### **TONIGHT'S GAME**

- Virginia concludes its home non-conference schedule as it hosts Towson
- The Cavaliers look to start a season 12-1 for the first time since 1982-83
- UVa seeks its first 10-game win streak since 2000-01

### **SERIES HISTORY**

- Virginia leads 4-0 (4-0 in Charlottesville)
- The last meeting was a 94-66 Cavalier win at University Hall in 1994-95

#### **WINNING STREAKS**

- The Cavaliers enter the game on a nine-game winning streak, their longest since the 2001-02 season
- Virginia hasn't won 10 consecutive games since the 2000-01 season
- Dating back to last season, UVa has won eight consecutive home games, the second-longest win streak at John Paul Jones Arena

### **STRONG START TO THE SEASON**

- The Cavaliers are looking for their 12th non-conference regular-season win this season, a feat they haven't accomplished since winning 14 non-conference regular season games in 1990-91
- A win tonight would give Virginia 20 wins in the 2011 calendar year, the first time since 2007 the Cavaliers won at least 20 games in a calendar year (23 wins)

### **LAST TIME OUT**

- Virginia defeated Maryland-Eastern Shore 69-42 on Tuesday at JPJA
- Mike Scott led Virginia with 17 points
- Darion Atkins and Joe Harris added 13 and 10 points respectively
- The Cavaliers broke the game open with a 26-6 run early in the second half

### SCOTT REPEATS AS ACC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- Mike Scott was named ACC Player of the Week on Dec. 26 after having 33 pts and 14 rebs in the Cavaliers' 83-77 win at Seattle
- He was also honored on Dec. 19 and becomes the first Cavalier to win the award in consecutive weeks since Sean Singletary in January 2007

### **HOOS RANKED**

- Virginia is ranked No. 23 in this week's Associated Press Top 25
- This week marks the first time Virginia has been in the AP poll in consecutive weeks since December 2004
- UVa entered the ESPN/USA Today Coaches Poll this week at No. 24
- It is the first time Virginia has been ranked in both polls since February 19, 2007

#### **AGAINST THE CAA**

- Tonight's game is the third of three games this season for UVa against the CAA
- UVa downed Drexel 49-35 in the Paradise Jam on Nov. 19 and defeated George Mason 68-48 at JPJA on Dec. 6
- The Cavaliers have won 22 consecutive games against CAA opponents, dating back to a 76-69 loss at Old Dominion in 1993-94
- Virginia has a 108-34 all-time record against current members of the CAA (10-1 vs. Delaware, 2-0 vs. Drexel, 7-0 vs. George Mason, 1-2 vs. Hofstra, 8-0 vs. James Madison, 3-0 vs. UNCW, 1-0 vs. Northeastern, 9-4 vs. Old Dominion, 4-0 vs. Towson, 10-1 vs. VCU, 53-26 vs. William & Mary)
- Virginia is 5-0 vs. the CAA at JPJA (def. Drexel and Old Dominion in 2007-08, def. UNCW in 2009-10, def. William & Mary in 2010-11, def. George Mason this season)

### **CAVALIERS GET DEFENSIVE**

- Virginia is second in the nation in scoring defense at 50.3 ppg (as of 12/28)
- UVa ranks third nationally in points allowed per possession (0.81) and 15th nationally in field goal percentage defense (37.3%)
- The Cavaliers held each of their first 10 opponents under 60 points, their longest streak since 17 straight games from the end of the 1947-48 season (last eight games) to the start of the 1948-49 season (first nine games)
- It is the third-longest streak in ACC history (longest in the shot clock era)
- UVa has held six opponents to under 50 points, a feat it has done 13 times in the Tony Bennett era
- Virginia held Drexel to 35 points, the second lowest scoring total by a UVa opponent in the shot clock era
- $\bullet$  South Carolina State's 25.5% shooting (13-51) was the lowest percentage allowed by UVa since Liberty shot 22.6% (12-53) against UVa in the 2005-06 season opener
- Virginia has held three opponents under 30% shooting this season (only accomplished the feat twice in the previous three seasons combined)
- It is the first time UVa has held multiple opponents under 30% shooting in the same season since 2005-06 (three times)

