SERIES HISTORY

- Michigan leads series 2-1 (UVa leads 1-0 in Charlottesville)
- The last two meetings have come in postseason play
- Last meeting was a 102-65 Michigan win in the Elite Eight of the 1989 NCAA Tournament
- Only previous meeting in Charlottesville was a 79-68 UVa win in the 1980 NIT

BIGTEN/ACC CHALLENGE HISTORY

- Virginia has a 6-5 all-time record in the challenge (4-1 at home)
- Michigan is the third ranked opponent the Cavaliers have played in the challenge (lost 82-75 at #21 Michigan State in 2002-03, won 87-79 at #15 Minnesota last season)

AGAINST RANKED OPPONENTS

- Under Tony Bennett, the Cavaliers are 4-6 against teams ranked in the AP poll
- The Cavaliers are 2-1 against non-conference ranked opponents under Bennett
- Virginia is 3-3 at home against ranked opponents under Bennett
- Michigan is the highest ranked non-conference opponent to visit Charlottesville
- since No. 10 Arizona in the first game at John Paul Jones Arena (Nov. 12, 2006)

LAST TIME OUT

- Virginia defeated Green Bay 68-42 on Friday at John Paul Jones Arena
- The game marked the first time Tony Bennett coached against his alma mater
- Mike Scott had 15 pts and 10 rebs for his second double-double of the season

CAVALIERS GET DEFENSIVE

- Virginia is second in the nation in scoring defense at 45.3 ppg (as of 11/26)
 The Cavaliers have held each of their first six opponents under 60 points, the first
- time they have held six straight opponents under 60 points since 1948-49
- Virginia has held opponents under 20 points in a half four times this season, twice
- as many times than all last season (two) and most in a season since 1996-97 (four) • UVa held four of its first six opponents to under 50 points, a feat it has done 11 times in the Tony Bennett era

• Virginia held Drexel to 35 points, the second lowest scoring total by a UVa opponent in the shot clock era

• South Carolina State's 25.5% shooting (13-51) was the lowest percentage allowed by UVa since Liberty shot 22.6% percent (12-53) against UVa in the 2005-06 season opener

• Virginia has held two opponents under 30% shooting this season (only accomplished the feat twice in the previous three seasons combined)

• It is the first time UVa has held multiple opponents under 30% shooting in the same season since 2005-06 (three times)

FREE THROW PRODUCTION

Virginia leads the ACC and ranks ninth

nationally with a 78.5 free throw percentage

• UVa has scored 30.1 percent of its points this season from the free throw line

• The Cavaliers are going to the line 7.4 more

times a game this season and scoring 7.3

THEY CALL THEM FREE THROWS FOR A REASON

- UVa set a school record by going 19-for-19 from the free throw line against Winthrop
- The previous school record was 16-for-16 against South Carolina on Jan. 8, 1965
- It was the best free throw performance by an ACC team since Wake Forest shot
- an ACC-record 32-for-32 against North Carolina in 2005

VIRGINIA PICKED FOURTH IN ACC

- Virginia was selected fourth in the preseason poll at ACC Operation Basketball
- It was highest the Cavaliers were picked in the poll since 2001-02, when they were picked to finish third
- UVa has finished higher than its place in the preseason poll in each of the last three seasons

• North Carolina was the preseason favorite, followed by Duke, Florida State, Virginia, Miami, Virginia Tech, Clemson, NC State, Maryland, Georgia Tech, Wake Forest and Boston College

SCOTT NAMED PRESEASON ALL-ACC

• Senior forward Mike Scott was one of six players named to the preseason All-ACC team at ACC Operation Basketball

• He is the first Cavalier selected as preseason All-ACC since Sean Singletary in 2007-08

70 IS A MAGIC NUMBER

- Under Tony Bennett, Virginia is 19-2 when scoring at least 70 points
- The Cavaliers are 17-30 over the past three seasons when scoring under 70 points

HOOS BACK

- 10 players return from last season's team that went 16-15 (7-9 ACC)
- The Cavaliers return 69.0% of scoring and 79.4% of rebounding from last season

AT JOHN PAUL JONES ARENA

- Virginia is 63-28 all-time at John Paul Jones Arena
- The Cavaliers went 11-6 at home last season

CAVALIER DEBUTS

• Malcolm Brogdon and James Johnson, along with walk-ons Rob Vozenilek and Angus Mitchell made their collegiate debuts in the season opener vs. SC State

- Brogdon had nine points, four assists and two rebounds in his debut
 Johnson had six points (6-8 FT) and three rebounds in his debut
- SCOTT DOUBLING IT UP

Mike Scott enters the game with 26 career double-doubles (T-4th in UVa history)
He had six double-doubles in his 10 games last season before suffering a season-ending injury

- His 26 career double-doubles leads all active ACC players
- Scott had his first double-double of the season against Drexel (21 pts, 10 rebs)
- It was his fifth "20-10" game of his career (at least 20 points and 10 rebounds)

SCOTT LEADS THE ACC

• Mike Scott is the ACC active leader in points (1,052), rebounds (739) and double-doubles (26)

SCOTT JOINS 1,000 POINT CLUB

• Mike Scott became the 43rd Cavalier to score 1,000 career points, reaching the milestone against TCU in the Virgin Islands

• He enters the game with 1,052 career points, 40th in Virginia history

RETURN TO SENE-DER

Assane Sene ranks seventh in school history with 99 career blocks

• He led the Cavaliers last season with 39 blocks

ZEGLINSKI FROM LONG RANGE

• Sammy Zeglinski enters the game with 144 career 3-pointers, which ranks 10th in school history

EVANS SHINES AGAINST WINTHROP

Jontel Evans scored a career-high 17 points against Winthrop

• He was 5-6 from the field, made a career-high two 3-pointers, and went 5-5 from the free throw line

• His previous career high was 11 points

JESPERSON TO REDSHIRT

• Freshman guard Paul Jesperson is expected to redshirt this season

• Virginia head coach Tony Bennett indicated that after Virginia's game with South Carolina State on Nov. 13

FOUR SIGN WITH VIRGINIA

• UVa signed four players to National Letters of Intent for the 2012 recruiting class • The four players are 6-6 wing Justin Anderson of Spotsylvania, Va.; 6-0 guard Teven Jones of Kannapolis, N.C.; 6-8 forward Evan Nolte of Alpharetta, Ga.; and 6-11 post player Mike Tobey of Monroe, N.Y.

SAMPSON TO BE HONORED AT HALFTIME

- Virginia will recognize Ralph Sampson at halftime in honor of his 2011 induction into the National Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame
- Sampson was a three-time Naismith Award winner and remains the only player to win the Wooden Award consecutive years
- He had 2,228 points, 1,511 rebounds and 462 blocks during his Cavalier career (1980-83) before being the No. 1 overall pick in the 1983 NBA draft

ON THE AIR

• Virginia will have almost every game this season broadcast either on television or online

- All 16 ACC games and all 16 home games will be broadcast
- 13 games will be televised nationally by ESPN, ESPN2, ESPNU or FSN

McKAY PARTICIPATING IN "SHOTS FROM THE HEART"

Associate Head Coach Ritchie McKay is participating in "Shots from the Heart",

- a project designed to raise awareness for the growing problem of heart disease
- College basketball coaches are competing against one another in a free throw






