Tonight's Game

- The Cavaliers continue their four-game season-opening homestand tonight vs. USF
- Virginia looks to open the season 2-0 for the 10th consecutive year

About the Cavaliers

- The Cavaliers return three starters (Mamadi Diane, Mike Scott, Jeff Jones) from last year's squad
- Virginia went 17-16 last season and reached the CBI semifinals
- The Cavaliers topped VMI 107-97 in their season opener Sunday

About the Bulls

- USF opened the season with a 60-46 home victory over SMU on Friday
- The Bulls were 12-19 (3-15 Big East) last season
- USF returns four starters from last year's squad

Series History

- First meeting between the schools
- USF is the only first-time opponent on the Cavaliers' regular season schedule
- The Cavaliers have won their last 18 games against a first-time opponent, dating back to a loss to Gonzaga in the 2001 NCAA Tournament
- Dave Leitao was 2-1 against USF while at DePaul, when both teams were in Conference USA

November Success

- Virginia has posted a 14-3 record in November under Dave Leitao
- The Cavaliers have won 34 consecutive November home games dating back to a 94-83 loss to Ohio on November 18, 1994
- Virginia has a 4-2 record against ranked opponents in November since 2000

Series Against the Big East

- Tonight's game is Virginia's first game of two this season vs. Big East opponents (Syracuse)
- Virginia has a 53-56 all-time record against current members of the Big East (1-3 vs. Cincinnati, 2-6 vs. Connecticut, 0-2 vs. DePaul, 11-12 vs. Georgetown, 5-3 vs. Louisville, 3-1 vs. Marquette, 5-1 vs. Notre Dame, 7-3 vs. Pittsburgh, 3-3 vs. Providence, 3-0 vs. Rutgers, 0-3 vs. Seton Hall, 0-7 vs. St. John's, 1-2 vs. Syracuse, 4-2 vs. Villanova and 8-8 vs. West Virginia)
- UVa has lost five consecutive games against Big East opponents since an 80-65 win over Virginia Tech on Nov. 28, 2003 (when the Hokies were a member of the Big East)
- Virginia hasn't beaten a current member of the Big East since a 79-75 win over Georgetown on December 28, 2002

Last Time Out

- Virginia opened the 2008-09 season with a 107-97 victory over VMI on Sunday
- Sylven Landesberg led the Cavaliers with 28 points, eight rebounds and eight assists in his debut
- Mike Scott posted career-highs with 26 points and 18 rebounds

Landesberg Named ACC Rookie of the Week

- Sylven Landesberg was named the ACC Rookie of the Week on Nov. 17 for his play in the Cavaliers' 107-97 season opening victory over VMI
- Landesberg had 28 points, eight rebounds and eight assists in his collegiate debut
- He is the first Cavalier to win the award since Sean Singletary won it five times in 2004-05

Landesberg Shines In Collegiate Debut

- Sylven Landesberg had 28 points in the seasonopener against VMI, the most by a Cavalier freshman in his debut
- •The previous record was 24 points set by Jeff Lamp in his debut against James Madison on Nov. 25, 1977
- Landesberg's 28 points are tied for the second most in ACC history by a freshman in his first game
- Landesberg is one of only three Cavalier first-years to score 20 points in his first collegiate game
- His 28 points are the most by a UVa freshman in any game since Chris Williams had 34 points vs. Liberty on Dec. 8, 1998
- He is the first Cavalier to lead the team in scoring in a season opener since Mamadi Diane had 17 points in the 2005-06 season opening win over Liberty

Mike Scott Opens Year With Impressive Performance

- Mike Scott set career highs with 26 points and 18 rebounds in the season opening win over VMI
- Scott tied the school record with 10 offensive rebounds, a mark previously set by Matt Blundin (vs. Clemson 1/9/90), Bryant Stith (vs. Georgia Tech 3/13/92) and Travis Watson (vs. Maryland 1/31/02)
- His 18 rebounds were the most by a Cavalier since Travis Watson had 20 rebounds vs. Wofford on Jan. 2, 2003

Scott and Landesberg Post UVa's First 25-25 Combo in Over a Year

- Against VMI, Sylven Landesberg (28 pts) and Mike Scott (26 points) became the first Cavaliers to score at least 25 points in the same game in over a year
- The previous game that Virginia had a pair of 25-point scorers was a 71-58 win at NC State on Jan. 24, 2007 when J.R Reynolds had 29 points and Sean Singletary had 27 points

More Cavaliers Have Career Bests Against VMI

- In the shadows of the performances by Landesberg and Scott against VMI were several other Cavaliers who had career bests
- Jamil Tucker tied a career high with 14 points on a career-high six made field goals
- Calvin Baker had a career-high seven assists and tied a career-high with four steals



Win No. 500 for Leitao

- The Cavaliers' season-opening victory over VMI was the 500th career win of Dave Leitao's coaching career as both a head coach and as an assistant coach
- It was his 134th career win as a head coach to go along with 366 wins as a part of Jim Calhoun's staffs at Northeastern and Connecticut

Cavaliers 12th in ACC Preseason Poll

- The Cavaliers were projected 12th in the preseason ACC poll of media
- Sylven Landesberg was second in the voting for Preseason ACC Rookie of the Year

Difficult Schedule for the Cavaliers

- 16 of 27 regular season games will be against 2008 postseason teams (seven vs. NCAA teams, eight vs. NIT teams, one vs. CBI team)
- 21 of 27 games will be televised
- Four opponents are ranked and five others are receiving votes in this week's Associated Press poll

Virginia Visited Canada in August

- The Cavaliers went on a trip to Canada in August to play three games
- Virginia went 2-1 on the trip
- UVa defeated St. Lawrence College (Ont.) 107-60
- UVa defeated Concordia 85-70
- UVa lost to McGill 88-83
- Four players averaged in double figures on the trip (Calvin Baker 16.0, Jeff Jones -13.7, Sylven Landesberg 12.0, Mike Scott 10.7)

Head Coach Dave Leitao

- 2007 ACC Coach of the Year
- First Virginia coach to win the honor since Terry Holland in 1982
- 54-42 record in his fourth season at Virginia, including a 23-25 mark in the ACC
- Overall record of 134-111 in his ninth season as a head coach

At Home at John Paul Jones Arena

- Virginia has an all-time record of 30-8 at John Paul Jones Arena
- UVa was 13-7 at home during the 2007-08 season
- The Cavaliers posted a 16-1 home record in 2006-07 in the first season in John Paul Jones Arena

Baker, Diane, Soroye Named Virginia's Captains

- Calvin Baker, Mamadi Diane, and Tunji Soroye are Virginia's captains for 2008-09
- This season marks the first year each player has served as a captain

Sene to Be Held Out of Games

- Freshman center Assane Sene is being held out of games pending the resolution of his eligibility status
- He will continue to practice with the team
- "Because of a recent NCAA interpretation, there are some aspects of Assane's pre-college enrollment that must be reviewed further," Virginia Athletics Director Craig Littlepage said on Nov. 16. "We're looking to have this resolved quickly."
- Sene is from Saint-Louis, Senegal, and attended South Kent Preparatory School in Connecticut during the 2007-08 academic year
