TONIGHT'S GAME

- Virginia opens ACC play as it hosts Miami
- The Cavaliers look to win their ACC opener for the fourth consecutive year
- UVa seeks its first 12-game win streak since 1981-82

SERIES HISTORY

- Miami leads 9-4 (series tied 3-3 in Charlottesville, UVa leads 2-1 at JPJA)
- The Hurricanes have won the last three meetings, including two overtime games last season (70-68 in Coral Gables, 69-62 in the ACC Tournament first round)
- Virginia won the last meeting in Charlottesville, 75-57, in 2009-10

WINNING STREAKS

- The Cavaliers enter the game on an 11-game winning streak, their longest since the 1992-93 season
- Virginia hasn't won 12 consecutive games since the 1981-82 season
- UVa has won its last nine home games, the second-longest streak at JPJA

STRONG START TO THE SEASON

- The Cavaliers' 13-1 record is their best start to a season since going 27-1 to open the 1981-82 season
- Virginia won13 non-conference regular-season games this season, its most since winning 14 non-conference regular-season games in 1990-91

LAST TIME OUT

- Virginia concluded non-conference play with a 57-52 win at LSU on Monday
- Sammy Zeglinski led Virginia with 17 points
- Joe Harris and Mike Scott added 14 and 12 points respectively
- It was Virginia's first win at an SEC school

2011-12 Opponents in Bold

HOOS RANKED

- Virginia is ranked No. 21 in the Associated Press Top 25, its highest AP ranking since December 6, 2004 (No. 19)
- It marks the first time Virginia has been in the AP poll in three consecutive weeks since December 2004
- UVa is ranked No. 23 in the ESPN/USA Today Coaches Poll

IN ACC OPENERS

- UVa has won its ACC opener the last three seasons and four of the last five seasons
- Virginia opens ACC play at home for the first time since 2006-07
- Last season the Cavaliers opened the ACC season with a 57-54 win at Virginia Tech
- The Cavaliers have lost their ACC home opener three of the past four seasons

CAVALIERS GET DEFENSIVE

- Virginia is second in the nation in scoring defense at 50.4 ppg (as of 1/5)
- UVa ranks third nationally in points allowed per possession (0.82) and 23rd nationally in field goal percentage defense (38.2%)
- Virginia leads the nation in fewest assists/game allowed (6.9) and ranks second nationally in opponents' assist-to-turnover ratio (0.48)
- The Cavaliers held each of their first 10 opponents under 60 points, their longest streak since 17 straight games from the end of the 1947-48 season (last eight games) to the start of the 1948-49 season (first nine games)
- It is the third-longest streak in ACC history (longest in the shot clock era)
- UVa has held six opponents to under 50 points, a feat it has done 13 times in the Tony Bennett era
- Virginia held Drexel to 35 points, the second lowest scoring total by a UVa opponent in the shot clock era
- South Carolina State's 25.5% shooting (13-51) was the lowest percentage allowed by UVa since Liberty shot 22.6% (12-53) against UVa in the 2005-06 season opener
- Virginia has held three opponents under 30% shooting this season (only accomplished the feat twice in the previous three seasons combined)
- It is the first time UVa has held multiple opponents under 30% shooting in the same season since 2005-06 (three times)

70 IS A MAGIC NUMBER

- Under Tony Bennett, Virginia is 22-2 when scoring at least 70 points
- The Cavaliers are 22-30 over the past three seasons when scoring under 70 points

ONE AND DONE...

- Virginia ranks fourth nationally in defensive rebounding percentage at 76.9%
- The Cavaliers have allowed points on just 41.5 percent of their opponents' possessions this season (second nationally)
- Opponents are averaging 6.7 second chance points a game this season
- UVa has held 12 of 14 opponents to single digit second chance points

TOP SCORERS STRONG AT THE LINE

- All of Virginia's top four scorers are shooting 80.0% or better from the free throw line (Mike Scott 80.2, Joe Harris 84.0, Sammy Zeglinski 80.0, Malcolm Brogdon 82.9)
- UVa is the only ACC team to have its top four scorers shooting at least 80.% FTs
- Murray State is the only other ranked team to have its top four scorers shooting at least 80% from the line

THEY CALL THEM FREE THROWS FOR A REASON

- UVa set a school record by going 19-for-19 from the free throw line against Winthrop
- The previous school record was 16-for-16 against South Carolina on Jan. 8, 1965
- It was the best free throw performance by an ACC team since Wake Forest shot an ACC-record 32-for-32 against North Carolina in 2005



SCOTT TWICE NAMED ACC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- Mike Scott was named ACC Player of the Week on Dec. 26 after having 33 pts and 14 rebs in the Cavaliers' 83-77 win at Seattle
- He was also honored on Dec. 19 and became the first Cavalier to win the award in consecutive weeks since Sean Singletary in January 2007

MIKE SCOTT DOMINATES IN SEATTLE

- Mike Scott had a career-high 33 points (12-14 FG), along with 14 rebounds, in Virginia's 83-77 win at Seattle University on Dec. 21
- Scott's 33 points were the most by a Cavalier since Sean Singletary scored 41 points at Miami on Mar. 1, 2008
- Scott's 33 points are the most by an ACC player this season
- Scott is the first ACC player with at least 33 pts and at least 14 rebs in a game since Florida State's Al Thornton (37 pts, 15 rebs) at Duke on Feb. 4, 2006
- Scott's 19 points in the first half were the most in a half by a Cavalier since Sylven Landesberg had 26 second half points vs. Boston College (Feb. 4, 2009) and the most in a first half since Sean Singletary had 23 first half points vs. Virginia Tech (Jan. 26, 2008)

