TONIGHT'S GAME

- UVa returns from a 10-day break to host Oregon at John Paul Jones Arena
- The game is the second of an eight-game homestand for the Cavaliers

SERIES HISTORY

- First all-time meeting between the schools
- UVa's next three games are against first-time opponents (Norfolk St, Seattle)
- Tony Bennett had a 6-2 record vs. Oregon while at Washington State, and the six wins over the Ducks are tied for the most Bennett has against any opponent (Arizona St)

AGAINST THE PAC-10

- Tonight's game is the third of three games vs. Pac-10 opponents this season
- The Cavaliers lost at Stanford (81-60) and vs. Washington (106-63) in Maui
- UVa is 9-11 against the Pac-10 (3-2 vs. Arizona, 1-0 vs. Arizona State, 1-7 vs. Stanford, 0-1 vs. UCLA, 1-0 vs. USC, 1-1 vs. Washington, 2-0 vs. Washington State)
- Tony Bennett, who was 32-22 in the Pac-10 at Washington State, is 0-3 vs. Pac-10 opponents at Virginia

LAST TIME OUT

- Virginia defeated Radford 54-44 on Dec. 7 at JPJA
- It was the Cavaliers' third consecutive win
- UVa's 54 points were its fewest in a win since a 54-49 win at Virginia Tech in 2005-06
- Virginia shot 27.7% (13-47) from the floor, the 15th lowest shooting percentage in school history and the lowest ever in a victory
- Mike Scott had 10 pts and 13 rebs for his fifth consecutive double-double
- Joe Harris and Mustapha Farrakhan each had 14 points to lead the Cavaliers
- KT Harrell had 13 points on 5-6 FGs (3-3 3FGs)

70 IS A MAGIC NUMBER

- Under Tony Bennett, Virginia is 15-1 when scoring at least 70 points
- The Cavaliers are 6-18 over the past two seasons when scoring under 70 points

SCOTT HONORED BY ACC

- Mike Scott was named ACC Player of the Week on Dec. 6
- The previous week he had a pair of double-doubles in two Cavalier road wins (17 pts and 12 rebs at #15 Minnesota; 21 pts and 13 rebs at Virginia Tech)
- It is the first ACC Player of the Week honor of Scott's career

LONG RANGE FIRING

- Virginia shot 76.9 percent (10-13) from 3-point range in the win at Minnesota
- The 76.9 3-point percentage is a school record (min of 10 attempts)
- It is the highest percentage by an ACC team (min. 10 attempts) since Clemson shot 11-13 (84.6%) from 3-point range vs. North Carolina in 2004
- It is the second time this season UVa shot over 50% from 3-point range (52.2%, 12-23) against William & Mary
- 12 3-pointers vs. W&M were the most UVa has made since making 13 vs. Liberty in 2008-09
- Against W&M, Billy Baron had the highest Cavalier three-point shooting percentage in a game (83.3 percent, 5-6) since Mamadi Diane (83.3 percent, 5-6) against Arizona on November 12, 2006 (minimum of five attempts)

HARRIS AND FARRAKHAN SHOOT DOWN GOPHERS

- Joe Harris (24 pts) and Mustapha Farrakhan (23 pts) led Virginia to the 87-79 win at #15
 Minnesota
- It was the first time Virginia had two 20-point scorers in a road game since Jan. 24, 2007 at NC State (J.R. Reynolds-29, Sean Singletary-27)
- It was the first career 20-point game for both Farrakhan and Harris

WIN AT MINNESOTA WAS NOTABLE

- Virginia's win at Minnesota in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge was notable for several reasons
- The No. 15 Gophers were the highest ranked opponent the Cavaliers defeated on the road since an 86-78 win at No. 8 Maryland on Feb. 6, 2003
- Virginia's 58 second half points were the most the Cavaliers have scored in a half since scoring 60 first half points in a 108-87 win over Gonzaga on Jan. 3, 2007
- The Cavaliers trailed by 13 points in the second half at Minnesota, the largest deficit they have overcome to win since rallying from 13 down to top Maryland 68-63 on Mar. 7, 2009
- UVa overcame a 10-point halftime deficit, the largest it has overcome in a win since trailing by 13 at the break in a 93-90 win over Arizona on Nov. 12, 2006 (first game at JPJA)
- It was the largest halftime deficit overcome by the Cavaliers on the road since rallying from a 21-point halftime deficit for a 91-88 2OT win at Duke on Jan. 14, 1995

SHARP-SHOOTING 'HOOS

- Virginia shot 50% or better from the field in the first two games this season (50% vs. William & Mary, 53.2% vs. USC Upstate)
- It was the first time the Cavaliers have shot at least 50% from the field in consecutive games since 2004-05 (57.1% vs. Clemson, 50.9% at Virginia Tech)

THEY CALL THEM FREE THROWS FOR A REASON

- Virginia went 11-11 from the free throw line at Stanford on Nov. 18
- It was the Cavaliers' first perfect game from the line since Feb. 28, 2009 vs. Wake (8-8)

