliers posted a 16-1 home record last year in the first season in John Paul Jones Arena
- Virginia was the only ACC team to go undefeated at home in conference play last year (8-0)
- The Cavaliers averaged 13,521 fans per game last year in the debut season at JPJA


## BASKETBALL SEATING FIGURE FOR JPJA CHANGES:

- After completing the first year in the John Paul Jones Arena, the Virginia athletics department has made an adjustment to the arena's seating figure for basketball. During the 2006-07 season, several seating areas were altered to accommodate needs within the arena. This led to an overall reduction of seats. These accommodations include seats converted to accessible seating and press tables for the media area. Additional seats have been removed from the usable inventory in an effort to improve sightlines and comfort. As a result of the changes, the arena's seating for men's basketball is now 14,593.


## SOROYE HAS KNEE SURGERY:

- Tunji Soroye, a senior center on the Virginia men's basketball team, had arthroscopic surgery on Nov. 8 to correct cartilage damage in his left knee
- Soroye is expected to be out 6-8 weeks
-"We will miss Tunji while he rehabilitates his knee,"Virginia head coach Dave Leitao said. "We look forward to having him back in action when he's recovered from his surgery."
- The 6-11 Soroye has lettered three times for UVa and started 34 games the last two seasons
- He averaged 2.1 points and 3.2 rebounds a game in 28 games last season
- He has blocked 78 shots during his Virginia career and has led Virginia in blocked shots the last two seasons


## VIRGINIA SIGNS THREE TO NATIONAL LETTERS OF INTENT:

- Head Coach Dave Leitao announced on Nov. 19 that three players have signed national letters of intent to join the Cavalier program in 2008-09
- 6-11 center John Brandenburg (Des Peres, Mo.), who averaged 8.2 points, 7.9 rebounds and 2.4 blocks per game last season as a junior at De Smet Jesuit H.S. in St. Louis
- 6-6 guard Sylven Landesberg (Flushing, N.Y.), who averaged 25.7 points, 10.5 rebounds and 3.6 assists per game last season as a junior at Holy Cross High School and was named the Catholic High School Athletic Association Player of the Year
- 7-0 center Assane Sene (Senegal), who is in his first season of basketball in the United States at South Kent Preparatory School in South Kent, Conn.


## UP NEXT:

- The Cavaliers will have an eight day break before returning to action on Dec. 30 when they host Hartford
- The game will be the final home non-conference game for Virginia
- Hartford is led by sophomore guard Joe Zeglinski (14.7 ppg), the older brother of Cavalier freshman guard Sammy Zeglinski

Sean Singletary scored four consecutive points in the final 90 seconds to give Virginia the lead for good and finished with game-high totals of 24 points and eight assists to lead the Cavaliers to a 75-72 win at No. 17 Arizona. Jeff Jones was 5-7 from three-point range and finished with 15 points, and Jamil Tucker was 5-7 from the field and tied his career high with 12 points for UVa.

It was the first home loss in November for Arizona since 1978.

The Cavaliers led by two (33-31) with $3: 15$ remaining in the first half before scoring the last nine points of the half to lead by 11 (42-31) at halftime. Virginia shot 69.2 percent (9-13) from three-point range in the first half and made all five of its free throws.

Both teams made runs in the second half. Arizona scored 12 consecutive points to take a 52-48 lead with 13:25 left in the game. The Cavaliers scored nine consecutive points to lead 66-59 with 8:23 remaining to play, but the Wildcats came right back and scored eight straight points to retake the lead 67-66 with 5:12 left in the game. With the score tied at 69, Singletary made two free throws and then a jump shot to give UVa a 73-69 lead with 39 seconds to play. After a Jerryd Bayless three-pointer cut the Cavaliers' lead to one, Adrian Joseph made two free throws with 20 seconds remaining to provide Virginia with its final margin of victory.

For the game, the Cavaliers shot 51 percent from the field, including 57.1 percent from threepoint range, and 86.7 percent from the free throw line. Arizona shot 48.1 percent from the field, including 47.1 percent from three-point range, and 85.7 percent from the free throw line.

Bayless scored 21 points to lead Arizona. Chase Budinger added 15 points and Jordan Hill 14.
"We got out early. We had a game plan and it worked. Both teams shot the ball extremely well in the first half, but we got the stops down the stretch. I'm really proud of how we stuck together." - Dave Leitao

Sean Singletary had 24 points and seven rebounds to lead Virginia to a $72-58$ victory over Drexel at John Paul Jones Arena in a game that was scheduled as part of the Philly Hoop Group Classic. Mamadi Diane had 22 points, hitting a careerhigh six three-point field goals, and Sean Singletary had his second career double-double to lead Virginia to a 94-52 win over Northwestern in a Big Ten/ ACC Challenge matchup at John Paul Jones Arena. Calvin Baker added 16 points, his high at Virginia, on perfect 6-6 shooting from the floor, including 4-4 from behind the arc.

The 42-point margin of victory was the largest in the nine-year history of the event, which annually matches teams from the two conferences.

Eight of the Cavaliers' first nine baskets were from three-point range and the Cavaliers led by as many as 27 points in the first half. They took a 54-29 advantage into halftime. Northwestern had 11 field goals in the first half, one less than Virginia had from three-point range (12).

The Cavaliers made 16 three-point field goals and shot 50.0 percent from behind the arc for the game. Overall, Virginia shot 51.6 from the floor and 87.5 percent from the free throw line. Northwestern shot 35.7 from the floor, including 27.6 percent from three-point range. The Wildcats' 4-15 (26.7 percent) performance from the free throw line was the fourth lowest percentage ever by an opponent against the Cavaliers.

Northwestern was led by Michael Thompson and Jason Okrzesik, who scored 14 and 12 points respectively.

The Cavaliers improved to 5-3 all-time in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge, including a 4-0 mark in games played in Charlottesville.
"We took 32 (3-pointers) today because 32 was the number that presented itself because they played a lot of zone. We shot 50 percent while taking that many. It's only a bad thing when you are taking over 30 and not making too many." - Dave Leitao

Donte Greene scored 20 points, including 12 in the final 10 minutes of the game to lead Syracuse to a 70-68 win over Virginia at John Paul Jones Arena. Greene also had 10 rebounds, blocked three shots and had two steals.

The loss snapped the Cavaliers' 12-game home winning streak and was just the second setback for Virginia at JPJA.

Adrian Joseph led the Cavaliers, posting his third double-double of the season with 19 points and 13 rebounds. Sean Singletary and Mamadi Diane each had 10 points for Virginia.

The Cavaliers led 36-29 at the break, but a 19-5 run by the Orange in the second half gave them a 51-44 lead with 10 minutes to play. The Cavaliers retook the lead and led by three (61-58) with six minutes remaining. Green answered with five consecutive points to give Syracuse the lead (63-61). Green's jumper with just over one minute left gave the Orange a three-point lead (68-65). Diane scored with seven seconds to go to cut the lead to 68-67, but Jonny Flynn made both ends of a one-in-one to increase Syracuse's lead to three. Sean Singletary was fouled with 1.2 seconds left and made the front end of a one-in-one. He intentionally missed the second shot, but the Cavaliers couldn't grab the rebound to attempt a tying shot.

Syracuse out-rebounded Virginia 39-36, the first team to out-rebound the Cavaliers on the season. The Orange shot 44.1 percent from the floor and 90.9 percent from the line, compared to 40.6 percent from the floor and 45.5 percent from the line for Virginia.

In addition to Green, Syracuse was led by Flynn, who had 18 points, Eric Devendorf, who scored 16 points, and Paul Harris, who added 10 points and 14 rebounds.
