TONIGHT'S GAME

• UVa travels to Minnesota for the first game of the 2010 ACC/Big Ten Challenge

- It is the Cavaliers' second trip to Minneapolis in three years in the event
- The game is part of a span of six straight games away from home for UVa

SERIES HISTORY

Virginia leads all-time series 4-2 (Minnesota leads 2-1 in Minneapolis)
The teams have met three times in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge, with the home team winning all three times (UVa in 2003, Minn. in 1999 and 2008)

• The last meeting came in the 2008 ACC/Big Ten Challenge, a 66-56 Minnesota win at Williams Arena

ACC/BIG TEN CHALLENGE HISTORY

• Virginia has a 5-5 all-time record in the challenge (1-4 on the road)

• The Cavaliers have lost their last two games in the challenge

• Minnesota is just the second ranked opponent the Cavaliers have played in the challenge (lost 82-75 at #21 Michigan State in 2002-03, also following a Virginia trip to Maui)

AGAINST RANKED OPPONENTS

Minnesota is the second ranked opponent the Cavaliers have played this season

• UVa lost to No. 13 Washington 106-63 in the first round of the Maui Invitational

Last season, the Cavaliers were 3-3 against teams ranked in the AP poll

LAST TIME OUT

• Virginia suffered a 70-58 loss to Wichita State in the 5th place game in Maui

Mike Scott (16 pts, 10 rebs) had his third double-double of the season

• Will Sherrill (11 pts), Jontel Evans (10 pts) and KT Harrell (10 pts) also scored in double figures

Under Tony Bennett, Virginia is 14-1 when scoring at least 70 points
The Cavaliers are 4-18 over the past two seasons when scoring under 70 points

HOOS ON THE ROAD

- Tonight's game continues a stretch of six games
- away from home for the Cavaliers
- It is the first time since 1991-92 that UVa has played
- six straight regular season games away from home
- The six games are in four different time zones
- (Pacific, Hawaii, Central, Eastern)
- The road trip will total 11,505 miles

SHARP-SHOOTING 'HOOS

 Virginia shot 50% or better from the field in the first two games this season (50% vs. William & Mary, 53.2% vs. USC Upstate)

• It was the first time the Cavaliers have shot at least 50% from the field in consecutive games since 2004-05 (57.1% vs. Clemson, 50.9% at Virginia Tech)

THEY CALL THEM FREE THROWS FOR A REASON

- Virginia went 11-11 from the free throw line at Stanford on Nov. 18
- It was the Cavaliers' first perfect game from the line since Feb. 28, 2009 vs. Wake (8-8)

LONG RANGE FIRING

Virginia shot over 50% (52.2%, 12-23) from 3-point range against William & Mary

 It was UVa's first game over 50% from behind the arc since going 7-12 last season against Texas-Pan American

• 12 3-pointers were the most UVa has made since making 13 vs. Liberty in 2008-09

 Against W&M, Billy Baron had the highest Cavalier three-point shooting percentage in a game (83.3 percent, 5-6) since Mamadi Diane (83.3 percent, 5-6) against Arizona on November 12, 2006 (minimum of five attempts)

FIRST-YEARS SHINE IN DEBUT

• The Cavalier first-years made an impact in their collegiate debut against William & Mary Billy Baron, KT Harrell, Will Regan, Joe Harris, Akil Mitchell and Thomas Rogers com-

bined for 37 points and 10 rebounds against the Tribe

 It was the most points scored by Cavalier first-years in a season opener since 2003-04 when the Cavalier freshmen combined for 40 points against Mt. St. Mary's (Gary Forbes-21, Donte Minter-12, J.R. Reynolds-7)

• Baron (19 pts) and Harrell (13) were the first Virginia freshman duo to score in double figures in an opener since 2005-06 (Mamadi Diane 17, Lars Mikalauskas 14 vs. Liberty)

CAVALIERS 11TH IN ACC PRESEASON POLL

Virginia was selected 11th in the preseason poll at ACC Operation Basketball

Reigning NCAA Champion Duke was the preseason favorite, followed by Virginia Tech,

North Carolina, NC State, Florida State, Maryland, Clemson, Miami, Georgia Tech, Boston College, Virginia and Wake Forest

'HOOS BACK

- Six players return from last season's team that went 15-16 (5-11 ACC)
- Mike Scott is UVa's leading returning scorer (12.0 ppg) and rebounder (7.2 rbg)
- Sammy Zeglinski, UVa's leader in assists (80), steals (38) and 3-point field goals (61) also returns
- All six returning players averaged over 12.0 minutes per game last season

YOUNG CAVALIERS

• Seven of Virginia's 13 players are first years

• The seven true freshmen are a program record, breaking the previous high of six in 1989-90 (Blair Ford, Chris Havlicek, Ted Jeffries, Terry Kirby, Doug Smith, Shawn Wilson) and 2004-05 (T.J. Bannister, Jason Cain, Gary Forbes, Donte Minter, Vince Redd and J.R. Reynolds)

• Virginia already has seven players with multiple doublefigure scoring games this season

Last year, the Cavaliers had just six players with multiple double-figure scoring gam

LETS GET TROPICAL!!!

• Will Sherrill has three career double-figure scoring games, all coming outside the continental United States

- He scored a career-high 18 points last season against Cleveland State in Cancun
- This season, he scored 11 points against both Oklahoma and Wichita State in Maui

ZEGLINSKI OUT

 Sammy Zeglinski had an operation on Oct. 19 involving cartilage work on his left knee • He is expected to be out approximately eight weeks

- JOHNSON TO REDSHIRT
- Freshman forward James Johnson is expected to redshirt this season

 Virginia head coach Tony Bennett indicated that after Virginia's game with William & Mary on Nov. 12

AT JOHN PAUL JONES ARENA

- Virginia is 51-22 all-time at John Paul Jones Arena
- The Cavaliers were 11-6 at JPJA last season

TRI-CAPTAINS NAMED

• Mustapha Farrakhan, Mike Scott and Will Sherrill are the tri-captains for the 2010-11 season

• The three players make up this year's senior class

McKAY PARTICIPATING IN "SHOTS FROM THE HEART"

 Associate Head Coach Ritchie McKay is participating in "Shots from the Heart", a project designed to raise awareness for the growing problem of heart disease

 College basketball coaches are competing against one another in a free throw shooting tournament, which will benefit the American Heart Association

• The event also pays tribute to the late Skip Prosser who passed away on July 26, 2007 of a heart attack

• McKay defeated Charles Baker of Campbell in the first round of the assistant coaches division
