## TODAY'S GAME:

- Virginia visits Wake Forest looking to remain unbeaten in the ACC
-The Cavaliers enter the game on an eight-game winning streak, their longest since the 2003-04 season, and are looking for their first nine-game win streak since the start of the 2001-02 season
-Virginia is looking for its first win in Winston-Salem since Jan. 30, 2000


## SERIES HISTORY:

-Wake leads series 66-59 (Wake leads 38-13 in Winston-Salem, 15-3 at Joel)

- In the only meeting last season, Wake won 70-60 at JPJA (2/28/09)
-The Demon Deacons have won the last three meetings overall
- Wake has won the last seven meetings in Winston-Salem


## WINNING STREAK:

-The Cavaliers enter today's game on an eight-game winning streak

- It is UVa's longest win streak since an eight-game streak to start the 2003-04 season
-The last time Virginia won nine straight was at the start of the 2001-02 season


## LAST TIME OUT:

- Virginia defeated UNC Wilmington 69-67 on Monday at JPJA
- Sylven Landesberg led UVa with 19 points and made the game-winning shot with 2.2 seconds remaining


## 'HOOS IN FIRST:

- UVa is the only team undefeated in ACC play, leading the conference at 3-0 - The 3-0 start is Virginia's best start in the ACC since starting the 1994-95 campaign with a 4-0 conference record

- UVa is receiving votes in the AP poll this week, the first time since Dec. 31, 2007 - UVa is receiving votes in the ESPN/USA Today Coaches poll this week, the first time since Dec. 17, 2007


## PARTY LIKE IT'S 1995:

-This season's team has accomplished several feats that haven't been done at Virginia since the 1994-95 season

- Virginia's first 3-0 start in the ACC since 1994-95
- UVa is the last unbeaten team in ACC play for the first time since 1994-95
- The last time UVa had three ranked wins 15 games into a season was in 1994-95 -That 1994-95 team included UVa assistant coach Jason Williford, UVa strength and conditioning coach Mike Curtis and UVa radio analyst Cory Alexander


## THESE CAVS CAN SCORE:

- To this point in the 2009-10 season, UVa has improved its offense in numerous statistical categories compared to the team's final 2008-09 statistics

- Virginia has improved its points per game, FG percentage, 3FG percentage, FT percentage, and assists/game from last season
- In conference games this season, Virginia ranks third in the ACC at 75.7 points per game in conference play


## TAKING CARE OF THE BALL:

- Virginia currently ranks third nationally in fewest turnovers a game at 10.2 turnovers per game
- Last season, the Cavaliers averaged 14.8 tpg, ranking 242nd nationally
-Virginia has had 10 or fewer turnovers in 10 games this season
- UVa ranks 12th nationally in assist-to-turnover ratio at 1.40
- Last season, UVa ranked 245th nationally with a 0.84 A/TO ratio


## BIG WINS, CLOSE LOSSES:

- Eight of Virginia's 12 wins this season have been by double digits
(The Cavaliers had just five double-digit wins all of last season)
- Three of Virginia's four losses this season have been by five points or less


## THEY CALL THEM FREE THROWS FOR A REASON:

- Virginia ranks second in the ACC and eighth nationally in free throw percentage at 76.3 percent (222-291)
- UVa is shooting 85.5 percent from the line (53-62) in its three ACC games - From the 12:57 mark of the second half at NCState ( $1 / 9$ ) to the 5:56 mark of the first halfvs. Georgia Tech (1/13), the Cavaliers made 22 consecutive free throws as a team

- Five Cavalier players are scoring at least 2.8 pts more per game than they did last season -Will Sherrill, who is scoring 3.6 ppg more than last season, leads the group

