- Virginia makes its first road trip of the season as it visits USF
- UVa is looking to snap a 10-game losing streak in the state of Florida
- Both teams are coming off wins in their season openers on Friday


## SERIES HISTORY:

-Tonight is the second all-time meeting between the schools
-The only previous meeting was a 77-75 UVa win last season in Charlottesville - Sylven Landesberg (21 pts) led four Cavaliers in double-figure scoring in last season's meeting

## ROAD OPENERS:

-Tonight's game is Virginia's first road game of the season

- The Cavaliers have won their first game away from home in seven of the past nine seasons
- Last year, Virginia fell 73-70 at Syracuse in its road opener


## SUNSHINE STATE WOES:

- Virginia has lost its last 10 games in the state of Florida (7 at FSU, 2 at Miami, 1 in ACC Tournament in Tampa)
- The Cavaliers'last win in the Sunshine State was the 2001 win at FSU


## LAST TIME OUT:

- Virginia opened the season with an 85-72 win over Longwood on Friday
- Sylven Landesberg led all scorers with 23 points
- Mustapha Farrakhan tied a career high with 17 points
- Mike Scott (12 pts, 13 rebs) had his 11th career double-double

## AGAINST THE BIG EAST:

-Tonight is the only regular season game for UVa vs. a Big East opponent

- Last year, Virginia was 1-1 vs. the Big East (W vs. USF, L at Syracuse)
-Virginia has a $54-57$ all-time record against current members of the Big East (1-3 vs. Cincinnati, 2-6 vs. Connecticut, 0-2 vs. DePaul, 11-12 vs. Georgetown, 5-3 vs. Louisville, 3-1 vs. Marquette, 5-1 vs. Notre Dame, 7-3 vs. Pittsburgh, 3-3 vs. Providence, $3-0$ vs. Rutgers, $0-3$ vs. Seton Hall, $0-7$ vs. St. John's, $1-0$ vs. USF, $1-3$ vs. Syracuse, $4-2$ vs. Villanova and $8-8$ vs. West Virginia)


## BENNETT VICTORIOUS IN DEBUT:

- Head coach Tony Bennett won his UVa debut Friday, 85-72 vs. Longwood
- Of the 11 Virginia head coaches, he became the eighth to win his debut
(Wins by Henry Lannigan, Gus Tebell, Evan "Bus" Male, Terry Holland, Jeff Jones, Pete Gillen, Dave Leitao and Tony Bennett)


## CAREER HIGHS IN SEASON OPENER:

-Two Cavaliers had career highs in the season opener vs. Longwood

- Mustapha Farrakhan tied career highs with 17 points and four assists, while having a career-high five rebounds
- Sammy Zeglinski tied a career high with six rebounds


## SHARP-SHOOTING 'HOOS:

- The Cavaliers shot $60.0 \%$ (30-50) from the field vs. Longwood - It marked the first time Virginia shot 60.0\% or higher since shooting 61.0\% (36-59) against Long Island on Nov. 17, 2000


## 'HOOS BACK:

-Virginia returns 11 letterwinners, including all five starters, from 2008-09

- UVa is the only team in the ACC to return all five starters
- Only twice have the Cavaliers returned all five starters, 1990-91 and 2006-07, and in both years the team made the NCAA Tournament
-Virginia returns 90.5 percent of its scoring and 89.9 percent of its rebounding


## LANDESBERG ON WATCH LISTS:

- Sophomore guard Sylven Landesberg has been named to a pair of preseason watch lists
- He is a preseason candidate for both the Naismith and Wooden awards
- Last season he led Virginia in scoring at 16.6 ppg as a freshman
- Landesberg was the 2008-09 ACC Rookie of the Year


## CAVALIERS 11TH IN ACC POLL:

-Virginia was picked 11th in the ACC preseason poll of media attending ACC Operation Basketball on Oct. 25
