#### **TODAY'S GAME:**

- The Cavaliers look to remain unbeaten on the young season as they host Howard
- Last week, Virginia opened the season by defeating Vermont 90-72
- The game is the first for the Cavaliers in the Philly Hoop Group Classic

#### **ABOUT THE CAVALIERS (1-0, 0-0 ACC):**

- The Cavaliers are 1-0 after a 90-72 season opening win over Vermont on Sunday
- Adrian Joseph and Sean Singletary each had 19 points to lead UVa against the Catamounts
- 14 players saw action against Vermont, including five that made their Cavalier debut

#### ABOUT THE BISON (0-1, 0-0 MEAC):

- Howard is coming off a 129-59 loss at Duquesne in its season opener Friday
- Eugene Myatt led Howard with 16 points against Duquesne
- Myatt was a second-team preseason All-MEAC selection

#### **PHILLY HOOP GROUP CLASSIC:**

- Tonight's game is the first contest for Virginia as part of the Philly Hoop Group Classic
- Teams in each session of the tournament will play two games against teams from the other session prior to the games in Philadelphia, with the results having no bearing on the pairings in Philadelphia
- Virginia's next home game against Drexel is also part of the Philly Hoop Group Classic

#### **SERIES VS. HOWARD:**

- Third ever meeting between the teams with Virginia holding a 2-0 advantage in the series
- Virginia defeated Howard 100-64 (1992-93) and 115-66 (2001-02), both at University Hall

#### **SERIES AGAINST MEAC**

- The Cavaliers are 9-0 against current members of the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (1-0 vs. Bethune-Cookman, 1-0 vs. Coppin State, 3-0 vs. Hampton, 2-0 vs. Howard, 1-0 vs. Maryland-Eastern Shore, 1-0 vs. Morgan State)
- Virginia was 3-0 vs. the MEAC last season, defeating Morgan State (85-66), Maryland-Eastern Shore (104-63) and Hampton (91-69)
- Howard is the first of two MEAC opponents on Virginia's 2007-08 schedule (Hampton)

#### LAST TIME OUT:

- Virginia opened the season with a 90-72 victory over Vermont on Sunday
- Adrian Joseph and Sean Singletary led Virginia with 19 points each

#### **JOSEPH SHINES AGAINST VERMONT:**

- Adrian Joseph led Virginia with 19 points in the season-opening win over Vermont
- He tied career-highs with five 3-point field goals and three assists in the contest
- His 19 points were his most since scoring 19 against Clemson during the 2005-06 season

#### **ABOUT THE SCHEDULE:**

- The Cavaliers will play 29 regular season games, including 17 games at home at John Paul Jones Arena
- Of those 29 games, 14 will come against 2007 NCAA Tournament teams
- Additionally, six games will be against teams that were in the 2007 NIT
- 23 games this season will be televised, including 15 of 16 ACC contests

#### **HEAD COACH DAVE LEITAO:**

- 2007 ACC Coach of the Year
- First Virginia coach to win the honor since Terry Holland in 1982
- 37-26 record at Virginia, including an 18-14 mark in the ACC
- First Virginia coach to have a winning ACC record over first two seasons as coach

#### **CAVALIERS FIFTH IN PRESEASON ACC POLL:**

- UVa was fifth in the preseason ACC poll, voted on by media members at last month's Operation Basketball
- It is the highest the Cavaliers have been in the poll since they were picked fifth in 2002-03

#### SINGLETARY TOP RETURNING SCORER IN THE ACC:

- Sean Singletary averaged 19.0 points per game last year, which ranked third in the ACC (behind Florida State's Al Thornton and Boston College's Jared Dudley both first round NBA Draft picks)
- Following Singletary on the ACC returning scorers list are North Carolina's Tyler Hansbrough (18.4) and Boston College's Tyrese Rice (17.6)

### **DOUBLE FIGURE STREAK FOR SINGLETARY:**

- Sean Singletary enters the game having scored in double figures in his last 23 games
- $\bullet$  It is the longest active streak in the ACC among returning players

#### **STAFF CHANGES FOR 2007-08:**

- Drew Diener, UVa's Director of Basketball Operations the last two years, was named Assistant Coach in September
- Replacing Diener as Director of Basketball Operations is Rick Brunson. A former standout at Temple, Brunson played nine seasons in the NBA

#### **SINGLETARY, JOSEPH NAMED CAPTAINS:**

- Seniors Sean Singletary and Adrian Joseph are co-captains for the 2007-08 season
- Singletary is a captain for the third consecutive year while Joseph is a captain for the first time
- Singletary joins Donald Hand (a captain from 98-99 through 00-01) as the only three-year captains in Virginia history

#### AT HOME AT JOHN PAUL JONES ARENA:

- Virginia has an all-time record of 17-1 at John Paul Jones Arena
- The Cavaliers posted a 16-1 home record last year in the first season in John Paul Jones Arena
- Virginia was the only ACC team to go undefeated at home in conference play last year (8-0)
- The Cavaliers averaged 13,521 fans per game last year in the debut season at JPJA

#### **BASKETBALL SEATING FIGURE FOR JPJA CHANGES:**

• After completing the first year in the John Paul Jones Arena, the Virginia athletics department has made an adjustment to the arena's seating figure for basketball. During the 2006-07 season, several seating areas were altered to accommodate needs within the arena. This led to an overall reduction of seats. These accommodations include seats converted to accessible seating and press tables for the media area. Additional seats have been removed from the usable inventory in an effort to improve sightlines and comfort. As a result of the changes, the arena's seating for men's basketball is now 14,593.

#### **SOROYE HAS KNEE SURGERY:**

- Tunji Soroye, a senior center on the Virginia men's basketball team, had arthroscopic surgery on Nov. 8 to correct cartilage damage in his left knee
- Soroye is expected to be out 6-8 weeks
- "We will miss Tunji while he rehabilitates his knee," Virginia head coach Dave Leitao said. "We look forward to having him back in action when he's recovered from his surgery."
- The 6-11 Soroye has lettered three times for UVa and started 34 games the last two seasons
- He averaged 2.1 points and 3.2 rebounds a game in 28 games last season
- He has blocked 78 shots during his Virginia career and has led Virginia in blocked shots the last two seasons

#### **TIME CHANGES:**

- Several games have had time changes since the original schedule was released in August
- The current version of the schedule is available on page 1 of the notes

#### **UP NEXT:**

- Virginia will hit the road for the first time this season on Saturday as it vists No. 17 Arizona
- The Wildcats open the season Tuesday vs. Northern Arizona
- UVa won last season's meeting between the schools 93-90 in the inaugural game at John Paul Jones Arena
