TONIGHT'S GAME:

- Virginia plays its first ranked opponent of the year as it hosts #24 UAB
- The game is the third of a four-game homestand for the Cavaliers

SERIES HISTORY:

- Tonight's game is the second meeting between the schools
- UAB won the only previous meeting, 68-66, in the 1982 NCAA Tournament in Birmingham
- Virginia head coach Tony Bennett is 1-0 against UAB, as his Washington State team topped the Blazers 71-60 in Milwaukee, Wis., in 2006-07 (Bennett's first game as a collegiate head coach)

AGAINST CONFERENCE USA:

- Tonight's game is the only game for Virginia this season against a C-USA foe
- It is the first game ever for the Cavaliers against a team from C-USA
- Virginia has a 15-6 all-time record against current members of C-USA, all played before C-USA was founded in 1995-96
- (1-0 vs. East Carolina, 3-3 vs. Houston, 6-2 vs. Marshall, 2-0 vs. Rice, 3-0 vs. Tulane, 0-1 vs. UAB)

AGAINST RANKED OPPONENTS:

- UAB is Virginia's first opponent of the season to be ranked by the AP
- UVa's last win over a ranked opponent was an 85-81 overtime win over No. 12 Clemson on Feb. 15, 2009
- The Cavaliers are 4-5 vs. ranked opponents at JPJA, including a 1-1 record against non-conference ranked opponents

LAST TIME OUT:

- Virginia defeated Hampton 80-54 on Dec. 23 at JPJA
- Sylven Landesberg (14 pts, 12 rebs) had his first career double-double

HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT:

- Head coach Tony Bennett is in his first season at Virginia (6-4 record)
- In his fourth season as a head coach, he has a career record of 75-37
- Bennett was the 2007 National Coach of the Year at Washington State

AT JOHN PAUL JONES ARENA:

- Virginia is 43-17 all-time at John Paul Jones Arena
- The Cavaliers are 5-1 at JPJA this season
- Against non-conference opponents, Virginia is 29-7 at JPJA

JPJA RECOGNIZED:

- John Paul Jones Arena was named the best new college basketball arena of the decade by SI.com
- The arena was recognized in Seth Davis' story about the highlights of the decade

BIG WINS, CLOSE LOSSES:

- All six of Virginia's wins this season have been by double digits (The Cavaliers had just five double-digit wins all of last season)
- Three of Virginia's four losses this season have been by five points or less

TAKING CARE OF THE BALL:

- Virginia currently ranks fifth nationally in fewest turnovers a game at 10.3 turnovers per game
- Last season, the Cavaliers averaged 14.8 tpg, ranking 242nd nationally
- Virginia has had 10 or fewer turnovers in seven games this season

SHARP SHOOTING 'HOOS:

- Against Hampton the Cavaliers shot 50.0 percent from the floor, the fourth time this season they have shot at least 50.0 percent from the field
- Last season, UVa shot 50.0 percent just four times all season (28 games)

DEFENSE SHINES AGAINST NJIT:

- The UVa defense put up a strong performance in the 68-37 win over NJIT
- \bullet NJIT's 37 points were the fewest allowed by the Cavaliers since 1996-97 (34 vs. UMBC) and is tied for the second fewest allowed in the shot clock era
- NJIT's 13 made FGs is tied for the fourth lowest total allowed by the Cavaliers since 1953
- NJIT's 27.1% shooting (13-48) was the lowest percentage allowed by the Cavaliers since Longwood shot 25.8% (16-62) against the Cavaliers on Feb. 13, 2007

LONG RANGE FIRING:

- Against both Penn State and Cleveland State, the Cavaliers shot over 50.0 percent from 3-point range
- Against Penn State, Virginia shot 53.3 percent (8-15) from 3-point range
- Against Cleveland State, Virginia shot 58.8 percent (10-17) from 3-point range
- It was the first time the Cavaliers shot over 50.0 percent from long range in consecutive games since doing it against Ohio and Tennessee in 2000-01

RETURN TO SENE-DER:

- · Assane Sene had a career-high five blocks vs. Hampton on Dec. 23
- Sene leads the Cavaliers at 1.8 blocks per game

SCOTT DOUBLING IT UP:

- Mike Scott had a double-double (17 pts, 11 rebs) vs. Penn State, his third of the season and his 13th career double-double
- His 13 double-doubles rank 20th in school history
- Scott's 13 career double-doubles are tied for the sixth highest total in the ACC among active players

SHERRILL EN FUEGO SOUTH OF THE BORDER:

- Against Cleveland State in Cancun, junior forward Will Sherrill had his career game
- He set career highs with 18 points, seven FGs, four 3FGs, two assists, three steals and tied a career high with six rebounds
- Prior to the game, Sherrill had scored just 15 points in his career, and his career high in a game was three points

BENNETT VICTORIOUS IN DEBUT:

- Head coach Tony Bennett won his UVa debut, 85-72 vs. Longwood
- Of the 11 Virginia head coaches, he became the eighth to win his debut (Wins by Henry Lannigan, Gus Tebell, Evan "Bus" Male, Terry Holland, Jeff Jones, Pete Gillen, Dave Leitao and Tony Bennett)

CAREER HIGHS IN SEASON OPENER:

- Two Cavaliers had career highs in the season opener vs. Longwood
- Mustapha Farrakhan tied career highs with 17 points and four assists, while having a career-high five rebounds
- Sammy Zeglinski tied a career high with six rebounds

CAVALIERS SHOOT WELL AGAINST LONGWOOD:

- The Cavaliers shot 60.0% (30-50) from the field vs. Longwood
- It marked the first time Virginia shot 60.0% or higher since shooting 61.0% (36-59) against Long Island on Nov. 17, 2000

LANDESBERG ON WATCH LISTS:

- Sophomore guard Sylven Landesberg has been named to a pair of preseason watch lists
- He is a preseason candidate for both the Naismith and Wooden awards
- Last season he led Virginia in scoring at 16.6 ppg as a freshman
- Landesberg was the 2008-09 ACC Rookie of the Year



CHALLENGING SCHEDULE:

- Five of Virginia's opponents this season (Duke, North Carolina, Clemson, Florida State, UAB) are currently ranked in the AP poll (12/28)
- Four other opponents (Georgia Tech, Miami, Wake Forest, Virginia Tech) are receiving votes

CAVALIERS 11TH IN ACC POLL:

 Virginia was picked 11th in the ACC preseason poll of media attending ACC Operation Basketball on Oct. 25

FIVE SIGN WITH VIRGINIA:

- Virginia signed five players to National Letters of Intent last month for the 2010 recruiting class
- The five players are 6-4 guard K.T. Harrell of Montgomery, Ala.; 6-6 guard Joe Harris from Chelan, Wash.; 6-9 forward James Johnson of Wildomar, Calif.; 6-7 wing Akil Mitchell of Charlotte, N.C.; and 6-8 forward Will Regan of Williamsville, N.Y.

UNCW GAME RESCHEDULED:

- The Virginia-UNC Wilmington game has been rescheduled for Jan. 18
- The game was originally scheduled for Dec. 19 but had to be postponed due to snow
- A game time will not be set until after it's determined whether the game will be televised

UP NEXT:

- The Cavaliers conclude their homestand on Jan. 5 against Texas-Pan American
- Game time at John Paul Jones Arena is 7 p.m.
