# **TONIGHT'S GAME**

- Virginia concludes a season-long four-game homestand by hosting George Mason
- The Cavaliers look to remain undefeated at home this season
- UVa seeks its first six-game win streak since 2009-10 (eight-game win streak)

# **SERIES HISTORY**

- Virginia leads 6-0 (UVa leads 5-0 in Charlottesville)
- The teams haven't met since the 1997-98 season (a 60-45 UVa win at U-Hall)
- Tony Bennett was 3-0 against GMU coach Paul Hewitt's teams at Georgia Tech during the last two seasons

# **AGAINST THE COMMONWEALTH**

- Since the 1999-2000 season, Virginia has a 40-9 record against teams from the Commonwealth of Virginia
- The Cavaliers are 31-3 at home against in-state foes during that time
- UVa has a 19-3 record against in-state opponents at John Paul Jones Arena
- Virginia has won its last six games against in-state opponents

# **AGAINST THE CAA**

- Tonight's game is the second of three games this season for UVa against the CAA
- UVa downed preseason CAA favorite Drexel 49-35 in the Paradise Jam on Nov. 19
- The Cavaliers have won 21 consecutive games against CAA opponents, dating back to a 76-69 loss at Old Dominion in 1993-94
- Virginia has a 107-34 all-time record against current members of the CAA (10-1 vs. Delaware, 2-0 vs. Drexel, 6-0 vs. George Mason, 1-2 vs. Hofstra, 8-0 vs. James Madison, 3-0 vs. UNCW, 1-0 vs. Northeastern, 9-4 vs. Old Dominion, 4-0 vs. Towson, 10-1 vs. VCU, 53-26 vs. William & Mary)
- Virginia is 4-0 vs. the CAA at JPJA (def. Drexel and Old Dominion in 2007-08, def. UNCW in 2009-10, def. William & Mary in 2010-11)

# **LAST TIME OUT**

- Virginia defeated Longwood 86-53 on Saturday at John Paul Jones Arena
- UVa's 86 points were the second-highest of the Tony Bennett era
- Mike Scott (20 pts and 9 rebs) and Sammy Zeglinski (14 pts, 7 assts) led Virginia

### **CAVALIERS GET DEFENSIVE**

- Virginia is second in the nation in scoring defense at 47.9 ppg (as of 12/5)
- UVa ranks third nationally in points allowed per possession (0.77) and 12th nationally in field goal percentage defense (35.4%)
- The Cavaliers have held each of their first eight opponents under 60 points, the first time they have held eight straight opponents under 60 points since 1948-49
- UVa held four of its first eight opponents to under 50 points, a feat it has done 11 times in the Tony Bennett era
- Virginia held Drexel to 35 points, the second lowest scoring total by a UVa opponent in the shot clock era
- South Carolina State's 25.5% shooting (13-51) was the lowest percentage allowed by UVa since Liberty shot 22.6% percent (12-53) against UVa in the 2005-06 season opener
- Virginia has held two opponents under 30% shooting this season (only accomplished the feat twice in the previous three seasons combined)
- It is the first time UVa has held multiple opponents under 30% shooting in the same season since 2005-06 (three times)

### FREE THROW PRODUCTION

- Virginia leads the ACC and ranks 16th nationally with a 76.0 free throw percentage
- UVa has scored 28.6 percent of its points this season from the free throw line
- The Cavaliers are going to the line 8.4 more times a game this season and scoring 7.5

more points from the line per game this season

# THEY CALL THEM FREE THROWS FOR A REASON

- UVa set a school record by going 19-for-19 from the free throw line against Winthrop
- The previous school record was 16-for-16 against South Carolina on Jan. 8, 1965
- It was the best free throw performance by an ACC team since Wake Forest shot an ACC-record 32-for-32 against North Carolina in 2005

### **VIRGINIA PICKED FOURTH IN ACC**

- Virginia was selected fourth in the preseason poll at ACC Operation Basketball
- It was highest the Cavaliers were picked in the poll since 2001-02, when they were picked to finish third
- UVa has finished higher than its place in the preseason poll in each of the last three seasons
- North Carolina was the preseason favorite, followed by Duke, Florida State, Virginia, Miami, Virginia Tech, Clemson, NC State, Maryland, Georgia Tech, Wake Forest and Boston College

