TONIGHT'S GAME

- Virginia concludes a two-game road stretch with a visit to Georgia Tech
- The Cavaliers look for their fifth consecutive win over the Yellow Jackets and their fourth straight win over Georgia Tech in Atlanta
- It is Virginia's first ever game at Philips Arena, site of this year's ACC Tournament

SERIES HISTORY

- Georgia Tech leads 38-33 (GT leads 22-10 in Atlanta, 1st meeting at Philips Arena)
- Virginia has won the last four meetings and five of the last six
- The Cavaliers have won the last three meetings in Atlanta
- UVa swept both regular season games last season, 72-64 at John Paul Jones Arena and 62-56 at Alexander Memorial Coliseum

ATLANTA SUCCESS

- Virginia has won its last three games at Georgia Tech
- It is its longest road winning streak against an ACC opponent since three-game streaks against Florida State and NC State from 1995-97
- The last time UVa won four straight road games against an ACC opponent was a five-game streak against Wake Forest from 1986-90 (two of those games were played in Greensboro)
- Both of Virginia's trips to the Final Four, in 1981 and 1984, came after winning NCAA Regionals in Atlanta at the Omni

STRONG START TO THE SEASON

- The Cavaliers' 14-2 record is their best start to a season since going 14-2 to open the 2001-02 season
- A win tonight would give UVa its first 15-2 start since the 1982-83 season
- Virginia won 13 non-conference regular-season games this season, its most since winning 14 non-conference regular-season games in 1990-91

2011-12 Opponents in Bold

LAST TIME OUT

- Virginia had its 12-game win streak snapped with a 61-58 loss to No. 8 Duke on Jan. 12 at Cameron Indoor Stadium
- Duke became just the second UVa opponent to score at least 60 points this season
- The Cavaliers held the Blue Devils to their lowest scoring total of the season, their lowest scoring total at Cameron since 2006-07, and 21 points below their season average entering the game
- Mike Scott led Virginia with 23 points and nine rebounds

'HOOS RANKED

- Virginia is ranked No. 15 in The Associated Press Top 25, its highest AP ranking since February 11, 2002 (No. 15)
- It marks the first time Virginia has been in the AP poll in five consecutive weeks since November-December 2004
- UVa remained No. 17 in the ESPN/USA Today Coaches poll, its highest coaches poll ranking since February 18, 2002 (No. 15)

CLOSE LOSSES

- Both of Virginia's losses this season have been by a single possession, and in both game the Cavaliers had the final shot to win or tie the game
- In the 57-55 loss to TCU in the Paradise Jam, Joe Harris' 3-pointer to win the game missed as time expired
- In the 61-58 loss at Duke, Mike Scott and Jontel Evans each had opportunities from 3-point range in the closing seconds to force overtime

CAVALIERS GET DEFENSIVE

- Virginia is second in the nation in scoring defense at 51.1 ppg (as of 1/17)
- UVa ranks third nationally in points allowed per possession (0.84) and 29th nationally in field goal percentage defense (38.9%)
- $\, \bullet \,$ Virginia leads the nation in fewest assists/game allowed (7.0) and ranks third nationally in opponents' assist-to-turnover ratio (0.51)
- The Cavaliers held each of their first 10 opponents under 60 points, their longest streak since 17 straight games from the end of the 1947-48 season (last eight games) to the start of the 1948-49 season (first nine games)
- It is the third-longest streak in ACC history (longest in the shot clock era)
- UVa has held six opponents to under 50 points, a feat it has done 13 times in the Tony Bennett era
- Virginia held Drexel to 35 points, the second lowest scoring total by a UVa opponent in the shot clock era
- South Carolina State's 25.5% shooting (13-51) was the lowest percentage allowed by UVa since Liberty shot 22.6% (12-53) against UVa in the 2005-06 season opener
- Virginia has held three opponents under 30% shooting this season (only accomplished the feat twice in the previous three seasons combined)
- It is the first time UVa has held multiple opponents under 30% shooting in the same season since 2005-06 (three times)

70 IS A MAGIC NUMBER

- Under Tony Bennett, Virginia is 22-2 when scoring at least 70 points
- The Cavaliers are 23-31 over the past three seasons when scoring under 70 points

ONE AND DONE...

