- Virginia continue its homestand tonight as it hosts Hampton
- It is the second consecutive year UVa and Hampton have met on Dec. 23

SERIES HISTORY:

- Tonight's game is the sixth meeting between the schools, with Virginia winning each of the previous five matchups
- The teams are playing for the fourth consecutive season at JPJA
- Last season the Cavaliers won 74-48 over Hampton

AGAINST THE MEAC:

- Tonight's game is the only game for Virginia this season against a MEAC foe
- Virginia has a 13-0 all-time record against current members of the MEAC (1-0 vs. Bethune Cookman, 1-0 vs. Coppin State, 5-0 vs. Hampton, 3-0 vs. Howard, 1-0 vs. Maryland-Eastern Shore, 1-0 vs. Morgan State, 1-0 vs. North Carolina A&T)
- The Cavaliers are 6-0 against MEAC teams at John Paul Jones Arena, with an average margin of victory of 26.8 points in those games

AGAINST THE COMMONWEALTH:

- Since the 1999-2000 season, Virginia has a 34-7 record against teams from the Commonwealth of Virginia (29-3 vs. non-conference opponents)
- The Cavaliers are 25-2 at home against in-state foes during that time
- UVa has a 13-2 record against in-state opponents at John Paul Jones Arena

LAST TIME OUT:

- Virginia defeated NJIT 68-37 Monday night at JPJA
- The Cavaliers had nine players score at least four points

HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT:

- Head coach Tony Bennett is in his first season at Virginia (5-4 record)
- In his fourth season as a head coach, he has a career record of 74-37
- Bennett was the 2007 National Coach of the Year at Washington State

AT JOHN PAUL JONES ARENA:

- Virginia is 42-17 all-time at John Paul Jones Arena
- The Cavaliers are 4-1 at JPJA this season
- Against non-conference opponents, Virginia is 28-7 at JPJA

JPJA RECOGNIZED:

- John Paul Jones Arena was named the best new college basketball arena of the decade by SI.com
- The arena was recognized in Seth Davis' story about the highlights of the decade

BIG WINS, CLOSE LOSSES:

- All five of Virginia's wins this season have been by double digits
- Three of Virginia's four losses this season have been by five points or less

TAKING CARE OF THE BALL:

- Virginia currently ranks fourth nationally in fewest turnovers a game at 10.2 turnovers per game
- Last season, the Cavaliers averaged 14.8 tpg, ranking 242nd nationally
- Virginia has had 10 or fewer turnovers in seven games this season

DEFENSE SHINES AGAINST NJIT:

- The UVa defense put up a strong performance in the 68-37 win over NJIT
- NJIT's 37 points were the fewest allowed by the Cavaliers since 1996-97 (34 vs. UMBC) and is tied for the second fewest allowed in the shot clock era
- NJIT's 13 made FGs is tied for the fourth lowest total allowed by the Cavaliers since 1953
- NJIT's 27.1% shooting (13-48) was the lowest percentage allowed by the Cavaliers since Longwood shot 25.8 % (16-62) against the Cavaliers on Feb. 13, 2007

LONG RANGE FIRING:

- Against both Penn State and Cleveland State, the Cavaliers shot over 50.0 percent from 3-point range
- Against Penn State, Virginia shot 53.3 percent (8-15) from 3-point range
- Against Cleveland State, Virginia shot 58.8 percent (10-17) from 3-point range
- It was the first time the Cavaliers shot over 50.0 percent from long range in consecutive games since doing it against Ohio and Tennessee in 2000-01

SHARP SHOOTING 'HOOS:

- Against Cleveland State, the Cavaliers shot over 50.0 percent (52.8) from the floor for the third time this season
- Last season, UVa shot over 50.0 percent just four times all season (28 games)

SHERRILL EN FUEGO SOUTH OF THE BORDER:

- Against Cleveland State in Cancun, junior forward Will Sherrill had his career game
- He set career highs with 18 points, seven FGs, four 3FGs, two assists, three steals and tied a career high with six rebounds
- Prior to the game, Sherrill had scored just 15 points in his career, and his career high in a game was three points

SCOTT DOUBLING IT UP:

- Mike Scott had a double-double (17 pts, 11 rebs) vs. Penn State, his third of the season and his 13th career double-double
- His 13 double-doubles rank 20th in school history
- Scott's 13 career double-doubles are tied for the sixth highest total in the ACC among active players

BENNETT VICTORIOUS IN DEBUT:

- Head coach Tony Bennett won his UVa debut, 85-72 vs. Longwood
- Of the 11 Virginia head coaches, he became the eighth to win his debut (Wins by Henry Lannigan, Gus Tebell, Evan "Bus" Male, Terry Holland, Jeff Jones, Pete Gillen, Dave Leitao and Tony Bennett)

CAREER HIGHS IN SEASON OPENER:

- Two Cavaliers had career highs in the season opener vs. Longwood
- Mustapha Farrakhan tied career highs with 17 points and four assists, while having a career-high five rebounds
- Sammy Zeglinski tied a career high with six rebounds

CAVALIERS SHOOT WELL AGAINST LONGWOOD:

- The Cavaliers shot 60.0% (30-50) from the field vs. Longwood
- It marked the first time Virginia shot 60.0% or higher since shooting 61.0% (36-59) against Long Island on Nov. 17, 2000

LANDESBERG ON WATCH LISTS:

- Sophomore guard Sylven Landesberg has been named to a pair of preseason watch lists
- He is a preseason candidate for both the Naismith and Wooden awards
- Last season he led Virginia in scoring at 16.6 ppg as a freshman
- Landesberg was the 2008-09 ACC Rookie of the Year

CHALLENGING SCHEDULE:

- Three of Virginia's opponents this season (North Carolina, Duke, Clemson) are currently ranked in the AP poll (12/21)
- Seven other opponents (Florida State, Georgia Tech, Miami, UAB, NC State, Wake Forest, Virginia Tech) are receiving votes
