## TONIGHT'S GAME:

-Virginia opens its ACC home schedule tonight as it hosts Georgia Tech - The Cavaliers enter the game on a five-game winning streak, their longest since the start of the 2007-08 season
-The game opens a three-game homestand for UVa, the first two games coming against ranked ACC opponents
-Virginia is looking to open in the ACC 2-0 for the first time since 1994-95

## SERIES HISTORY:

- Georgia Tech leads 38-30 (UVa leads 17-11 in Charlottesville, 1-1 at JPJA) - Last season the Cavaliers won the only meeting between the schools, 88-84 in overtime at Alexander Memorial Coliseum
-The road team has won the last three regular season meetings
-Tonight's game is the only regular season meeting this season


## AGAINST RANKED OPPONENTS:

- GT is Virginia's second opponent of the season to be ranked by the AP
-Virginia defeated then-No. 24 UAB 72-63 on Dec. 30 at JPJA
-The Cavaliers are $5-5$ vs. ranked opponents at JPJA (3-4 vs. ACC)


## LAST TIME OUT:

-Virginia won 70-62 at NC State Saturday in its ACC Opener

- Sylven Landesberg led Virginia with 23 points
-The Cavaliers went 19-20 from the free throw line (making their last 17) -Virginia rallied from a 10-point deficit with 12:35 remaining in the 2nd Half -Tony Bennett joined Jeff Jones and Billy McCann as the only UVa coaches to win their first ACC game

## WINNING STREAK:

-The Cavaliers enter tonight's game on a five-game winning streak

- It is Virginia's longest win streak since winning the first five games in 2007-08
-The last time UVa won six straight games was a seven-game win streak in 2006-07


## LOOKING FOR 2-0 START IN THE ACC:

-The Cavaliers are looking to open ACC play with a 2-0 record for the first time since opening the 1994-95 conference season with a 4-0 record -That team included UVa assistant coach Jason Williford, UVa strength and conditioning coach Mike Curtis and UVa radio analyst Cory Alexander

## HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT:

- Head coach Tony Bennett is in his first season at Virginia (9-4 record)
- In his fourth season as a head coach, he has a career record of 78-37
- Bennett was the 2007 National Coach of the Year at Washington State


## AT JOHN PAUL JONES ARENA:

- Virginia is 45-17 all-time at John Paul Jones Arena
-The Cavaliers are 7-1 at JPJA this season


## JPJA RECOGNIZED:

- John Paul Jones Arena was named the best new college basketball arena of the decade by SI.com
-The arena was recognized in Seth Davis'story about the highlights of the decade


## BIG WINS, CLOSE LOSSES:

- Seven of Virginia's nine wins this season have been by double digits
(The Cavaliers had just five double-digit wins all of last season)
- Three of Virginia's four losses this season have been by five points or less


## TAKING CARE OF THE BALL:

-Virginia currently ranks fifth nationally in fewest turnovers a game at 10.5 turnovers per game

- Last season, the Cavaliers averaged 14.8 tpg, ranking 242nd nationally -Virginia has had 10 or fewer turnovers in eight games this season


## INCREASED SCORING:

- Five Cavalier players are scoring at least 1.5 pts more per game than they did last season -Will Sherrill, who is scoring 4.2 ppg more than last season, leads the group
-Three of the five players are scoring at least

## ON TARGET FROM 3-POINT RANGE:

- Virginia ranks first in the ACC and sixth nationally in 3-point percentage at 42.3 percent (88-208)
- Last season, the Cavaliers ranked 242 nd nationally at 31.6 percent (156-494)
- Sammy Zeglinski ranks 14th nationally in 3-point percentage at 50.8\% (32-63)
- Last year Zeglinski led UVa in 3-pointers with 33 for the entire season and enters tonight's game one shy of that mark
- Jeff Jones (45.0 percent, 18-40), Sylven Landesberg (41.2 percent, 7-17), Will Sherrill (40.9 percent, 9-22) and Jontel Evans (40.0 percent, 2-5) are also shooting 40.0 percent or better from behind the arc