### **ONE AND DONE...**

- Virginia ranks third nationally in defensive rebounding percentage at 77.0%
- The Cavaliers have allowed points on just 41.1 percent of their opponents' possessions this season (third nationally)
- $\bullet \ \, \text{Opponents are averaging 6.7 second chance points a game this season}$
- UVa has held 10 of 12 opponents to single digit second chance points

### **70 IS A MAGIC NUMBER**

- Under Tony Bennett, Virginia is 22-2 when scoring at least 70 points
- The Cavaliers are 20-30 over the past three seasons when scoring under 70 points



### THEY CALL THEM FREE THROWS FOR A REASON

- UVa set a school record by going 19-for-19 from the free throw line against Winthrop
- The previous school record was 16-for-16 against South Carolina on Jan. 8, 1965
- It was the best free throw performance by an ACC team since Wake Forest shot an ACC-record 32-for-32 against North Carolina in 2005

### MIKE SCOTT DOMINATES IN SEATTLE

- Mike Scott had a career-high 33 points (12-14 FG), along with 14 rebounds, in Virginia's 83-77 win at Seattle University on Dec. 21
- Scott's 33 points were the most by a Cavalier since Sean Singletary scored 41 points at Miami on Mar. 1, 2008
- Scott's 33 points are the most by an ACC player this season
- Scott is the first ACC player with at least 33 pts and at least 14 rebs in a game since Florida State's Al Thornton (37 pts, 15 rebs) at Duke on Feb. 4, 2006
- Scott's 19 points in the first half were the most in a half by a Cavalier since Sylven Landesberg had 26 second half points vs. Boston College (Feb. 4, 2009) and the most in a first half since Sean Singletary had 23 first half points vs. Virginia Tech (Jan. 26, 2008)

#### SCOTT NAMED PRESEASON ALL-ACC

- Senior forward Mike Scott was one of six players named to the preseason All-ACC team at ACC Operation Basketball
- He is the first Cavalier selected as preseason All-ACC since Sean Singletary in 2007-08

### **SCOTT DOUBLING IT UP**

- Mike Scott enters the game with 29 career double-doubles (T-3rd in UVa history)
- He has five double-doubles this season
- His 29 career double-doubles leads all active ACC players
- Scott has two "20-10" games this season (six in his career)

### **SCOTT LEADS THE ACC**

• Mike Scott is the ACC active leader in points (1,168), rebounds (794) and doubledoubles (29)

### **SCOTT JOINS 1,000 POINT CLUB**

- Mike Scott became the 43rd Cavalier to score 1,000 career points, reaching the milestone against TCU in the Virgin Islands
- He enters the game with 1,168 career points, 34th in Virginia history

#### **RETURN TO SENE-DER**

- Assane Sene ranks seventh in school history with 106 career blocks
- He led the Cavaliers last season with 39 blocks

### **ZEGLINSKI FROM LONG RANGE**

• Sammy Zeglinski enters the game with 162 career 3-pointers, which ranks sixth in school history

### **EVANS SHINES AGAINST WINTHROP**

- Jontel Evans scored a career-high 17 points against Winthrop
- He was 5-6 from the field, made a career-high two 3-pointers, and went 5-5 from the free throw line
- His previous career high was 11 points

### **ACC LEADERS**

- Mike Scott is second in the ACC in field goal percentage (.636)
- Scott ranks third in rebounding (9.6) and fourth in scoring (17.1)
- Joe Harris ranks third in free throw percentage (.897) and T-15th in scoring (12.6)
- Sammy Zeglinski ranks fourth in 3-point percentage (.404), 4th in steals (1.7) and T-10th in assists (3.0)
- Jontel Evans ranks eighth in assists (3.2) and sixth in steals (1.7)

