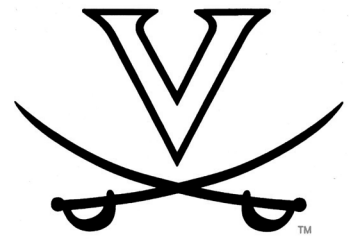

TODAY'S GAME:

- The Cavaliers look to remain unbeaten on the season as they travel to The Palestra for the Philly Hoop Group Classic
- Virginia will play Penn on Friday and either Seton Hall or Navy on Saturday
- UVa won both of its home preliminary games in the event, downing Howard, 92-53, and Drexel, 72-58

ABOUT THE CAVALIERS (4-0, 0-0 ACC):

- The Cavaliers are 4-0 after a 72-58 win over Drexel on Tuesday in Charlottesville
- Sean Singletary had 24 points, seven rebounds, and five assists to lead Virginia against the Dragons
- Virginia entered the AP rankings this week at No. 23 after a 75-72 win at then No. 17 Arizona on Nov. 17

CAVALIERS HAVE A PHILLY HOMECOMING:

- This weekend's tournament is a homecoming for several members of the Virginia program
- Three players hail from Southeastern Pennsylvania: Sean Singletary and Sammy Zeglinski (Philadelphia) and Jeff Jones (Chester)
- Ryan Pettinella returns to The Palestra, where he played his first two seasons of college basketball for Penn, averaging 4.0 points and 2.5 rebounds per game in his Quaker career
- Assistant coach Steve Seymour was on the staff at Drexel for 10 seasons, including two as head coach, leading the Dragons to a 28-29 record from 1999-2001
- Director of Basketball Operations Rick Brunson was a standout at Temple (1992-95) before playing nine seasons in the NBA
- Virginia's Athletics Director Craig Littlepage is a native of the Philadelphia suburb of LaMott, Pa. and is a 1973 graduate of Penn. He was a member of three Ivy League Championship teams as a player and led the Quakers to one Ivy League title while the head coach at Penn (1982-85).

VIRGINIA ENTERS ASSOCIATED PRESS TOP 25:

- The Cavaliers entered the AP Top 25 this week at No. 23
- It is Virginia's first ranking in the poll since being No. 24 on Feb. 19, 2007
- No. 23 is UVa's highest AP ranking since a No. 19 ranking on Dec. 6, 2004
- This season marks the earliest in a season Virginia has been ranked by the AP since being No. 11 in the 2001-02 preseason poll

ABOUT THE QUAKERS (1-3, 0-0 IVY LEAGUE):

- Penn posted its first win of the year on Tuesday, defeating The Citadel 93-77
- Brian Grandieri leads Penn, averaging 15.8 points and 6.0 rebounds per game
- The Quakers have won the last three Ivy League Championships

SERIES VS. PENN:

- Friday's game is the 13th all-time meeting between the schools with Virginia holding a 7-5 edge in the series
- Virginia is 2-4 against the Quakers at The Palestra
- The Cavaliers have won the last five meetings between the teams
- UVa has won the last two meetings at The Palestra; 60-50 in 1984-85 (Penn was coached at the time by current Virginia Athletics Director Craig Littlepage) and 74-68 in the 1992-93 season opener

ABOUT THE PIRATES (3-0, 0-0 BIG EAST):

- Seton Hall has opened the season with home wins over Monmouth, Robert Morris, and Loyola (Md.)
- Eugen Harvey leads the Pirates, averaging 23.3 points and 5.3 assists per game
- Seton Hall was 13-16 last season, including a 4-12 Big East record

SERIES VS. SETON HALL:

- If Virginia plays Seton Hall on Saturday it would be the third meeting between the schools
- Seton Hall has won both previous meetings; 73-71 in 1970-71 and 84-67 in 1988-89

ABOUT THE MIDSHIPMEN (2-3, 0-0 PATRIOT LEAGUE):