YOUNG CAVALIERS

- Seven of Virginia's 13 players are first years
- The seven true freshmen are a program record, breaking the previous high of six in 1989-90 (Blair Ford, Chris Havlicek, Ted Jeffries, Terry Kirby, Doug Smith, Shawn Wilson) and 2004-05 (T.J. Bannister, Jason Cain, Gary Forbes, Donte Minter, Vince Redd and J.R. Reynolds)

SCOTT DOUBLING IT UP

- Mike Scott has 24 career double-doubles (ranks T-8th in UVa history)
- He had his sixth double-double of the season, and fifth consecutive double-double, vs. Radford (10 pts, 13 rebs)
- He is the first Cavalier with five consecutive double-doubles since Ralph Sampson in 1983

SPREADING THE WEALTH

- Virginia already has seven players with multiple double-figure scoring games this season
- Last year, the Cavaliers had just six players with multiple double-figure scoring games

EVANS DISHES IT OUT

- Jontel Evans has recorded at least five assists in five of nine games this season
- Last season, he had only three five-assist games during his freshman season (31 games)

SENE-DING HIM TO THE LINE

- Assane Sene is shooting 70.6% (12-17) from the line this season
- Sene entered the season a career 43.6% (17-39) free throw shooter
- His 12 made free throws are already a career high for a season
- He went 7-8 from the line at Minnesota, setting career highs for FTs and FTAs in a game (previous highs were 2 FTs and 4 FTAs)

LETS GET TROPICAL!!!

- Will Sherrill has three career double-figure scoring games, all coming outside the continental United States
- He scored a career-high 18 points last season against Cleveland State in Cancun
- This season, he scored 11 points against both Oklahoma and Wichita State in Maui

SHERRILL INJURED AT MINNESOTA

- Will Sherrill suffered a fractured fibula in his right leg at Minnesota on Nov. 29
- It is uncertain how long he will be out of action
- He will progress as his tolerance to activity indicates and will play when he is functional without pain; it is anticipated that will be in less than six weeks

ZEGLINSKI RETURNS

- Sammy Zeglinski made his season debut at Virginia Tech and had three assists
- Zeglinski had an operation on Oct. 19 involving cartilage work on his left knee and missed the first seven games of the season

FIRST-YEARS SHINE IN DEBUT

- The Cavalier first-years made an impact in their collegiate debut against William & Mary
- Billy Baron, KT Harrell, Will Regan, Joe Harris, Akil Mitchell and Thomas Rogers combined for 37 points and 10 rebounds against the Tribe
- It was the most points scored by Cavalier first-years in a season opener since 2003-04 when the Cavalier freshmen combined for 40 points against Mt. St. Mary's (Gary Forbes-21, Donte Minter-12, J.R. Reynolds-7)
- Baron (19 pts) and Harrell (13) were the first Virginia freshman duo to score in double figures in an opener since 2005-06 (Mamadi Diane 17, Lars Mikalauskas 14 vs. Liberty)

CAVALIERS 11TH IN ACC PRESEASON POLL

- Virginia was selected 11th in the preseason poll at ACC Operation Basketball
- Reigning NCAA Champion Duke was the preseason favorite, followed by Virginia Tech, North Carolina, NC State, Florida State, Maryland, Clemson, Miami, Georgia Tech, Boston College, Virginia and Wake Forest

'HOOS BACK

- Six players return from last season's team that went 15-16 (5-11 ACC)
- Mike Scott is UVa's leading returning scorer (12.0 ppg) and rebounder (7.2 rbg)
- Sammy Zeglinski, UVa's leader in assists (80), steals (38) and 3-point field goals (61) also returns
- · All six returning players averaged over 12.0 minutes per game last season

JOHNSON TO REDSHIRT

- Freshman forward James Johnson is expected to redshirt this season
- Virginia head coach Tony Bennett indicated that after Virginia's game with William & Mary on Nov. 12

AT JOHN PAUL JONES ARENA

- Virginia is 52-22 all-time at John Paul Jones Arena
- The Cavaliers were 11-6 at JPJA last season

TRI-CAPTAINS NAMED

- Mustapha Farrakhan, Mike Scott and Will Sherrill are the tri-captains for the 2010-11 season
- The three players make up this year's senior class

McKAY PARTICIPATING IN "SHOTS FROM THE HEART"

- Associate Head Coach Ritchie McKay is participating in "Shots from the Heart", a project designed to raise awareness for the growing problem of heart disease
- College basketball coaches are competing against one another in a free throw shooting tournament, which will benefit the American Heart Association
- The event also pays tribute to the late Skip Prosser who passed away on July 26, 2007 of a heart attack
- McKay defeated Charles Baker of Campbell in the first round and Greg Gary of Duquesne in the second round of the assistant coaches division
- In his second round match, McKay went a perfect 25-of-25 from the line
- He will play either Ben Johnson of Northern Iowa or Al Pinkins of Middle Tennessee in the round of 16

THREE SIGN WITH VIRGINIA

- UVa signed three players to National Letters of Intent for the 2011 recruiting class
- The three players are 6-8 forward Darion Atkins of Clinton, Md.; 6-5 guard Malcolm Brogdon of Norcross, Ga.; and 6-7 wing Paul Jesperson of Merrill, Wisc.
