## VIRGINIA CAVALIERS (2-1,0-0 ACC) AT EA SPORTS MAUI INVITATIONAL



#### NOVEMBER 22-24, 2010 • LAHAINA CIVIC CENTER • MAUI

#### THIS WEEK

- UVa travels to Hawaii for the 2010 EA SPORTS Maui Invitational
- It is the Cavaliers' fourth appearance in the tournament
- The tournament is part of a span of six straight games away from home for UVa
- Virginia opens the tournament against Washington, its second consecutive Pac-
- 10 opponent and the second of three Pac-10 teams on UVa's 2010-11 schedule

#### **TOURNAMENT HISTORY**

- Virginia makes its fourth appearance in the Maui Invitational
- The Cavaliers are 5-3 all-time in the event
- The Cavaliers were the runner-up in 1996 and 2002, the last two times they were in the tournament

#### ALOHA CAVALIERS

- This season marks the ninth time the Cavaliers have traveled to Hawaii to play
- Virginia is 12-7 on the islands during its previous eight trips
- The Cavaliers have played games on Maui, Oahu and the big island of Hawaii

#### AGAINST THE FIELD

- Virginia has played six of the other seven teams in Maui previously
- The Cavaliers are 1-0 against first round opponent Washington, winning 65-61 in
- 1983-84 (at the Cabrillo Classic in San Diego)
- UVa is 4-1 vs. Chaminade, 2-6 vs. UConn, 3-6 vs. Kentucky, 0-3 vs. Michigan State, and 1-1 vs. Oklahoma
- The Cavaliers have never played Wichita State

#### LAST TIME OUT

• Virginia suffered its first loss of the season on Thursday, 81-60, at Stanford

- Mustapha Farrakhan led the Cavaliers with 14 points
- Joe Harris made his first career start and scored 12 points
- Jontel Evans scored a career-high 11 points

#### SHARP-SHOOTING 'HOOS

• Virginia shot 50% or better from the field in the first two games this season (50% vs. William & Mary, 53.2% vs. USC Upstate)

• It is the first time the Cavaliers have shot at least 50% from the field in consecutive games since 2004-05 (57.1% vs. Clemson, 50.9% at Virginia Tech)

- Tonight's game begins a stretch of six games away
- from home for the Cavaliers
- It is the first time since 1991-92 that UVa has played
- six straight regular season games away from home
- The six games are in four different time zones
- (Pacific, Hawaii, Central, Eastern)
- The road trip will total 11,505 miles

#### **70 IS A MAGIC NUMBER**

- Under Tony Bennett, Virginia is 13-1 when scoring at least 70 points
- The Cavaliers are 4-16 over the past two seasons when scoring under 70 points

#### THEY CALL THEM FREE THROWS FOR A REASON

- Virginia went 11-11 from the free throw line at Stanford on Nov. 18
- It was the Cavaliers' first perfect game from the line since Feb. 28, 2009 vs. Wake (8-8)
- Through three games, the Cavaliers are shooting 80.9% (38-47) from the line
- As of Thursday's games (11/18), Virginia was one of just 24 teams nationally shooting over 80.0% from the line as a team

#### LONG RANGE FIRING

- Virginia shot over 50% (52.2%, 12-23) from 3-point range against William & Mary
- It was UVa's first game over 50% from behind the arc since going 7-12 last season against Texas-Pan American
- 12 3-pointers were the most UVa has made since making 13 vs. Liberty in 2008-09

 Against W&M, Billy Baron had the highest Cavalier three-point shooting percentage in a game (83.3 percent, 5-6) since Mamadi Diane (83.3 percent, 5-6) against Arizona on November 12, 2006 (minimum of five attempts)

• The Cavaliers have made 26 3-pointers this season through three games (last year, UVa didn't make its 26th 3-pointer of the season until the sixth game of the season)

#### **FIRST-YEARS SHINE IN DEBUT**

- The Cavalier first-years made an impact in their collegiate debut against William & Mary
- Billy Baron, KT Harrell, Will Regan, Joe Harris, Akil Mitchell and Thomas Rogers com-
- bined for 37 points and 10 rebounds against the Tribe
- It was the most points scored by Cavalier first-years in a season opener since 2003-04 when the Cavalier freshmen combined for 40 points against Mt. St. Mary's (Gary Forbes-21, Donte Minter-12, J.R. Reynolds-7)