- Virginia ranks fifth nationally in defensive rebounding percentage at 75.8%
- The Cavaliers have allowed points on just 42.7 percent of their opponents' possessions this season (fourth nationally)
- Opponents are averaging 6.8 second chance points a game this season
- UVa has held 14 of 16 opponents to single digit second chance points



SCOTT ON WOODEN AWARD MIDSEASON LIST

- Mike Scott is one of 25 players on the Wooden Award Midseason Top 25 List
- He is the first Cavalier to be named to the list since Sean Singletary in 2007-08

SCOTT NAMED ACC PLAYER OF THE WEEK THREE TIMES

- Mike Scott leads the league with three ACC Player of the Week awards this season
- He joins Barry Parkhill (1971-72), Ralph Sampson (1982-83), Bryant Stith (1989-90) and Norman Nolan (1997-98) as the only Cavaliers to be named ACC Player of the Week three times in a season
- Scott was named ACC Player of the Week on Dec. 19, Dec. 26 and Jan. 9
- With his awards on Dec. 19 and Dec. 26 he became the first Cavalier to be honored in consecutive weeks since Sean Singletary in January 2007

MIKE SCOTT DOMINATES IN SEATTLE

- Mike Scott had a career-high 33 points (12-14 FG), along with 14 rebounds, in Virginia's 83-77 win at Seattle University on Dec. 21
- Scott's 33 points were the most by a Cavalier since Sean Singletary scored 41 points at Miami on Mar. 1, 2008
- Scott's 33 points are the most by an ACC player this season
- Scott is the first ACC player with at least 33 pts and at least 14 rebs in a game since Florida State's Al Thornton (37 pts, 15 rebs) at Duke on Feb. 4, 2006
- Scott's 19 points in the first half were the most in a half by a Cavalier since Sylven Landesberg had 26 second half points vs. Boston College (Feb. 4, 2009) and the most in a first half since Sean Singletary had 23 first half points vs. Virginia Tech (Jan. 26, 2008)

SCOTT NAMED PRESEASON ALL-ACC

- Senior forward Mike Scott was one of six players named to the preseason All-ACC team at ACC Operation Basketball
- He is the first Cavalier selected as preseason All-ACC since Sean Singletary in 2007-08

SCOTT DOUBLING IT UP

- Mike Scott enters the game with 29 career double-doubles (T-3rd in UVa history)
- He has five double-doubles this season
- His 29 career double-doubles lead all active ACC players
- Scott has two "20-10" games this season (six in his career)

SCOTT LEADS THE ACC

• Mike Scott is the ACC active leader in points (1,233), rebounds (822) and doubledoubles (29)

SCOTT JOINS 1,000 POINT CLUB

- Mike Scott became the 43rd Cavalier to score 1,000 career points, reaching the milestone against TCU in the Virgin Islands
- He enters the game with 1,233 career points, 29th in Virginia history

RETURN TO SENE-DER

- Assane Sene ranks seventh in school history with 107 career blocks
- He leads the Cavaliers with 14 blocks this season

ZEGLINSKI FROM LONG RANGE

- Sammy Zeglinski enters the game with 172 career 3-pointers, which ranks sixth in school history
- He has made at least three 3-pointers in seven of 14 games this season, including four games with four 3-pointers
- Zeglinski is fourth in the ACC in 3-point percentage at 39.2%

EVANS SHINES AGAINST WINTHROP

- Jontel Evans scored a career-high 17 points against Winthrop
- He was 5-6 from the field, made a career-high two 3-pointers, and went 5-5 from the free throw line
- His previous career high was 11 points

