### **TONIGHT'S GAME**

- Virginia concludes its two-game trip as it plays Seattle
- The Cavaliers look to start a season 10-1 for the first time since 2000-01
- UVa seeks its first eight-game win streak since 2009-10

### **SERIES HISTORY**

- Seattle leads 1-0
- The only previous meeting was a 59-53 Redhawk win last season in Charlottesville

### **EMERALD CITY HISTORY**

- Virginia is making its second-ever trip to Seattle
- The Cavaliers played in the 1984 Final Four, falling 49-47 (ot) to Houston in a national semifinal at the Kingdome
- Tony Bennett's Washington State teams were 5-1 in Seattle, including a 3-0 record at KeyArena

### **WINNING STREAK**

- The Cavaliers enter the game on a seven-game winning streak, their longest since an eight-game winning streak in 2009-10
- Virginia has won five straight games by double digits, its longest streak since winning the first 10 games of the 2000-01 season by double digits
- Dating back to last season, UVa has won three consecutive true road games, its longest streak since 2006-07 (UVa hasn't won four straight true road games since 1994-95)

### **LAST TIME OUT**

- Virginia defeated Oregon 67-54 on Sunday in Eugene
- It was the Cavaliers' first true road game of the season
- Mike Scott led Virginia with 17 pts and 13 rebs (4th double-double this season)
- Joe Harris and Jontel Evans added 15 pts and 12 pts respectively

### 2011-12 Opponents in Bold

### SCOTT NAMED ACC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- Mike Scott was named ACC Player of the Week on Dec. 19 after having 17 pts and 13 rebs in the Cavaliers' 67-54 win at Oregon
- It was his second career honor (also honored once last season)

### **HOOS RANKED**

- Virginia entered the Associated Press Top 25 this week at No. 24
- It is the Cavaliers' first national ranking since Nov. 19, 2007 (at No. 23)

### **CAVALIERS GET DEFENSIVE**

- Virginia is second in the nation in scoring defense at 48.5 ppg (as of 12/20)
- UVa ranks second nationally in points allowed per possession (0.79) and 20th nationally in field goal percentage defense (37.2%)
- The Cavaliers have held each of their first 10 opponents under 60 points, their longest streak since 17 straight games from the end of the 1947-48 season (last eight games) to the start of the 1948-49 season (first nine games)
- UVa held five of its first 10 opponents to under 50 points, a feat it has done 12 times in the Tony Bennett era
- Virginia held Drexel to 35 points, the second lowest scoring total by a UVa opponent in the shot clock era
- South Carolina State's 25.5% shooting (13-51) was the lowest percentage allowed by UVa since Liberty shot 22.6% percent (12-53) against UVa in the 2005-06 season opener
- Virginia has held two opponents under 30% shooting this season (only accomplished the feat twice in the previous three seasons combined)
- It is the first time UVa has held multiple opponents under 30% shooting in the same season since 2005-06 (three times)
- Eight of 10 Cavalier opponents this season have scored their season-low against Virginia

### **OPPONENTS UNDER 60**

- Virginia has held all 10 opponents this season to under 60 points
- It is the third longest streak in ACC history (the longest in the shot clock era)
- Virginia and Wyoming are the only
- schools in the nation to hold every opponent this season under 60 points
- It is the longest streak by a Tony Bennett coached squad and the longest Division I streak by a Bennett coached men's team (his father, Dick, had a nine-game streak in 1994-95 at Green Bay)

### ONE AND DONE...

- Virginia leads the nation in defensive rebounding percentage at 79.1%
- The Cavaliers have allowed points on just 39.6 percent of their opponents' possessions this season (leads the nation)
- Opponents are averaging 5.8 second chance points a game this season
- UVa has held five of 10 opponents to five second chance points or fewer

### FREE THROW PRODUCTION

- Virginia leads the ACC and ranks 27th nationally with a 74.8 free throw percentage
- UVa has scored 25.8 percent of its points this season from the free throw line
- The Cavaliers are going to the line 6.4 more times a game this season and scoring 5.7 more points from the line per game this season

### THEY CALL THEM FREE THROWS FOR A REASON

- UVa set a school record by going 19-for-19 from the free throw line against Winthrop
- The previous school record was 16-for-16 against South Carolina on Jan. 8, 1965
- It was the best free throw performance by an ACC team since Wake Forest shot an ACC-record 32-for-32 against North Carolina in 2005

### **70 IS A MAGIC NUMBER**

- Under Tony Bennett, Virginia is 21-2 when scoring at least 70 points
- The Cavaliers are 19-30 over the past three seasons when scoring under 70 points

### **BALANCED MINUTES**

- Virginia has eight players averaging over 17 minutes per game, but none averaging 30 minutes per game
- UVa is the only ACC team without a player averaging at least 30 minutes/game

### SCOTT NAMED PRESEASON ALL-ACC

- Senior forward Mike Scott was one of six players named to the preseason All-ACC team at ACC Operation Basketball
- He is the first Cavalier selected as preseason All-ACC since Sean Singletary in 2007-08