• Baron (19 pts) and Harrell (13) were the first Virginia freshman duo to score in double figures in an opener since 2005-06 (Mamadi Diane 17, Lars Mikalauskas 14 vs. Liberty)

#### **TAKING CARE OF THE BALL**

 Virginia had just eight turnovers against William & Mary, the 16th time in 34 games under Tony Bennett that UVa has had 10 or fewer turnovers

 Last season the Cavaliers ranked first in the ACC and 13th nationally in fewest turnovers per game at 10.7

#### **CAVALIERS 11TH IN ACC PRESEASON POLL**

Virginia was selected 11th in the preseason poll at ACC Operation Basketball

• Reigning NCAA Champion Duke was the preseason favorite, followed by Virginia Tech, North Carolina, NC State, Florida State, Maryland, Clemson, Miami, Georgia Tech, Boston College, Virginia and Wake Forest

#### **'HOOS BACK**

- Six players return from last season's team that went 15-16 (5-11 ACC)
- Mike Scott is UVa's leading returning scorer (12.0 ppg) and rebounder (7.2 rbg)
- Sammy Zeglinski, UVa's leader in assists (80), steals (38) and 3-point field goals (61) also returns
- All six returning players averaged over 12.0 minutes per game last season

Seven of Virginia's 13 players are first years

• The seven true freshmen are a program record, breaking the previous high of six in 1989-90 (Blair Ford, Chris Havlicek, Ted Jeffries, Terry Kirby, Doug Smith, Shawn Wilson) and 2004-05 (T.J. Bannister, Jason Cain, Gary Forbes, Donte Minter, Vince Redd and J.R. Reynolds)

#### **ZEGLINSKI OUT**

Sammy Zeglinski had an operation on Oct. 19 involving cartilage work on his left knee
He is expected to be out approximately eight weeks

#### JOHNSON TO REDSHIRT

• Freshman forward James Johnson is expected to redshirt this season

• Virginia head coach Tony Bennett indicated that after Virginia's game with William & Mary on Nov. 12

#### SCOTT DOUBLING IT UP

• Mike Scott has 19 career double-doubles (ranks 12th in UVa history)

• He had his first double-double of the season against USC Upstate (19 pts, 12 rebs)

#### **CHALLENGING SCHEDULE**

• Virginia will play at least 11 games against teams that particpated in the 2010 NCAA Tournament

• UVa will play at least five games against teams that participated in the 2010 National Invitation Tournament

#### AT JOHN PAUL JONES ARENA

• Virginia is 51-22 all-time at John Paul Jones Arena

• The Cavaliers were 11-6 at JPJA last season

#### TRI-CAPTAINS NAMED

• Mustapha Farrakhan, Mike Scott and Will Sherrill are the tri-captains for the 2010-11 season

• The three players make up this year's senior class

#### McKAY TO PARTICIPATE IN "SHOTS FROM THE HEART"

• Associate Head Coach Ritchie McKay is participating in "Shots from the Heart", a project designed to raise awareness for the growing problem of heart disease

• College basketball coaches will compete against one another in a free throw shooting tournament, which will benefit the American Heart Association

• The event will also pay tribute to the late Skip Prosser who passed away on July 26, 2007 of a heart attack

• McKay's first round matchup in the assistant coaches division is against Charles Baker of Campbell

#### THREE SIGN WITH VIRGINIA

• UVa signed three players to National Letters of Intent for the 2011 recruiting class

• The three players are 6-8 forward Darion Atkins of Clinton, Md.; 6-5 guard Malcolm Brogdon of Norcross, Ga.; and 6-7 wing Paul Jesperson of Merrill, Wisc.

#### **UP NEXT**

• After the Maui Invitational, the Cavaliers will return home before continuing their road trip when they visit Minnesota on Nov. 29 as part of the ACC/Big Ten Challenge

• It is the second time in three seasons that the Cavaliers have traveled to Minnesota as part of the challenge


