Tonight's Game

- The Cavaliers take to the road for the first time this season as they visit Syracuse
- Virginia looks to rebound from its first loss of the season, 86-82 to Liberty on Tuesday

About the Cavaliers

- Virginia is 3-1 after opening the season with a four-game homestand
- UVa is led by Sylven Landesberg, who is averaing 22.0 points per game
- Mike Scott leads the ACC in rebounding at 11.5 per game

About the Orange

- Syracuse is 5-0 this season and is coming off winning the CBE Classic Championship
- The Orange defeated Florida and Kansas, the teams that have won the last three NCAA Championships, in the semifinals and finals earlier this week in Kansas City
- Jonny Flynn leads the team in scoring with a 21.0 average and was named the CBE Classic MVP

Series History

- Syracuse leads the series 2-1 (tonight's game is the first meeting in Syracuse)
- Last season the Orange won 70-68 at John Paul Jones Arena
- The first two meetings between the schools were in the NCAA Tournament, a 63-55 Virginia win in the 1984 round of 16 and a 63-61 Syracuse win in the 1990 second round

Cavaliers in Syracuse

• Tonight marks the Cavaliers' third game at the Carrier Dome, where they have a 2-0 record

• Virginia played in the 1993 NCAA Tournament at Syracuse, defeating Manhattan 78-66 in the first round and Massachusetts 71-56 in the second round

The Cavaliers have not played in a dome since the 2001 ACC Tournament at the Georgia Dome

Close Wins

- Virginia won its first three games of the season by a combined 14 points
- It marked the first time in school history that the Cavaliers opened a season with three victories of 10 points or less
- Virginia is already halfway to its total of wins by 10 or less for all of last season (six)

Series Against the Big East

- Tonight's game is Virginia's second game of two this season vs. Big East opponents (USF)
- Virginia has a 54-56 all-time record against current members of the Big East (1-3 vs. Cincinnati, 2-6 vs. Connecticut, 0-2 vs. DePaul, 11-12 vs. Georgetown, 5-3 vs. Louisville, 3-1 vs. Marquette, 5-1 vs. Notre Dame, 7-3 vs. Pittsburgh, 3-3 vs. Providence, 3-0 vs. Rutgers, 0-3 vs. Seton Hall, 0-7
- vs. St. John's, 1-0 vs. USF, 1-2 vs. Syracuse, 4-2 vs. Villanova and 8-8 vs. West Virginia)

• The Cavaliers' win over USF on Nov. 19 snapped a five-game losing streak vs. Big East opponents • Virginia has lost its last four road games against Big East opponents since a 61-57 win at Rutgers on Dec. 21, 2002

Road Openers

- Tonight's game is Virginia's road opener after beginning the season with a four-game homestand
- The Cavaliers have won their first game away from home in seven of the past eight seasons
- Last year Virginia defeated No. 17 Arizona 75-72 in its first road game of the season

Last Time Out

• Virginia suffered its first loss of the season, 86-82 to Liberty Tuesday night at JPJA

• Sammy Zeglinski had a career-high 24 points, all in the second half, and Mike Scott had 17 rebounds to lead the Cavaliers

Bench Production

• Virginia has gotten solid production from its bench this season, avergaing 30.5 points, 13.3 rebounds and 4.5 assists per game off the bench

• Virginia had 51 points off the bench against USF, the most bench points in a game for the Cavaliers since scoring 52 off the bench against Maryland on March 1, 1986

Landesberg Named ACC Rookie of the Week ... Again

• Sylven Landesberg was named the ACC Rookie of the Week on Nov. 24, the second consecutive week he won the honor

• He is the first Cavalier to win the award in consecutive weeks since Sean Singletary won it on Feb. 14, 2005 and Feb. 21, 2005

• He is the first player to win the award in each of the first two weeks of the season since Georgia Tech's Chris Bosh in 2002-03

