- Virginia returns home to host Rider
- The game was scheduled as part of the Cancun Challenge
- First of two home games for the Cavaliers in the Cancun Challenge
- Rider is the first Cavalier opponent this season to be receiving votes in the Associated Press poll

SERIES HISTORY:

- First ever meeting between the schools
- Rider is the first of potentially five first-time opponents on UVa's schedule
- The Cavaliers have won their last 18 games against a first-time opponent, dating back to a loss to Gonzaga in the 2001 NCAA Tournament

LAST TIME OUT:

- Virginia suffered a 66-49 loss at USF on Monday
- Sylven Landesberg led Virginia with 14 points
- It was the Cavaliers' 11th consecutive loss in the state of Florida

AGAINST THE MAAC:

- Tonight is the only regular-season game for UVa vs. a MAAC opponent
- The Cavaliers have not played a team from the MAAC since a 98-59 win over Loyola (Md.) in 2005-06
- Virginia has a 13-0 all-time record against current members of the MAAC (1-0 vs. Canisius, 2-0 vs. Fairfield, 1-0 vs. Iona, 7-0 vs. Loyola (Md.), 1-0 vs. Manhattan, 1-0 vs. Siena)

BENNETT VICTORIOUS IN DEBUT:

- Head coach Tony Bennett won his UVa last week, 85-72 vs. Longwood
- Of the 11 Virginia head coaches, he became the eighth to win his debut (Wins by Henry Lannigan, Gus Tebell, Evan "Bus" Male, Terry Holland, Jeff Jones, Pete Gillen, Dave Leitao and Tony Bennett)

HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT:

- Head coach Tony Bennett is in his first season at Virginia (1-1 record)
- In his fourth season as a head coach, he has a career record of 70-34
- Bennett was the 2007 National Coach of the Year at Washington State

CAREER HIGHS IN SEASON OPENER:

- Two Cavaliers had career highs in the season opener vs. Longwood
- Mustapha Farrakhan tied career highs with 17 points and four assists, while having a career-high five rebounds
- Sammy Zeglinski tied a career high with six rebounds

SHARP-SHOOTING 'HOOS:

- The Cavaliers shot 60.0% (30-50) from the field vs. Longwood
- It marked the first time Virginia shot 60.0% or higher since shooting 61.0% (36-59) against Long Island on Nov. 17, 2000

'HOOS BACK:

- Virginia returns 11 letterwinners, including all five starters, from 2008-09
- UVa is the only team in the ACC to return all five starters
- Only twice have the Cavaliers returned all five starters, 1990-91 and 2006-07, and in both years the team made the NCAA Tournament
- Virginia returns 90.5 percent of its scoring and 89.9 percent of its rebounding

LANDESBERG ON WATCH LISTS:

- Sophomore guard Sylven Landesberg has been named to a pair of preseason watch lists
- He is a preseason candidate for both the Naismith and Wooden awards
- Last season he led Virginia in scoring at 16.6 ppg as a freshman
- Landesberg was the 2008-09 ACC Rookie of the Year

CHALLENGING SCHEDULE:

- Five of Virginia's opponents this season (North Carolina, Duke, Georgia Tech, Clemson, Maryland) are currently ranked in the AP poll, as is Kentucky (a potential opponent in Cancun)
- Four other opponents (Florida State, Wake Forest, Rider, Boston College) are receiving votes

SCOTT DOUBLING IT UP:

- His 11 double-doubles rank 21st in school history
