#### **Tonight's Game**

- The Cavaliers continue their four-game season-opening homestand tonight vs. Radford
- Virginia looks to open the season 3-0 for the third consecutive year and the eighth time in the past nine years

#### **About the Cavaliers**

- Virginia opened the season with home wins over VMI and USF
- Five Cavaliers are averaging double figures in scoring
- UVa is led by Sylven Landesberg, who leads the ACC in scoring at 24.5 points per game

#### **About the Highlanders**

- Radford is 2-0 after home wins against Brevard (Division II) and Bridgewater (Division III)
- The Highlanders were second in the preseason Big South poll
- Radford head coach Brad Greenberg is the brother of Virginia Tech head coach Seth Greenberg
- Senior guard Kenny Thomas leads Radford at 17.0 points per game

#### **Series History**

- Virginia leads the series 4-0 (all of the games have been played in Charlottesville)
- The teams haven't met since the 1996-97 season, a 95-47 Cavalier win at University Hall

#### **November Success**

- Virginia has posted a 15-3 record in November under Dave Leitao
- The Cavaliers have won 35 consecutive November home games dating back to a 94-83 loss to Ohio on November 18, 1994
- Virginia has a 4-2 record against ranked opponents in November since 2000

#### **Series Against the Big South**

- Tonight's game is Virginia's second game of three this season vs. Big South opponents (VMI, Liberty)
- Virginia has a 119-16 all-time record against current members of the Big South (1-0 vs. Charleston Southern, 2-0 vs. Coastal Carolina, 1-0 vs. Gardner Webb, 1-0 vs. High Point, 6-1 vs. Liberty, 4-0 vs. Radford, 1-0 vs. UNC-Asheville, 101-15 vs. VMI, 2-0 vs. Winthrop)
- UVa has won its last 15 games against Big South opponents, dating back to 1998

#### **Against the State**

- Tonight's game is the second of seven this season against in-state opponents
- Under Dave Leitao, Virginia has a 14-3 record against in-state opponents
- Virginia has won 14 consecutive games against non-conference in-state opponents dating back to the 2002-03 season (73-55 loss at Virginia Tech, when the Hokies were in the Big East)

#### **Last Time Out**

- Virginia improved to 2-0 on the season with a 77-75 victory over USF
- Sylven Landesberg led the Cavaliers with 21 points, including the game-winning layup with 13 seconds remaining
- The win snapped a five-game losing streak against Big East opponents

#### **Landesberg Makes Immediate Impact**

- With 28 points vs. VMI and 21 points vs. USF, Sylven Landesberg became the first Cavalier freshman to open his career with two 20-point games
- He is the first Cavalier freshman since Gary Forbes in 2003-04 to lead the team in scoring in each of the first two games of the season
- He leads the ACC in scoring with a 24.5 average

#### **Landesberg Named ACC Rookie of the Week**

- Sylven Landesberg was named the ACC Rookie of the Week on Nov. 17 for his play in the Cavaliers' 107-97 season opening victory over VMI
- Landesberg had 28 points, eight rebounds and eight assists in his collegiate debut
- He is the first Cavalier to win the award since Sean Singletary won it five times in 2004-05

#### **Landesberg Shines In Collegiate Debut**

- Sylven Landesberg had 28 points in the seasonopener against VMI, the most by a Cavalier freshman in his debut
- •The previous record was 24 points set by Jeff Lamp in his debut against James Madison on Nov. 25, 1977
- Landesberg's 28 points are tied for the second most in ACC history by a freshman in his first game
- Landesberg is one of only four Cavalier first-years to score 20 points in his first collegiate game
- His 28 points are the most by a UVa freshman in any game since Chris Williams had 34 points vs. Liberty on Dec. 8, 1998
- He is the first Cavalier freshman to lead the team in scoring in a season opener since Mamadi Diane had 17 points in the 2005-06 season opening win over Liberty

#### Mike Scott Opens Season With Impressive Performance

- Mike Scott set career highs with 26 points and 18 rebounds in the season opening win over VMI
- Scott tied the school record with 10 offensive rebounds, a mark previously set by Matt Blundin (vs. Clemson 1/9/90), Bryant Stith (vs. Georgia Tech 3/13/92) and Travis Watson (vs. Maryland 1/31/02)
- His 18 rebounds were the most by a Cavalier since Travis Watson had 20 rebounds vs. Wofford on Jan. 2, 2003



#### Scott and Landesberg Post UVa's First 25-25 Combo in Over a Year

- Against VMI, Sylven Landesberg (28 pts) and Mike Scott (26 points) became the first Cavaliers to score at least 25 points in the same game in over a year
- The previous game that Virginia had a pair of 25-point scorers was a 71-58 win at NC State on Jan. 24, 2007 when J.R Reynolds had 29 points and Sean Singletary had 27 points

#### **Tucker Steps Up**

- Jamil Tucker has posted a pair of career highs to open the season
- Against VMI, Tucker tied his previous career high with 14 points
- He topped that mark with a new career-high 15 points against USF

#### **Cavaliers 12th in ACC Preseason Poll**

- The Cavaliers were projected 12th in the preseason ACC poll of media
- Sylven Landesberg was second in the voting for Preseason ACC Rookie of the Year

#### **Difficult Schedule for the Cavaliers**

- 16 of 27 regular season games will be against 2008 postseason teams (seven vs. NCAA teams, eight vs. NIT teams, one vs. CBI team)
- 21 of 27 games will be televised
- Four opponents are ranked and five others are receiving votes in this week's Associated Press poll

#### Virginia Visited Canada in August

- The Cavaliers went on a trip to Canada in August to play three games
- Virginia went 2-1 on the trip
- UVa defeated St. Lawrence College (Ont.) 107-60
- UVa defeated Concordia 85-70
- UVa lost to McGill 88-83
- Four players averaged in double figures on the trip (Calvin Baker 16.0, Jeff Jones -13.7, Sylven Landesberg 12.0, Mike Scott 10.7)

#### **Head Coach Dave Leitao**

- 2007 ACC Coach of the Year
- First Virginia coach to win the honor since Terry Holland in 1982
- 55-42 record in his fourth season at Virginia, including a 23-25 mark in the ACC
- Overall record of 135-111 in his ninth season as a head coach

#### At Home at John Paul Jones Arena

- Virginia has an all-time record of 31-8 at John Paul Jones Arena
- UVa was 13-7 at home during the 2007-08 season
- The Cavaliers posted a 16-1 home record in 2006-07 in the first season in John Paul Jones Arena

#### **Baker, Diane, Soroye Named Virginia's Captains**

- Calvin Baker, Mamadi Diane, and Tunji Soroye are Virginia's captains for 2008-09
- This season marks the first year each player has served as a captain

#### Sene to Be Held Out of Games

- Freshman center Assane Sene is being held out of games pending the resolution of his eligibility status
- He will continue to practice with the team
- "Because of a recent NCAA interpretation, there are some aspects of Assane's pre-college enrollment that must be reviewed further," Virginia Athletics Director Craig Littlepage said on Nov. 16. "We're looking to have this resolved quickly."
- Sene is from Saint-Louis, Senegal, and attended South Kent Preparatory School in Connecticut during the 2007-08 academic year