### **SHARP-SHOOTING HOOS**

- Virginia is second in the ACC and 29th nationally with a 48.3 field goal percentage
- •The Cavaliers have shot 50 percent or better in six of the last eight games
- The Cavaliers' six games of shooting 50 percent or better from the field already ties their total from the entire 2010-11 season

### **ON THE BOARDS**

- Virginia is third in the ACC with a +7.2 rebounding margin
- The Cavaliers have outrebounded their opponent in 8 of 12 games this season, including seven games with a double-digit rebound advantage

### **COMEBACK CAVS**

- Virginia rallied from halftime deficits to win at both Oregon and Seattle
- It marked the first time the Cavaliers won consecutive games when trailing at the half since 2009-10 (at NC State, vs. Georgia Tech)
- It marked the first time Virginia won consecutive games (both on the road) when trailing at the half since 1990-91 (at Minnesota, at Marquette)

### AT JOHN PAUL JONES ARENA

- Virginia is 67-28 all-time at John Paul Jones Arena
- The Cavaliers went 11-6 at home last season
- Virginia is 7-0 at home this season
- With a win tonight, Virginia will go undefeated at home in non-conference regular-season games for the first time since the 2004-05 season

### **ROAD WARRIORS**

- Dating back to last season, Virginia has won four consecutive true road games
- It is the Cavaliers' longest road winning streak since winning four straight road games during the 1994-95 season
- When Virginia plays at LSU on Jan. 2, it will look for its first five-game road win streak since a five game streak from the end of 1991-92 to the start of 1992-93

### **CAVALIERS TOP MICHIGAN**

- UVa's 70-58 win over No. 14 Michigan was its highest ranked win of the Bennett era
- It was the Cavaliers' first double-digit win over a top-15 opponent since a 72-58 win over No. 11 Boston College on Feb. 21, 2006 at University Hall

### **VIRGINIA PICKED FOURTH IN ACC**

- Virginia was selected fourth in the preseason poll at ACC Operation Basketball
- It was the highest the Cavaliers were picked in the poll since 2001-02, when they were picked to finish third
- UVa has finished higher than its place in the preseason poll in each of the last three seasons
- North Carolina was the preseason favorite, followed by Duke, Florida State, Virginia, Miami, Virginia Tech, Clemson, NC State, Maryland, Georgia Tech, Wake Forest and Boston College



### HARRELL AND JOHNSON DECIDE TO TRANSFER

- Sophomore guard KT Harrell (Dec. 23) and redshirt freshman forward James Johnson (Dec. 24) announced they were transferring
- Harrell appeared in 11 games (starting five) and averaged 4.7 ppg this season
- Johnson appeared in six games and averaged 1.5 ppg this season

### **FOUR SIGN WITH VIRGINIA**

- UVa signed four players to National Letters of Intent for the 2012 recruiting class
- The four players are 6-6 wing Justin Anderson of Spotsylvania, Va.; 6-0 guard Teven Jones of Kannapolis, N.C.; 6-8 forward Evan Nolte of Alpharetta, Ga.; and 6-11 post player Mike Tobey of Monroe, N.Y.

### McKAY PARTICIPATING IN "SHOTS FROM THE HEART"

- Associate Head Coach Ritchie McKay is participating in "Shots from the Heart", a project designed to raise awareness for the growing problem of heart disease
- College basketball coaches are competing against one another in a free throw shooting tournament, which benefits the American Heart Association
- The event also pays tribute to the late Skip Prosser who passed away on July 26, 2007 of a heart attack
- Last year, McKay reached the quarterfinals of the assistant coach bracket in the inaugural event
- McKay defeated Ricky Yahn of Longwood in the first round of this year's tournament and will play Adam Caporn of St. Mary's in the round of 32

### **UP NEXT**

- Virginia concludes its non-conference schedule on Jan. 2 as it visits LSU
- Game time at Pete Maravich Assembly Center in Baton Rouge is 7 p.m. ET (6 p.m. CT), and the game will be televised by CSS


