#### **TONIGHT'S GAME:**

- Virginia looks to snap a two-game losing streak as it visits North Carolina
- The Cavaliers are looking for their first win in Chapel Hill since 2001-02

#### **SERIES HISTORY:**

- UNC leads series 124-48 (UNC leads 63-5 in Chapel Hill, 21-2 at Smith Center)
- The Tar Heels have won six straight in series, including both meetings last season
- Tonight's game is the only regular season meeting this season

#### **CAVALIERS FIRE FROM LONG RANGE IN DEAN DOME:**

- Last season, UVa had one of its best 3-point shooting games of the season at North Carolina
- UVa shot a season-high 50.0% (10-20) from long range
- That game is the only time in the past five seasons that Virginia has shot 50.0% from 3-point range in an ACC road game
- Jeff Jones was 3-5 from 3-point range in the game as he scored an ACC career-high 19 points

#### **LAST TIME OUT:**

- Virginia had its seven-game home win streak snapped with a 76-71 overtime loss to Virginia Tech on Thursday
- Mike Scott led UVa with 21 points and eight rebounds

#### **BIG WINS, CLOSE LOSSES:**

- Eight of Virginia's 12 wins this season have been by double digits (*The Cavaliers had just five double-digit wins all of last season*)
- Four of Virginia's six losses this season have been by five points or less

#### **CAVALIERS SURPASS WIN TOTAL:**

- Through 18 games of the regular season, Virginia has already surpassed its win total of 10 from last season with 12 this season
- UVa is already one win shy of last season's total of four ACC wins

#### PARTY LIKE IT'S 1995:

- This season's team has accomplished several feats that haven't been done at Virginia since the 1994-95 season
- Virginia's first 3-0 start in the ACC since 1994-95
- UVa was the last unbeaten team in ACC play for the first time since 1994-95
- The last time UVa had three ranked wins 15 games into a season was in 1994-95
- That 1994-95 team included UVa assistant coach Jason Williford, UVa strength and conditioning coach Mike Curtis and UVa radio analyst Cory Alexander

#### **THESE CAVS CAN SCORE:**

• To this point in the 2009-10 season, UVa has improved its offense in numerous statistical categories compared to the team's final 2008-09 statistics

- Virginia has improved its points per game, FG percentage, 3FG percentage, FT percentage, and assists/game from last season
- In conference games this season, Virginia is tied for fourth in the ACC at 71.0 points per game in conference play

#### TAKING CARE OF THE BALL:

- Virginia currently ranks sixth nationally in fewest turnovers a game at 10.6 turnovers per game
- Last season, the Cavaliers averaged 14.8 tpg, ranking 242nd nationally
- Virginia has had 10 or fewer turnovers in 10 games this season
- UVa ranks 24th nationally in assist-to-turnover ratio at 1.29
- Last season, UVa ranked 245th nationally with a 0.84 A/TO ratio

### **THEY CALL THEM FREE THROWS FOR A REASON:**

- Virginia ranks second in the ACC and 21st nationally in free throw percentage at 74.5 percent (245-329)
- UVa is shooting 76.0 percent from the line (76-100) in ACC play
- $\bullet$  From the 12:57 mark of the second half at NC State (1/9) to the 5:56 mark of the first half vs. Georgia Tech (1/13), the Cavaliers made 22 consecutive free throws as a team

#### **70 IS A MAGIC NUMBER:**

- Scoring 70 points has been the magic number for the Cavaliers this season
- Virginia is 10-1 this season when scoring at least 70 points and 2-5 this season when scoring less than 70 points

- Will Sherrill, who is scoring 3.5 ppg more than last season, leads the group

#### **ON TARGET FROM 3-POINT RANGE:**

- Virginia ranks first in the ACC and 21st nationally in 3-point percentage at 39.5 percent (113-286)
- Last season, the Cavaliers ranked 242nd nationally at 31.6 percent (156-494)
- Sammy Zeglinski is second in the ACC in 3-point percentage at 45.5% (40-88)
- Zeglinski already has more 3-pointers this season with 40 than last season when he led the team with 33 3-pointers
- Jeff Jones is shooting 43.1% (25-58) from 3-point range overall and 50.0% (9-18) during ACC play