Landesberg Makes Immediate Impact

• With 28 points vs. VMI, 21 points vs. USF and 22 points vs. Radford, Sylven Landesberg became the first Cavalier freshman to open his career with three 20-point games

• He was the first Cavalier freshman since Tom Sheehey in 1983-84 to lead the team in scoring in each of the first three games of the season

• He was only the second freshman in ACC history to score at least 20 points in the first three games of his career (Georgia Tech's Kenny Anderson scored at least 20 points in his first six career games in 1989-90)

• He was the first Cavalier player to score 20 or more points in the first three games of a season since Roger Mason, Jr. in 2001-02

Zeglinski Scores Big Against Liberty

- Sammy Zeglinski scored a career-high 24 points, all in the second half, against Liberty
- He shot 8-13 from the floor, including 6-10 from 3-point range
- His 24 second half points are a John Paul Jones Arena record

Virginia Signs Two to Letters of Intent

• The Cavaliers signed two recruits to National Letters of Intent during the November signing period

• Jontel Evans, a 5-11 guard from Hampton, Va., and Tristan Spurlock, a 6-7 forward from Woodbridge, Va., will join the Cavaliers in 2009-10

• The Cavaliers will visit Minnesota Tuesday night for a matchup in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge

- The game will be televised by ESPN2 and gametime is 9:30 p.m. ET (8:30 p.m. local)
- Last year the Cavaliers had a 94-52 win over Northwestern in the challenge at John Paul Jones Arena
- It will be the third meeting between the schools in the challenge, with Minnesota winning
- 74-62 in Minneapolis in 1999-00 and Virginia winning 86-78 in Charlottesville in 2003-04

Sylven Landesberg scored 28 points, grabbed eight rebounds and had eight assists, and Mike Scott added career highs of 26 points and 18 rebounds to lead Virginia to a season-opening 107-97 victory over VMI at John Paul Jones Arena. Mamadi Diane and Jamil Tucker each added 14 points, and Sammy Zeglinski scored 11 points for the Cavaliers. The victory was the 11th consecutive season-

opening victory for Virginia.

Landesberg's 28 points are the most by a Virginia freshman in his collegiate debut and tied for the second most by an ACC freshman in his first game.

Scott tied a school record with 10 offensive rebounds and his 18 total rebounds were the most by a Cavalier since Travis Watson had 20 rebounds against Wofford on Jan. 2, 2003.

A 28-9 run gave Virginia a 36-19 lead with 10:14 left to play in the first half, but the Keydets rallied to cut the UVa lead to 51-45 at halftime. Scott had 14 first half points for the Cavaliers, Landesberg had 13 and Tucker 10.

The game was tied 82-82 with 6:47 to play when Virginia went on a 10-2 run to take control of the game. A jumper by Scott gave Virginia the lead for good at 84-82 with 6:30 remaining and two three-pointers by Jeff Jones completed the run. VMI didn't get closer than four points the rest of the game.

The Cavaliers shot 54.4 percent (43-79) from the field, out-rebounded the Keydets 50-35 and had 24 assists. VMI shot 46.8 percent (37-79) from the field, 93.3 percent (14-15) from the free throw line and had 15 steals. Virginia shot 64.3 percent (18-28) from the free throw line.

Twin brothers Chavis and Travis Holmes led VMI. Chavis Holmes scored a game-high 31 points and Travis Holmes had 20 points. Austin Kenon added 18 points, while Willie Bell and Keith Gabriel each scored 14 points.

Sylven Landesberg scored on a layup with 13 seconds left in the game to give Virginia the lead for good at 76-75 and then added a free throw six seconds later to account for the final margin of victory as the Cavaliers defeated the University of South Florida 77-75 at John Paul Jones Arena.

Landesberg finished with a team-high 21 points and also had four rebounds and three steals. He is the first Virginia freshman since Gary Forbes in 2003-04 to lead the team in scoring in each of the first two games of the season.