# SCOTT NAMED PRESEASON ALL-ACC

- Senior forward Mike Scott was one of six players named to the preseason All-ACC team at ACC Operation Basketball
- He is the first Cavalier selected as preseason All-ACC since Sean Singletary in 2007-08

# **70 IS A MAGIC NUMBER**

- Under Tony Bennett, Virginia is 21-2 when scoring at least 70 points
- The Cavaliers are 17-30 over the past three seasons when scoring under 70 points



### **'HOOS BACK**

- 10 players return from last season's team that went 16-15 (7-9 ACC)
- The Cavaliers return 69.0% of scoring and 79.4% of rebounding from last season

# AT JOHN PAUL JONES ARENA

- Virginia is 65-28 all-time at John Paul Jones Arena
- The Cavaliers went 11-6 at home last season
- Virginia is 5-0 at home this season

# **CAVALIERS TOP MICHIGAN**

- UVa's 70-58 win over No. 14 Michigan was its highest ranked win of the Bennett era
- It was the Cavaliers' first double-digit win over a top-15 opponent since a 72-58 win over No. 11 Boston College on Feb. 21, 2006 at University Hall

#### **CAVALIER DEBUTS**

- Malcolm Brogdon and James Johnson, along with walk-ons Rob Vozenilek and Angus Mitchell made their collegiate debuts in the season opener vs. SC State
- Brogdon had nine points, four assists and two rebounds in his debut
- Johnson had six points (6-8 FT) and three rebounds in his debut

### **SCOTT DOUBLING IT UP**

- Mike Scott enters the game with 27 career double-doubles (4th in UVa history)
- He had six double-doubles in his 10 games last season before suffering a seasonending injury
- His 27 career double-doubles leads all active ACC players
- Scott had his first double-double of the season against Drexel (21 pts, 10 rebs)
- It was his fifth "20-10" game of his career (at least 20 points and 10 rebounds)

# **SCOTT LEADS THE ACC**

• Mike Scott is the ACC active leader in points (1,090), rebounds (759) and doubledoubles (27)

# **SCOTT JOINS 1,000 POINT CLUB**

- Mike Scott became the 43rd Cavalier to score 1,000 career points, reaching the milestone against TCU in the Virgin Islands
- He enters the game with 1,070 career points, 39th in Virginia history

# **RETURN TO SENE-DER**

- Assane Sene ranks seventh in school history with 100 career blocks
- He led the Cavaliers last season with 39 blocks

### **ZEGLINSKI FROM LONG RANGE**

• Sammy Zeglinski enters the game with 151 career 3-pointers, which ranks 10th in school history

# **EVANS SHINES AGAINST WINTHROP**

- Jontel Evans scored a career-high 17 points against Winthrop
- He was 5-6 from the field, made a career-high two 3-pointers, and went 5-5 from the free throw line
- His previous career high was 11 points

# **JESPERSON TO REDSHIRT**

- Freshman guard Paul Jesperson is expected to redshirt this season
- Virginia head coach Tony Bennett indicated that after Virginia's game with South Carolina State on Nov. 13

# **FOUR SIGN WITH VIRGINIA**

- UVa signed four players to National Letters of Intent for the 2012 recruiting class
- The four players are 6-6 wing Justin Anderson of Spotsylvania, Va.; 6-0 guard Teven Jones of Kannapolis, N.C.; 6-8 forward Evan Nolte of Alpharetta, Ga.; and 6-11 post player Mike Tobey of Monroe, N.Y.

#### ON THE AIR

- Virginia will have almost every game this season broadcast either on television or online
- All 16 ACC games and all 16 home games will be broadcast
- 13 games will be televised nationally by ESPN, ESPN2, ESPNU or FSN

# McKAY PARTICIPATING IN "SHOTS FROM THE HEART"

- Associate Head Coach Ritchie McKay is participating in "Shots from the Heart", a project designed to raise awareness for the growing problem of heart disease
- College basketball coaches are competing against one another in a free throw shooting tournament, which benefits the American Heart Association
- The event also pays tribute to the late Skip Prosser who passed away on July 26, 2007 of a heart attack
- Last year, McKay reached the quarterfinals of the assistant coach bracket in the inaugural event
- McKay defeated Ricky Yahn of Longwood in the first round of this year's tournament and will play either Adam Caporn of St. Mary's or Mike Wolf of Portland in the round of 32