## LONG RANGE FIRING:

- Against both Penn State and Cleveland State, the Cavaliers shot over 50.0 percent from 3-point range
- Against Penn State, Virginia shot 53.3 percent (8-15) from 3-point range
- Against Cleveland State, Virginia shot 58.8 percent (10-17) from 3-point range - It was the first time the Cavaliers shot over 50.0 percent from long range in consecutive games since doing it against Ohio and Tennessee in 2000-01 - Virginia also shot over 50.0 percent from 3-point range vs. Texas-Pan American (7-12, 58.3 percent)


## SHARP SHOOTING 'HOOS:

- Against Texas-Pan American the Cavaliers shot 56.6 percent from the floor, the fifth time this season they have shot at least 50.0 percent from the field - Last season, UVa shot 50.0 percent just four times all season (28 games)


## LANDESBERG A CONSISTENT SCORER:

- Sylven Landesberg has scored in double figures every game this season
- He is one of just two players in the ACC to accomplish the feat (Jon Scheyer of Duke)
- Landesberg has scored 20 or more points five times this season, including the last two games


## BAKER TAKING CARE OF THE BALL:

- Calvin Baker has 31 assists this season to just eight turnovers
- That 3.9 assist-to-turnover ratio would rank second in the ACC and in the top five nationally if he met the 3.0 assists/per game minimum (Baker is at 2.6)
- Baker has had 20 assists in the last four games


## SCOTT DOUBLING IT UP:

- Mike Scott had a double-double (17 pts, 11 rebs) vs. Penn State, his third of the season and his 13th career double-double
- His 13 double-doubles rank 20th in school history
- Scott's 13 career double-doubles are tied for the sixth highest total in the

ACC among active players

## RETURN TO SENE-DER:

- Assane Sene had a career-high five blocks vs. Hampton on Dec. 23
- Sene leads the Cavaliers at 1.8 blocks per game


## DEFENSE SHINES AGAINST NJIT:

-The UVa defense put up a strong performance in the 68-37 win over NJTT - NJIT's 37 points were the fewest allowed by the Cavaliers since 1996-97 (34 vs. UMBC) and is tied for the second fewest allowed in the shot clock era

- NJIT's 13 made FGs is tied for the fourth lowest total allowed by the Cavaliers since 1953
- NJIT's $27.1 \%$ shooting (13-48) was the lowest percentage allowed by the Cavaliers since Longwood shot $25.8 \%$ (16-62) against the Cavaliers on Feb. 13, 2007


## SHERRILL EN FUEGO SOUTH OF THE BORDER:

- Against Cleveland State in Cancun, junior forward Will Sherrill had his career game
- He set career highs with 18 points, seven FGs, four 3FGs, two assists, three steals and tied a career high with six rebounds
- Prior to the game, Sherrill had scored just 15 points in his career, and his career high in a game was three points


## CAVALIERS SHOOT WELL AGAINST LONGWOOD:

- The Cavaliers shot $60.0 \%$ (30-50) from the field vs. Longwood
- It marked the first time Virginia shot 60.0\% or higher since shooting 61.0\% (36-59) against Long Island on Nov. 17, 2000


## CHALLENGING SCHEDULE:

- Six of Virginia's opponents this season (Duke, North Carolina, Georgia Tech, Miami, Clemson, Florida State) are currently ranked in the AP poll (1/11)
-Three other opponents (UAB, Wake Forest, Virginia Tech) are receiving votes


## CAVALIERS 11TH IN ACC POLL:

-Virginia was picked 11th in the ACC preseason poll of media attending ACC Operation Basketball on Oct. 25

## FIVE SIGN WITH VIRGINIA:

-Virginia signed five players to National Letters of Intent in November for the 2010 recruiting class
-The five players are 6-4 guard K.T. Harrell of Montgomery, Ala.; 6-6 guard Joe Harris from Chelan, Wash.; 6-9 forward James Johnson of Wildomar, Calif.; 6-7 wing Akil Mitchell of Charlotte, N.C.; and 6-8 forward Will Regan of Williamsville, N.Y.

## UNCW GAME RESCHEDULED:

-The Virginia-UNC Wilmington game has been rescheduled for Jan. 18
-The game was originally scheduled for Dec. 19 but had to be postponed due to snow

- Game time is 7 p.m. and the game will not be televised


## UPNEXT:

-The Cavaliers will continue their homestand on Saturday when they host No. 23 Miami

- Game time at John Paul Jones Arena is 8 p.m.