SCOTT NAMED PRESEASON ALL-ACC

- Senior forward Mike Scott was one of six players named to the preseason All-ACC team at ACC Operation Basketball
- He is the first Cavalier selected as preseason All-ACC since Sean Singletary in 2007-08

SCOTT DOUBLING IT UP

- Mike Scott enters the game with 29 career double-doubles (T-3rd in UVa history)
- He has five double-doubles this season
- His 29 career double-doubles leads all active ACC players
- Scott has two "20-10" games this season (six in his career)

SCOTT LEADS THE ACC

• Mike Scott is the ACC active leader in points (1,187), rebounds (805) and doubledoubles (29)

SCOTT JOINS 1,000 POINT CLUB

- Mike Scott became the 43rd Cavalier to score 1,000 career points, reaching the milestone against TCU in the Virgin Islands
- He enters the game with 1,187 career points, 32nd in Virginia history

RETURN TO SENE-DER

- Assane Sene ranks seventh in school history with 107 career blocks
- He led the Cavaliers last season with 39 blocks

ZEGLINSKI FROM LONG RANGE

- Sammy Zeglinski enters the game with 170 career 3-pointers, which ranks sixth in school history
- He has made at least three 3-pointers in seven of 12 games this season, including four games with four 3-pointers
- Zeglinski is second in the ACC in 3-point percentage at 43.3%

EVANS SHINES AGAINST WINTHROP

- Jontel Evans scored a career-high 17 points against Winthrop
- He was 5-6 from the field, made a career-high two 3-pointers, and went 5-5 from the free throw line
- His previous career high was 11 points

ACC LEADERS

- Mike Scott leads the ACC in field goal percentage (.619)
- Scott ranks fourth in rebounding (9.0) and fifth in scoring (16.0)
- Scott is the only player to rank in the top five in the ACC in both scoring and rebounding
- Joe Harris ranks sixth in free throw percentage (.840) and T-13th in scoring (13.0)
- Sammy Zeglinski ranks second in 3-point percentage (.433) and second in steals (1.8)
- Jontel Evans ranks seventh in assists (3.4) and fifth in steals (1.7)

ON THE BOARDS

- Virginia is third in the ACC with a +6.9 rebounding margin
- The Cavaliers have outrebounded their opponent in 10 of 14 games this season, including seven games with a double-digit rebound advantage

CONSISTENT LINEUP

- Virginia has had the same starting lineup (Scott, Sene, Evans, Harris, Zeglinski) the past nine games and has used just two different starting lineups this season
- The last time Virginia used the same lineup in 10 consecutive games was in 2006-07
- If the Cavaliers use the same lineup tonight, it will mark the first time since 1993-94 that they have used just two lineups through the first 15 games of a season

ROAD WARRIORS

- Dating back to last season, Virginia has won five consecutive true road games
- It is the Cavaliers' longest road winning streak since winning five straight road games from the end of 1991-92 to the start of 1992-93
- Virginia won three non-conference road games in a season for the first time since 2000-01

COMEBACK CAVS

- Virginia rallied from halftime deficits to win at both Oregon and Seattle
- It marked the first time the Cavaliers won consecutive games when trailing at the half since 2009-10 (at NC State, vs. Georgia Tech)
- It marked the first time Virginia won consecutive games (both on the road) when trailing at the half since 1990-91 (at Minnesota, at Marquette)

AT JOHN PAUL JONES ARENA

- Virginia is 68-28 all-time at John Paul Jones Arena
- The Cavaliers went 11-6 at home last season
- Virginia is 8-0 at home this season
- UVa has won its last nine home games, the second-longest streak at JPJA
- This season the Cavaliers went undefeated at home in non-conference regularseason games for the first time since the 2004-05 season

CAVALIERS TOP MICHIGAN

- UVa's 70-58 win over No. 14 Michigan was its highest ranked win of the Bennett era
- It was the Cavaliers' first double-digit win over a top-15 opponent since a 72-58 win over No. 11 Boston College on Feb. 21, 2006 at University Hall

VIRGINIA PICKED FOURTH IN ACC

- Virginia was selected fourth in the preseason poll at ACC Operation Basketball
- It was the highest the Cavaliers were picked in the poll since 2001-02, when they were picked to finish third
- UVa has finished higher than its place in the preseason poll in each of the last three seasons
- North Carolina was the preseason favorite, followed by Duke, Florida State, Virginia, Miami, Virginia Tech, Clemson, NC State, Maryland, Georgia Tech, Wake Forest and Boston College

HARRELL AND JOHNSON DECIDE TO TRANSFER

- Sophomore guard KT Harrell (Dec. 23) and redshirt freshman forward James Johnson (Dec. 24) announced they were transferring
- Harrell appeared in 11 games (starting five) and averaged 4.7 ppg this season
- Johnson appeared in six games and averaged 1.5 ppg this season

FOUR SIGN WITH VIRGINIA

- UVa signed four players to National Letters of Intent for the 2012 recruiting class
- The four players are 6-6 wing Justin Anderson of Spotsylvania, Va.; 6-0 guard Teven Jones of Kannapolis, N.C.; 6-8 forward Evan Nolte of Alpharetta, Ga.; and 6-11 post player Mike Tobey of Monroe, N.Y.

McKAY PARTICIPATED IN "SHOTS FROM THE HEART"

- Associate Head Coach Ritchie McKay participated in "Shots from the Heart", a project designed to raise awareness for the growing problem of heart disease
- College basketball coaches are competing against one another in a free throw shooting tournament, which benefits the American Heart Association
- •The event also pays tribute to the late Skip Prosser who passed away on July 26, 2007 of a heart attack
- McKay defeated Ricky Yahn of Longwood in the first round of this year's tournament before falling to Adam Caporn of Saint Mary's in the round of 32
- Last year, McKay reached the quarterfinals of the assistant coach bracket in the inaugural event