- Navy improved to 2-3 on the season with a 71-60 home win over Canisius on Tuesday
- Greg Sprink leads the Midshipmen, averaging 18.0 points per game
- Navy was 14-16 last season, including a 4-10 Patriot League record

SERIES VS. NAVY:

- If Virginia plays Navy on Saturday it would be the 45th meeting between the schools
- Navy holds a 31-13 edge in the series, but Virginia has won the last six meetings
- The teams have not met since the 1973-74 season

SINGLETON NAMED ACC PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

- Senior guard Sean Singleton was named ACC Player of the Week on Nov. 19 after leading Virginia to wins over Howard and at Arizona
- Singleton had 23 points and eight assists against the Bison and followed with 24 points and eight assists in the upset of the No. 17 Wildcats
- It is the fourth ACC Player of the Week honor of Singleton's career

LAST TIME OUT:

- Virginia is coming off a 72-58 win over Drexel on Tuesday at John Paul Jones Arena
- The Cavaliers were led by Sean Singleton (24 points) and Adrian Joseph (11 points, 11 rebounds), who posted his first career double-double.

SPREADING THE WEALTH:

- Against Howard, 13 different Cavaliers scored
- It was the most different players to score in a game for UVa since 14 different players scored in a 93-47 win over Winthrop on December 1, 1990

JOSEPH SHINES AGAINST VERMONT:

- Adrian Joseph led Virginia with 19 points in the season-opening win over Vermont
- He tied career-highs with five 3-point field goals and three assists in the contest
- His 19 points were his most since scoring 19 against Clemson during the 2005-06 season

SINGLETARY REACHES ASSIST MILESTONE:

- Sean Singletary had his 400th career assist in the win at Arizona, becoming the eighth Cavalier to reach the mark
- Singletary heads to Philadelphia in seventh place on UVa's career list with 412 assists

ABOUT THE SCHEDULE:

- The Cavaliers will play 29 regular season games, including 17 games at home at John Paul Jones Arena
- Of those 29 games, 14 will come against 2007 NCAA Tournament teams
- Additionally, six games will be against teams that were in the 2007 NIT
- 23 games this season will be televised, including 15 of 16 ACC contests

HEAD COACH DAVE LEITAO:

- 2007 ACC Coach of the Year
- First Virginia coach to win the honor since Terry Holland in 1982
- 40-26 record at Virginia, including an 18-14 mark in the ACC
- First Virginia coach to have a winning ACC record over first two seasons as coach

LEITAO HONORED BY DICK VITALE:

- ESPN's Dick Vitale named Dave Leitao his national coach of the week on Nov. 19
- Leitao led Virginia to a 75-72 win at No. 17 Arizona that week

TUCKER A "SOPHOMORE TO WATCH":

- Jamil Tucker was named one of 10 "Sophomores to Watch" by Seth Davis of *Sports Illustrated*
- The list features players who didn't have a large impact as freshmen but are expected to have break out seasons in their second season

CAVALIERS FIFTH IN PRESEASON ACC POLL:

- UVa was fifth in the preseason ACC poll, voted on by media members at last month's Operation Basketball
- It is the highest the Cavaliers have been in the poll since they were picked fifth in 2002-03

SEAN SINGLETARY RECEIVES PRESEASON ACCOLADES:

- First-team Collegehoops.net preseason All-American
- Third-team CBSsportsline.com preseason All-American
- Colleagueinsider.com preseason All-American
- Top 50 preseason candidate for the John R. Wooden Award
- Preseason Watch List for the Naismith Trophy presented by AT&T
- Bob Cousy Award presented by The Hartford (nation's top point guard) preseason list
- Preseason All-ACC
- No. 4 on Luke Winn's Top 15 Seniors on SI.com

SINGLETARY TOP RETURNING SCORER IN THE ACC:

- Sean Singletary averaged 19.0 points per game last year, which ranked third in the ACC (behind Florida State's Al Thornton and Boston College's Jared Dudley - both first round NBA Draft picks)
- Following Singletary on the ACC returning scorers list are North Carolina's Tyler Hansbrough (18.4) and Boston College's Tyrese Rice (17.6)

DOUBLE FIGURE STREAK FOR SINGLETARY:

- Sean Singletary heads to Philadelphia having scored in double figures in his last 26 games
- It is the longest active streak in the ACC

STAFF CHANGES FOR 2007-08:

- Drew Diener, UVA's Director of Basketball Operations the last two years, was named Assistant Coach in Sept.
- Replacing Diener as Director of Basketball Operations is Rick Brunson. A former standout at Temple, Brunson played nine seasons in the NBA

SINGLETARY, JOSEPH ARE VIRGINIA'S CAPTAINS:

- Seniors Sean Singletary and Adrian Joseph are co-captains for the 2007-08 season
- Singletary is a captain for the third consecutive year while Joseph is a captain for the first time
- Singletary joins Donald Hand (a captain from 98-99 through 00-01) as the only three-year captains in Virginia history

AT HOME AT JOHN PAUL JONES ARENA:

- Virginia has an all-time record of 19-1 at John Paul Jones Arena
- The Cavaliers posted a 16-1 home record last year in the first season in John Paul Jones Arena
- Virginia was the only ACC team to go undefeated at home in conference play last year (8-0)
- The Cavaliers averaged 13,521 fans per game last year in the debut season at JPJA

BASKETBALL SEATING FIGURE FOR JPJA CHANGES:

- After completing the first year in the John Paul Jones Arena, the Virginia athletics department has made an adjustment to the arena's seating figure for basketball. During the 2006-07 season, several seating areas were altered to accommodate needs within the arena. This led to an overall reduction of seats. These accommodations include seats converted to accessible seating and press tables for the media area. Additional seats have been removed from the usable inventory in an effort to improve sightlines and comfort. As a result of the changes, the arena's seating for men's basketball is now 14,593.

SOROYE HAS KNEE SURGERY:

- Tunji Soroye, a senior center on the Virginia men's basketball team, had arthroscopic surgery on Nov. 8 to correct cartilage damage in his left knee
- Soroye is expected to be out 6-8 weeks
- "We will miss Tunji while he rehabilitates his knee," Virginia head coach Dave Leitao said. "We look forward to having him back in action when he's recovered from his surgery."
- The 6-11 Soroye has lettered three times for UVA and started 34 games the last two seasons
- He averaged 2.1 points and 3.2 rebounds a game in 28 games last season
- He has blocked 78 shots during his Virginia career and has led Virginia in blocked shots the last two seasons

VIRGINIA SIGNS THREE TO NATIONAL LETTERS OF INTENT:

- Head Coach Dave Leitao announced on Nov. 19 that three players have signed national letters of intent to join the Cavalier program in 2008-09
- 6-11 center John Brandenburg (Des Peres, Mo.), who averaged 8.2 points, 7.9 rebounds and 2.4 blocks per game last season as a junior at De Smet Jesuit H.S. in St. Louis
- 6-6 guard Sylven Landesberg (Flushing, N.Y.), who averaged 25.7 points, 10.5 rebounds and 3.6 assists per game last season as a junior at Holy Cross High School and was named the Catholic High School Athletic Association Player of the Year
- 7-0 center Assane Sene (Senegal), who is in his first season of basketball in the United States at South Kent Preparatory School in South Kent, Conn.

UP NEXT:

- Virginia will return home to open a six-game homestand to close out 2007
- The Cavaliers host Northwestern on Tuesday, Nov. 27 in a Big Ten/ACC Challenge matchup (7 p.m./ESPNU)
- It marks the third time the two teams have met in the competition, with Virginia winning both previous meetings (48-44 in 2004-05 in Evanston, Ill., 72-57 in 2005-06 at University Hall)
