### **TONIGHT'S GAME:**

- Virginia returns home to host Penn State in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge
- The Cavaliers are 5-4 all-time in the Challenge, including a 4-0 home record

### **SERIES HISTORY:**

- Tonight's game is the eighth all-time meeting between Virginia and Penn State with the Cavaliers leading the series 5-2
- The teams haven't met since the 1984-85 season
- The Cavaliers are 3-0 vs. Penn State at home, although the Nittany Lions haven't visited Charlottesville since 1977-78

### **BIG TEN/ACC CHALLENGE HISTORY:**

- Virginia has a 5-4 record in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge
- The Cavaliers are 4-0 at home in the Challenge (3-0 at U-Hall, 1-0 at JPJA)
- Last year, Virginia lost 66-56 at Minnesota in the Challenge
- Two years ago, the last time they hosted a Challenge game, the Cavaliers topped Northwestern 94-52, still the largest margin of victory in the series
- The ACC has won all 10 previous Challenges

### **LAST TIME OUT:**

- Virginia defeated Cleveland State 76-65 in Cancun, Mexico on Wednesday
- Sylven Landesberg led UVa with 20 points, his 14th career 20-point game
- Will Sherrill set career highs with 18 points, seven FGs, four 3FGs, two assists, three steals and tied a career high with six rebounds
- The Cavaliers rallied from a seven-point halftime deficit (34-27) for victory, the largest halftime deficit they have overcome to win since rallying from eight down at the break (37-29) vs. Old Dominion in the 2008 CBI Quarterfinals

### **AGAINST THE BIG TEN:**

- Tonight's game is UVa's only regular season game against a Big Ten opponent
- Virginia has a 17-17 all-time record against current members of the Big Ten (1-2 vs. Indiana, 0-1 vs. Iowa, 1-2 vs. Michigan, 0-3 vs. Michigan State, 4-2 vs. Minnesota, 3-0 vs. Northwestern, 1-3 vs. Ohio State, 5-2 vs. Penn State, 1-1 vs. Purdue, 1-1 vs. Wisconsin)

### **HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT:**

- Head coach Tony Bennett is in his first season at Virginia (4-2 record)
- In his fourth season as a head coach, he has a career record of 73-35
- Bennett was the 2007 National Coach of the Year at Washington State

### AT JOHN PAUL JONES ARENA:

- Virginia is 41-16 all-time at John Paul Jones Arena
- The Cavaliers are 3-0 at JPJA this season and have won four in a row at home
- Against non-conference opponents, Virginia is 27-6 at JPJA

### **SHARP SHOOTING 'HOOS:**

- Against Cleveland State, the Cavaliers shot over 50.0 percent (52.8) from the floor for the third time in six games this season
- Last season, UVa shot over 50.0 percent just four times all season (28 games)

### **LONG RANGE FIRING:**

- Against Cleveland State, Virginia shot 58.8 percent (10-17) from 3-point range
- It was the first time UVa was over 50.0 percent from long range since shooting 57.1 percent (12-21) at Arizona on Nov. 17, 2007

### SHERRILL EN FUEGO SOUTH OF THE BORDER:

- Against Cleveland State in Cancun, junior forward Will Sherrill had his career game
- He set career highs with 18 points, seven FGs, four 3FGs, two assists, three steals and tied a career high with six rebounds
- Prior to the game, Sherrill had scored just 15 points in his career, and his career high in a game was three points

### **SENE MAKES DEBUT:**

- Assane Sene made his season debut vs. Oral Roberts and had a careerhigh eight points, along with seven rebounds
- Sene was suspended for the first three games of the 2009-10 regular season by men's head basketball coach Tony Bennett for conduct detrimental to the team.
- He missed the Longwood, USF and Rider games

### **DEFENSE SHUTS DOWN RIDER:**

- The Cavaliers held Rider to a JPJA record-low 46 points on Nov. 19
- The 46 points was the fewest allowed by Virginia since a 59-43 win at Richmond in 2005-06
- The 46 points was also 41 points below Rider's scoring average of 87 ppg

### **BENNETT VICTORIOUS IN DEBUT:**

- Head coach Tony Bennett won his UVa debut, 85-72 vs. Longwood
- Of the 11 Virginia head coaches, he became the eighth to win his debut (Wins by Henry Lannigan, Gus Tebell, Evan "Bus" Male, Terry Holland, Jeff Jones, Pete Gillen, Dave Leitao and Tony Bennett)

### **CAREER HIGHS IN SEASON OPENER:**

- Two Cavaliers had career highs in the season opener vs. Longwood
- Mustapha Farrakhan tied career highs with 17 points and four assists, while having a career-high five rebounds
- Sammy Zeglinski tied a career high with six rebounds

### **CAVALIERS SHOOT WELL AGAINST LONGWOOD:**

- The Cavaliers shot 60.0% (30-50) from the field vs. Longwood
- It marked the first time Virginia shot 60.0% or higher since shooting 61.0% (36-59) against Long Island on Nov. 17, 2000

### **'HOOS BACK:**

- Virginia returns 11 letterwinners, including all five starters, from 2008-09
- UVa is the only team in the ACC to return all five starters
- Only twice have the Cavaliers returned all five starters, 1990-91 and 2006-07, and in both years the team made the NCAA Tournament
- Virginia returns 90.5 percent of its scoring and 89.9 percent of its rebounding

### **LANDESBERG ON WATCH LISTS:**

- Sophomore guard Sylven Landesberg has been named to a pair of preseason watch lists
- He is a preseason candidate for both the Naismith and Wooden awards
- Last season he led Virginia in scoring at 16.6 ppg as a freshman
- Landesberg was the 2008-09 ACC Rookie of the Year

### **CHALLENGING SCHEDULE:**

- Four of Virginia's opponents this season (North Carolina, Duke, Clemson, Maryland) are currently ranked in the AP poll (11/23)
- Four other opponents (Florida State, Georgia Tech, Wake Forest, Miami) are receiving votes

### **CAVALIERS 11TH IN ACC POLL:**

• Virginia was picked 11th in the ACC preseason poll of media attending ACC Operation Basketball on Oct. 25

### **SCOTT DOUBLING IT UP:**

- Mike Scott had a double-double (15 pts, 10 rebs) vs. Oral Roberts, his second of the season and his 12th career double-double
- His 12 double-doubles rank 20th in school history



### **TUCKER RETURNS TO PRACTICE:**

- Jamil Tucker is back practicing with the Virginia men's basketball team, but will not be in uniform for games at this time
- Tucker has been practicing with the team since Friday (Nov. 27)
- Tucker took a leave of absence from the team to focus on personal matters, beginning on Nov. 11

### **FIVE SIGN WITH VIRGINIA:**

- Virginia signed five players to National Letters of Intent this month for the 2010 recruiting class
- The five players are 6-4 guard K.T. Harrell of Montgomery, Ala.; 6-6 guard Joe Harris from Chelan, Wash.; 6-9 forward James Johnson of Wildomar, Calif.; 6-7 wing Akil Mitchell of Charlotte, N.C.; and 6-8 forward Will Regan of Williamsville, N.Y