### **SCOTT DOUBLING IT UP**

- Mike Scott enters the game with 28 career double-doubles (4th in UVa history)
- He had six double-doubles in his 10 games last season before suffering a season-ending injury
- His 28 career double-doubles leads all active ACC players
- Scott had his first double-double of the season against Drexel (21 pts, 10 rebs)
- It was his fifth "20-10" game of his career (at least 20 points and 10 rebounds)

### **SCOTT LEADS THE ACC**

• Mike Scott is the ACC active leader in points (1,118), rebounds (774) and doubledoubles (28)

### **SCOTT JOINS 1,000 POINT CLUB**

- Mike Scott became the 43rd Cavalier to score 1,000 career points, reaching the milestone against TCU in the Virgin Islands
- He enters the game with 1,118 career points, 38th in Virginia history

### **RETURN TO SENE-DER**

- Assane Sene ranks seventh in school history with 104 career blocks
- He led the Cavaliers last season with 39 blocks

### **ZEGLINSKI FROM LONG RANGE**

• Sammy Zeglinski enters the game with 158 career 3-pointers, which ranks T-7th in school history

### **EVANS SHINES AGAINST WINTHROP**

- Jontel Evans scored a career-high 17 points against Winthrop
- He was 5-6 from the field, made a career-high two 3-pointers, and went 5-5 from the free throw line
- His previous career high was 11 points

### JESPERSON TO REDSHIRT

- Freshman guard Paul Jesperson is expected to redshirt this season
- Virginia head coach Tony Bennett indicated that after Virginia's game with South Carolina State on Nov. 13

### **ACC LEADERS**

- Mike Scott is second the ACC in field goal percentage (.595)
- Scott ranks third in rebounding (9.5) and seventh in scoring (15.5)
- Joe Harris ranks T-second in free throw percentage (.909) and 14th in scoring (12.7)
- Sammy Zeglinski ranks fourth in 3-point percentage (.405) and third in steals (1.9)
- Jontel Evans ranks seventh in assists (3.2) and eighth in steals (1.4)

### **CAVALIER DEBUTS**

- Malcolm Brogdon and James Johnson, along with walk-ons Rob Vozenilek and Angus Mitchell, made their collegiate debuts in the season opener vs. SC State
- Brogdon had nine points, four assists and two rebounds in his debut
- Johnson had six points (6-8 FT) and three rebounds in his debut

### **'HOOS BACK**

- 10 players return from last season's team that went 16-15 (7-9 ACC)
- The Cavaliers return 69.0% of scoring and 79.4% of rebounding from last season

### **EXPERIENCE COUNTS**

- Virginia opened the season with the roster having 256 career starts, which is the most among ACC schools
- The Cavaliers had seven players who made a start in their career prior to this season (Mike Scott-74, Sammy Zeglinski-55, Assane Sene-48, Jontel Evans-38, Joe Harris-25, KT Harrell-15, Akil Mitchell-1)

### AT JOHN PAUL JONES ARENA

- Virginia is 66-28 all-time at John Paul Jones Arena
- The Cavaliers went 11-6 at home last season
- Virginia is 6-0 at home this season

### **CAVALIERS TOP MICHIGAN**

- UVa's 70-58 win over No. 14 Michigan was its highest ranked win of the Bennett era
- It was the Cavaliers' first double-digit win over a top-15 opponent since a 72-58 win over No. 11 Boston College on Feb. 21, 2006 at University Hall

### **VIRGINIA PICKED FOURTH IN ACC**

- Virginia was selected fourth in the preseason poll at ACC Operation Basketball
- It was the highest the Cavaliers were picked in the poll since 2001-02, when they were picked to finish third
- UVa has finished higher than its place in the preseason poll in each of the last three seasons
- North Carolina was the preseason favorite, followed by Duke, Florida State, Virginia, Miami, Virginia Tech, Clemson, NC State, Maryland, Georgia Tech, Wake Forest and Boston College

### **FOUR SIGN WITH VIRGINIA**

- UVa signed four players to National Letters of Intent for the 2012 recruiting class
- The four players are 6-6 wing Justin Anderson of Spotsylvania, Va.; 6-0 guard Teven Jones of Kannapolis, N.C.; 6-8 forward Evan Nolte of Alpharetta, Ga.; and 6-11 post player Mike Tobey of Monroe, N.Y.



### ON THE AIR

- Virginia will have almost every game this season broadcast either on television or online
- All 16 ACC games and all 16 home games will be broadcast
- 13 games will be televised nationally by ESPN, ESPN2, ESPNU or FSN

### McKAY PARTICIPATING IN "SHOTS FROM THE HEART"

- Associate Head Coach Ritchie McKay is participating in "Shots from the Heart", a project designed to raise awareness for the growing problem of heart disease
- College basketball coaches are competing against one another in a free throw shooting tournament, which benefits the American Heart Association
- •The event also pays tribute to the late Skip Prosser who passed away on July 26, 2007 of a heart attack
- Last year, McKay reached the quarterfinals of the assistant coach bracket in the inaugural event
- McKay defeated Ricky Yahn of Longwood in the first round of this year's tournament and will play Adam Caporn of St. Mary's in the round of 32

### **UP NEXT**

- Virginia returns home to host Maryland-Eastern Shore on Dec. 27
- Game time at John Paul Jones Arena is 7 p.m., and the game will be broadcast online by the ACC Digital Network