ACC LEADERS

- Mike Scott leads the ACC in field goal percentage (.588)
- Scott ranks fifth in rebounding (8.9) and fourth in scoring (16.9)
- He is the only player to rank in the top five in the ACC in both scoring and rebounding
- Scott leads the league in scoring in conference games (23.0)
- Joe Harris ranks seventh in free throw percentage (.818) and 19th in scoring (12.4)
- Sammy Zeglinski ranks fourth in 3-point percentage (.392), fifth in steals (1.7) and 10th in assists (2.9)
- Jontel Evans ranks fifth in assists (3.6) and sixth in steals (1.7)

THEY CALL THEM FREE THROWS FOR A REASON

- UVa set a school record by going 19-for-19 from the free throw line against Winthrop
- The previous school record was 16-for-16 against South Carolina on Jan. 8, 1965
- It was the best free throw performance by an ACC team since Wake Forest shot an ACC-record 32-for-32 against North Carolina in 2005

CONSISTENT LINEUP

- Virginia has had the same starting lineup (Scott, Sene, Evans, Harris, Zeglinski) the past 11 games and has used just two different starting lineups this season
- If the Cavaliers use the same lineup tonight, it will mark the first time since 1993-94 that they have used just two lineups through the first 17 games of a season

COMEBACK CAVS

- Virginia rallied from halftime deficits to win at both Oregon and Seattle
- It marked the first time the Cavaliers won consecutive games when trailing at the half since 2009-10 (at NC State, vs. Georgia Tech)
- It marked the first time Virginia won consecutive games (both on the road) when trailing at the half since 1990-91 (at Minnesota, at Marquette)

AT JOHN PAUL JONES ARENA

- Virginia is 69-28 all-time at John Paul Jones Arena
- The Cavaliers went 11-6 at home last season
- Virginia is 9-0 at home this season
- UVa has won its last 10 home games, the second-longest streak at JPJA
- This season the Cavaliers went undefeated at home in non-conference regularseason games (8-0) for the first time since the 2004-05 season

CAVALIERS TOP MICHIGAN

- UVa's 70-58 win over No. 14 Michigan was its highest ranked win of the Bennett era
- It was the Cavaliers' first double-digit win over a top-15 opponent since a 72-58 win over No. 11 Boston College on Feb. 21, 2006 at University Hall

VIRGINIA PICKED FOURTH IN ACC

- Virginia was selected fourth in the preseason poll at ACC Operation Basketball
- It was the highest the Cavaliers were picked in the poll since 2001-02, when they were picked to finish third
- UVa has finished higher than its place in the preseason poll in each of the last three seasons
- North Carolina was the preseason favorite, followed by Duke, Florida State, Virginia, Miami, Virginia Tech, Clemson, NC State, Maryland, Georgia Tech, Wake Forest and Boston College

HARRELL AND JOHNSON DECIDE TO TRANSFER

- Sophomore guard KT Harrell (Dec. 23) and redshirt freshman forward James Johnson (Dec. 24) announced they were transferring
- Harrell appeared in 11 games (starting five) and averaged 4.7 ppg this season
- Johnson appeared in six games and averaged 1.5 ppg this season

FOUR SIGN WITH VIRGINIA

- UVa signed four players to National Letters of Intent for the 2012 recruiting class
- The four players are 6-6 wing Justin Anderson of Spotsylvania, Va.; 6-0 guard Teven Jones of Kannapolis, N.C.; 6-8 forward Evan Nolte of Alpharetta, Ga.; and 6-11 post player Mike Tobey of Monroe, N.Y.

JONES JOINS CAVALIERS

- Teven Jones, who signed with Virginia in November, enrolled at UVa for the start of the spring semester
- Jones, who was attending Fishburne Military Academy, will practice with the Cavaliers for the remainder of the season, but will not play in games
- He will still have four years of eligibility at Virginia beginning with the 2012-13 season

UP NEXT

- Virginia will return home to host in-state rival Virginia Tech on Sunday night
- Game time at John Paul Jones Arena is 6 p.m., and the game will be televised on ESPNU