## ON TARGET FROM 3-POINT RANGE:

- Virginia ranks first in the ACC and ninth nationally in 3-point percentage at 41.5 percent (102-246)
- Last season, the Cavaliers ranked 242nd nationally at 31.6 percent (156-494)
- Sammy Zeglinski ranks 17th nationally in 3-point percentage at 48.7\% (38-78)
- Zeglinski already has more 3-pointers this season with 38 than last season when he led the team with 33 3-pointers
- Zeglinski has made at least two 3-pointers in each of the past 11 games, the longest such streak in the ACC
- Jeff Jones (46.8 percent, 22-47), Mustapha Farrakhan (40.5 percent, 15-37) and Will Sherrill (40.0 percent, 10-25) are also shooting 40.0 percent or better from behind the arc
- Jones leads the ACC in 3-point percentage in conference games at 85.7 percent (6-7)


## LONG RANGE FIRING:

- Against both Penn State and Cleveland State, the Cavaliers shot over 50.0 percent from 3-point range
- Against Penn State, Virginia shot 53.3 percent (8-15) from 3-point range
- Against Cleveland State, Virginia shot 58.8 percent (10-17) from 3-point range - It was the first time the Cavaliers shot over 50.0 percent from long range in consecutive games since doing it against Ohio and Tennessee in 2000-01 - Virginia also shot over 50.0 percent from 3-point range vs. Texas-Pan American (7-12, 58.3 percent)


## DEFENSE!!!... DEFENSE!!!... DEFENSE!!!

- Virginia ranks third in the ACC and 26th nationally in points allowed per game at 60.4 ppg
- It is a 12.1 ppg improvement from last season when UVa allowed 72.5 ppg , which ranked 294th nationally


## CAVALIERS SURPASS WIN TOTAL:

- Just past the halfway point of the regular season, Virginia has already surpassed its win total of 10 from last season with 12 this season
- UVa is already one win shy of last season's total of four ACC wins


## SHARP SHOOTING 'HOOS:

- Against Miami the Cavaliers shot 51.8 percent from the floor, the sixth time this season they have shot at least 50.0 percent from the field
- Last season, UVa shot 50.0 percent just four times all season (28 games)


## 'HOOS HONORED BY ANDY KATZ:

- Virginia was honored as the ESPN.com Weekly Watch Team of the Week on Jan. 18 in Andy Katz's weekly column
-The Cavaliers defeated \#20 Georgia Tech and \#23 Miami the previous week


## LANDESBERG A CONSISTENT SCORER:

- Sylven Landesberg has scored in double figures every game this season
- He is the only player in the ACC to accomplish the feat
- Landesberg has scored 20 or more points six times this season


## SCOTT DOUBLING IT UP:

- Mike Scott had a double-double (17 pts, 11 rebs) vs. Penn State, his third of the season and his 13th career double-double
- His 13 double-doubles rank 20th in school history


## BAKER TAKING CARE OF THE BALL:

- Calvin Baker has 34 assists this season to just 10 turnovers
-That 3.4 assist-to-turnover ratio would rank second in the ACC and in the top
10 nationally if he met the 3.0 assists/per game minimum (Baker is at 2.3)
- Baker has had 23 assists in the last seven games


## EVANS STEPS UP:

- Jontel Evans has raised his play during the Cavaliers' eight game win streak compared to the first eight games of the season
- He has increased his scoring, rebounding, assist,

## RETURN TO SENE-DER:

- Assane Sene had a career-high five blocks vs. Hampton on Dec. 23
- Sene leads the Cavaliers at 1.3 blocks per game


## TRI-CAPTAINS NAMED:

-The three senior members of the team, Calvin Baker, Jerome Meyinsse and Solomon Tat, were named the team's tri-captains by head coach Tony Bennett

- Bennett announced his decision to the team on Jan. 8, the day before the Cavaliers'first ACC game of the season at NC State on Jan. 9 .


## DEFENSE SHINES AGAINST NJIT:

-The UVa defense put up a strong performance in the 68-37 win over NJTT

- NJIT's 37 points were the fewest allowed by the Cavaliers since 1996-97 (34 vs.

UMBC) and is tied for the second fewest allowed in the shot clock era

- NJIT's 13 made FGs is tied for the fourth lowest total allowed by the Cavaliers since 1953