Jamil Tucker added a career-high 15 points for the Cavaliers and led the team with seven rebounds. Mamadi Diane added 13 points, while Mike Scott scored 10 points and had six rebounds.

USF jumped out to a 10-2 lead 5:01 into the game, but UVa battled back and to tie the game 34-34 at halftime. Dominique Jones scored 13 points in the first half for USF and Diane had 10 first half points for the Cavaliers.

Virginia trailed by as many as six points in the second half (61-55 with 9:06 to play) before rallying for the victory. Landesberg and Tucker each scored 12 points in the second half to lead UVa.

The Cavaliers shot 40.3 percent (27-67) from the field, including 26.3 percent (5-19) from threepoint range, and 64.3 percent (18-28) from the free throw line. Virginia had eight steals and turned the ball over only 10 times in the game. USF shot 49.2 percent (32-65) from the field, including 33.3 percent (5-15) from three-point range, and 50 percent (6-12) from the free throw line. The Bulls turned the ball over 14 times.

Jones finished with a game-high 23 points to lead USF and Jesus Verdejo scored 22 points. Chris Howard scored 12 points for the Bulls and Alex Rivas Sanchez added 10 points and nine rebounds.

"Without playing particularly well today, we still were able to win. And were able do it a little bit 'gutty'. In the last five minutes, we were finally getting some stops that we weren't successful in stringing together in the previous 35 (minutes). We had some timely plays on the offensive end and a couple of mishaps that we didn't pay prices for." - Dave Leitao

Radford led 29-27 at halftime with Joey Lynch-Flohr's nine points leading the Highlanders. Zeglinski had nine first half points for the Cavaliers. Neither team led by more than four points in the second half before Virginia came from behind in the closing minute for the victory.

UVa shot 36.9 percent (24-65) from the field, including just 11.1 percent (1-9) from three-point range, and 79.2 percent (19-24 from the free throw line. The Cavaliers out-rebounded the Highlanders 43-40. Radford shot 38.7 percent (24-62) from the field, including 4-12 from three-point range, and 56.0 percent (14-25) from the free throw line. The Highlanders blocked 10 of the Cavaliers' shots in the game.

Ărtsiom Parakhouski had a double-double for Radford with 16 points and 12 rebounds. Lynch-Flohr finished with 15 points, while Martell McDuffy scored 13 points and Kenny Thomas 10 for the Highlanders

"By chance today, we made a play or two at the end or they didn't execute a play or two at the end, and we were fortunate to win. The Flames shot 56.6 percent (30-53) from the field for the game, including 50 percent (13-26) from three-point range. In the second half, Liberty shot 69.6 percent (16-23) from the field, including 60 percent (6-10) from three-point range. The Flames also shot 65 percent (13-20) from the free throw line, 72.2 percent (13-18) in the second half.

Sammy Zeglinski made the first start of his collegiate career and scored a career-high 24 points to lead the Cavaliers. Zeglinski also had a career high with six three-point field goals. Sylven Landesberg scored 17 points and had nine rebounds, Calvin Baker scored 15 points and had five assists, and Jeff Jones scored 10 points for Virginia. Mike Scott had a game-high 17 rebounds for the Cavaliers.


UVa shot 46.6 percent (27-58) from the field, including 40.6 percent (13-32) from three-point range, and 78.9 percent (15-19) from the free throw line.

A three-pointer by Curry at the buzzer gave Liberty a 35-32 halftime lead. The Flames ran off six consecutive points to take a seven-point lead (78-71) with 1:14 left in the game. Virginia closed to within two points (83-81) with 16 seconds remaining to play, but Liberty hung on for the victory.

Virginia out-rebounded the Flames 37-23.

The loss ended the Cavaliers' 36-game November home winning streak, UVa's 16-game winning streak against Big South opponents and Virginia's 15-game winning streak against non-conference in-state opponents.