#### **LONG RANGE FIRING:**

- Against both Penn State and Cleveland State, the Cavaliers shot over 50.0 percent from 3-point range
- Against Penn State, Virginia shot 53.3 percent (8-15) from 3-point range
- Against Cleveland State, Virginia shot 58.8 percent (10-17) from 3-point range
- It was the first time the Cavaliers shot over 50.0 percent from long range in consecutive games since doing it against Ohio and Tennessee in 2000-01
- Virginia also shot over 50.0 percent from 3-point range vs. Texas-Pan American (7-12, 58.3 percent)

#### DEFENSE!!! ... DEFENSE!!! ... DEFENSE!!!:

- Virginia ranks fourth in the ACC and 43rd nationally in points allowed per game at 61.7 ppg
- It is a 10.8 ppg improvement from last season when UVa allowed 72.5 ppg, which ranked 294th nationally

#### **HITTING THE GLASS:**

- One reason for Virginia's defensive success this season has been rebounding
- The Cavaliers are allowing just 8.7 offensive rebounds and 8.7 second chance points per game
- Virginia's 73.8% defensive rebounding percentage ranks first in the ACC and fifth nationally

#### **SHARP SHOOTING 'HOOS:**

- Against Miami the Cavaliers shot 51.8 percent from the floor, the sixth time this season they have shot at least 50.0 percent from the field
- Last season, UVa shot 50.0 percent just four times all season (28 games)

#### **'HOOS HONORED BY ANDY KATZ:**

- Virginia was honored as the ESPN.com Weekly Watch Team of the Week on Jan. 18 in Andy Katz's weekly column
- The Cavaliers defeated #20 Georgia Tech and #23 Miami the previous week





#### **LANDESBERG A CONSISTENT SCORER:**

- Sylven Landesberg has scored in double figures every game this season
- He is the only player in the ACC to accomplish the feat
- Landesberg is the only player to score at least 18 points in every ACC game this season
- He is the first Cavalier to score 18 or more points in five consecutive ACC games since J.R. Reynolds had a seven-game streak of 18 or better in 2006-07
- Landesberg has scored 20 or more points six times this season

#### **SCOTT DOUBLING IT UP:**

- Mike Scott had a double-double (17 pts, 11 rebs) vs. Penn State, his third of the season and his 13th career double-double
- His 13 double-doubles rank 20th in school history

## **BAKER TAKING CARE OF THE BALL:**

- Calvin Baker has 34 assists this season to just 10 turnovers
- That 3.4 assist-to-turnover ratio would rank second in the ACC and in the top 10 nationally if he met the 3.0 assists/per game minimum (Baker is at 2.3)
- Baker has had 23 assists in the last seven games he has played in

#### **EVANS STEPS UP:**

- Jontel Evans has raised his play over the last 11 games, compared to the first seven games of the season
- He has increased his scoring, rebounding, assist, steal and minutes averages

#### **MEYINSSE SHINES:**

- Jerome Meyinsse has developed into a strong inside presence for the Cavaliers over the past six games
- Over the last six games, he has averaged 7.7 points and 4.3 rebounds per game
- In ACC play, he is averaging 6.4 points and 4.6 rebounds per game this season, after averaging 0.9 point and 1.0 rebound per game in ACC play over his first three seasons

#### TRI-CAPTAINS NAMED:

- The three senior members of the team, Calvin Baker, Jerome Meyinsse and Solomon Tat, were named the team's tri-captains by head coach Tony Bennett
- Bennett announced his decision to the team on Jan. 8, the day before the Cavaliers' first ACC game of the season at NC State on Jan. 9.

#### **DEFENSE SHINES AGAINST NJIT:**

- The UVa defense put up a strong performance in the 68-37 win over NJIT
- NJIT's 37 points were the fewest allowed by the Cavaliers since 1996-97 (34 vs. UMBC) and is tied for the second fewest allowed in the shot clock era
- NJIT's 13 made FGs is tied for the fourth lowest total allowed by the Cavaliers since 1953
- NJIT's 27.1% shooting (13-48) was the lowest percentage allowed by the Cavaliers since Longwood shot 25.8% (16-62) against the Cavaliers on Feb. 13, 2007

#### SHERRILL EN FUEGO SOUTH OF THE BORDER:

- Against Cleveland State in Cancun, junior forward Will Sherrill had his career game
- He set career highs with 18 points, seven FGs, four 3FGs, two assists, three steals and tied a career high with six rebounds
- Prior to the game, Sherrill had scored just 15 points in his career, and his career high in a game was three points

#### **CAVALIERS SHOOT WELL AGAINST LONGWOOD:**
