- Virginia travels to Mexico for the 2009 Cancun Challenge
- The Cavaliers will play Stanford on Tuesday and either Cleveland State or Kentucky on Wednesday

SERIES HISTORIES:

- Tuesday's game is the seventh all-time meeting between Virginia and Stanford with the Cardinal leading the series 5-1
- The Cardinal have won the last four games in the series, including a 76-75 win in 2006-07, Virginia's first defeat in John Paul Jones Arena
- Tony Bennett was 2-5 vs. Stanford while at Washington State
- If Virginia plays Cleveland State, it will be the first ever meeting
- If Virginia plays Kentucky, it will be the 10th all-time meeting with UK leading the series 6-3
- The Cavaliers won the last meeting with the Wildcats, 75-61, in the semifinals of the 2002 Maui Invitational

CAVALIERS ABROAD:

- Virginia will play their ninth and 10th games outside of the USA this week
- The Cavaliers are 5-3 abroad (2-0 in Tokyo, Japan; 2-1 in Bayamon, P.R.; 1-2 in Guaynabo, P.R.)

LAST TIME OUT:

- Virginia defeated Oral Roberts 76-55 Saturday in Charlottesville
- Mike Scott led Virginia with 15 points and 10 rebounds
- Sylven Landesberg had 14 points, while Mustapha Farrakhan and Sammy Zeglinski each had 13 points

HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT:

- Head coach Tony Bennett is in his first season at Virginia (3-1 record)
- In his fourth season as a head coach, he has a career record of 72-34
- Bennett was the 2007 National Coach of the Year at Washington State

SENE MAKES DEBUT:

- Assane Sene made his season debut vs. Oral Roberts and had a careerhigh eight points, along with seven rebounds
- Sene was suspended for the first three games of the 2009-10 regular season by men's head basketball coach Tony Bennett for conduct detrimental to the team.
- He missed the Longwood, USF and Rider games

DEFENSE SHUTS DOWN RIDER:

- The Cavaliers held Rider to a JPJA record-low 46 points on Nov. 19
- The 46 points was the fewest allowed by Virginia since a 59-43 win at Richmond in 2005-06
- The 46 points was also 41 points below Rider's scoring average of 87 ppg

SHERRILL SHINES VS. RIDER:

- Will Sherrill made an impact off the bench against Rider
- Sherrill played a career-high 16 minutes, recording two points, a career-high six rebounds, one assist and one steal
- The six rebounds matched his total for his first two seasons combined

BENNETT VICTORIOUS IN DEBUT:

- Head coach Tony Bennett won his UVa debut, 85-72 vs. Longwood
- Of the 11 Virginia head coaches, he became the eighth to win his debut (Wins by Henry Lannigan, Gus Tebell, Evan "Bus" Male, Terry Holland, Jeff Jones, Pete Gillen, Dave Leitao and Tony Bennett)

CAREER HIGHS IN SEASON OPENER:

- Two Cavaliers had career highs in the season opener vs. Longwood
- Mustapha Farrakhan tied career highs with 17 points and four assists, while having a career-high five rebounds
- Sammy Zeglinski tied a career high with six rebounds

SHARP-SHOOTING 'HOOS:

- The Cavaliers shot 60.0% (30-50) from the field vs. Longwood
- \bullet It marked the first time Virginia shot 60.0% or higher since shooting 61.0% (36-59) against Long Island on Nov. 17, 2000

'HOOS BACK:

- Virginia returns 11 letterwinners, including all five starters, from 2008-09
- UVa is the only team in the ACC to return all five starters
- Only twice have the Cavaliers returned all five starters, 1990-91 and 2006-07, and in both years the team made the NCAA Tournament
- Virginia returns 90.5 percent of its scoring and 89.9 percent of its rebounding

LANDESBERG ON WATCH LISTS:

- Sophomore guard Sylven Landesberg has been named to a pair of preseason watch lists
- He is a preseason candidate for both the Naismith and Wooden awards
- Last season he led Virginia in scoring at 16.6 ppg as a freshman
- Landesberg was the 2008-09 ACC Rookie of the Year

CHALLENGING SCHEDULE:

- Five of Virginia's opponents this season (North Carolina, Duke, Georgia Tech, Clemson, Maryland) are currently ranked in the AP poll (11/16), as is Kentucky (a potential opponent in Cancun)
- Four other opponents (Florida State, Wake Forest, Rider, Boston College) are receiving votes

CAVALIERS 11TH IN ACC POLL:

• Virginia was picked 11th in the ACC preseason poll of media attending ACC Operation Basketball on Oct. 25

SCOTT DOUBLING IT UP:

- Mike Scott had a double-double (15 pts, 10 rebs) vs. Oral Roberts, his second of the season and his 12th career double-double
- His 12 double-doubles rank 20th in school history

TAT DOESN'T TRAVEL TO MEXICO

- Solomon Tat didn't make the trip to Mexico for the Cancun Challenge
- While the process is ongoing, Tat's visa status is not clarified and he won't be traveling internationally

TUCKER TAKES LEAVE OF ABSENCE:

- Jamil Tucker is taking an indefinite leave of absence from the team to focus on personal matters
- Head coach Tony Bennett announced the leave on Nov. 11

FIVE SIGN WITH VIRGINIA:

- Virginia signed five players to National Letters of Intent this month for the 2010 recruiting class
