#### **FOR OPENERS**

• UVa hosts Fairfield in its home opener as part of the NIT Season Tip-Off.

• UVa is 3-0 in home openers under head coach Tony Bennett and has won 15 consectutive home opening games overall.

- Virginia's last home-opening loss was a 62-52 decision to then-No. 25 Clemson on Dec. 7, 1996.
- The winner of tonight's game will play either Penn or Delaware on Tuesday, Nov. 13.

#### LAST TIME OUT

- Virginia's 14-game season-opening winning streak was snapped after a 63-59 loss at George Mason on Nov. 9.
- The Cavaliers started three freshmen (Justin Anderson, Taylor Barnette and Mike Tobey) in the season-opening game for the first time in school history.
- Joe Harris led UVa with 19 points and eight rebounds, and Akil Mitchell added a career-best 11 points and seven rebounds.
- UVa allowed George Mason to shoot 54.5 percent from the floor, including 7-for-14 (50%) from three-point range.

#### **SERIES HISTORY**

- UVa sports a 2-0 career mark against Fairfield.
- The teams are meeting for the first time since Feb. 13, 1991, where UVa won 84-52 in Charlottesville.
- UVa also beat Fairfield, 107-66, on Nov. 27, 1981.

#### AGAINST THE MAAC

• Fairfield is the lone Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference opponent on Virginia's 2012-13 schedule.

• UVa is 14-0 all-time against current MAAC members (1-0 vs. Canisius, 2-0 vs. Fairfield, 1-0 vs. Iona, 7-0 vs. Loyola, 1-0 vs. Manhattan, 1-0 vs. Rider and 1-0 vs. Siena.)

## 2012-13 MEN'S BASKETBALL GAME NOTES

#### THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- Virginia posted a 13-3 record last season at John Paul Jones Arena last season and are 35-15 at home under Tony Bennett .
- The Cavaliers are 72-31 all-time at JPJ Arena.

#### ABOUT THE NIT SEASON TIP-OFF

• Virginia is one of four teams to host a pair of games during the preliminary rounds of the NIT Season Tipoff.

• The team that posts two wins at each of the four sites will advance to the semifinals at Madison Square Garden in New York City on Nov. 21.

• Virginia will host the consolation rounds on Nov. 19-20 if they lose either game on Nov. 12-13.

#### HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Head coach Tony Bennett has posted a 53-42 mark in four seasons at UVa.
- Bennett has a 122-75 record, including a 69-33 record at Washington State, in seven seasons of collegiate coaching.
- Bennett guided the Cavaliers to their first NCAA Tournament since 2007 last season, and UVa's 22 wins were the most since 25 in 1994-95.
- UVa's nine ACC wins in 2011-12 were its most since 11 in 2006-07.
- Bennett is one of 18 Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.

#### EVANS AND BROGDON MISS GEORGE MASON GAME

• Senior guard Jontel Evans, an ACC All-Defensive Team member last season, and Malcolm Brogdon missed the season opener with injuries.

• Evans tallied 7.3 points and 3.9 assists per game last season, while Brogdon averaged 6.7 points and 2.8 rebounds per game.

#### FRESHMEN GAIN EXPERIENCE IN SEASON OPENER

- Four Virginia freshmen played and scored in the season opener.
- Evan Nolte (6 points), Taylor Barnette (5 points), Mike Tobey (5 points) and Justin Anderson (3 points) each saw more than 17 minutes of action.
- Barnette handled the point-guard duties well in his debut and committed just one turnover in 27 minutes of action.

#### **NOTE WORTHY**

• Virgina enjoyed a 32-26 rebounding advantage in the opener, including 11 offensive rebounds.

- Harris led the team in scoring for the 13th time and scored in double figures for the 38th time in 64 career games at Virginia.
- Harris also led UVa in rebounding for the 11th time in his career.

#### LONG RANGE BOMBERS

• Virginia drilled eight three-pointers in the season opener. Joe Harris (4), Evan Nolte (2), Mike Tobey (1) and Taylor Barnette (1) each connected from long range.

#### VIRGINIA PICKED 7TH IN THE ACC

• Virginia was selected seventh in the preseason poll at ACC Operation Basketball.

• The Cavaliers, who were picked fourth and finished fourth last season, have finished at or higher than their predicted finish in each of the last four seasons.

 NC State is the preseason favorite, followed by Duke, North Carolina, Florida State, Miami, Maryland, Virginia, Clemson, Georgia Tech, Virginia Tech, Wake Forest and Boston College.



#### ABOUT THE 2012-13 SCHEDULE

• Five of Virginia's opponents are ranked in the preseason polls (NC State, Duke, North Carolina, Wisconsin and Florida State), while another two are receiving votes (Tennessee and Miami, Fla.).

• Six opponents earned 2012 NCAA Tournament berths, while three participated in the College Basketball Invitational and two in the National Invitation Tournament.

#### **EUROPEAN TOUR RECAP**

• The Cavaliers posted a 2-3 mark during their five-game European Tour this past August.

• UVa competed against teams from the Netherlands, Belgium and France.
Joe Harris led Virginia in scoring in Europe, averaging 15.6 points per game, while
Akil Mitchell averaged 13.4 ppg, Mike Tobey 11.2 ppg and Jontel Evans 9.6 ppg.
• Evans averaged 7.8 assists per games, while Mitchell was UVa's top rebounder, pulling down 50 boards in the five games.

#### SCOTT WILL BE MISSED

• UVa will miss the 2011-12 third-team All-American Mike Scott, who is now a member of the NBA's Atlanta Hawks.

• Scott, who led Virginia in scoring and rebounding last season, was the first Cavalier to earn All-America honors since Ralph Sampson in 1983.

• Scott totaled 1,538 points and 944 rebounds in 130 career games at UVa.

#### 70 IS A MAGIC NUMBER

• Under Tony Bennett, Virginia is 25-2 when scoring at least 70 points.

• The Cavaliers are 28-40 over the past four seasons when scoring under 70 points.

#### 60 IS THE NEW 70

• Last season, Virginia was 18-2 when scoring at least 60 points.

• The Cavaliers are 1-0 when scoring under 60 points and were 4-8 last season when scoring under 60 points.

#### **ON THE AIR THIS SEASON**

• All of Virginia's games this season will be broadcast either on television or online this season. The only games that may not be broadcast are the NIT Season Tip-Off consolation games.

• All games will be broadcast on the Virginia Sports Radio Network with David Koehn (play-by-play) and Ted Jeffries (analyst) calling the action.

#### HOLDING FOES UNDER 50

• Last season, Virginia held 11 opponents under 50 points, the most by an ACC team in the shot clock era.

• The 11 games of holding opponents under 50 points were the most for the Cavaliers in a season since holding 16 opponents under 50 points in 1945-46. • Virginia has accomplished the feat 18 times in the Tony Bennett era.

• The Cavaliers held three consecutive ACC opponents under 50 points (Georgia Tech, Virginia Tech, Boston College), marking the first time in the shot clock era (second overall) an ACC team has held three consecutive conference opponents under 50 points (UNC accomplished the feat in the '82 ACC Tournament).

#### **RECORDS WATCH**

• Jontel Evans needs 25 assists and 25 steals to rank 10th on the UVa career lists. Joe Harris needs 41 three-pointers to rank 10th on the all-time career list.

#### **ON THE HORIZON**

Virginia hosts Seattle in nonconference action on Saturday, Nov. 17.

#### PHOTO CREDENTIALS

All photographers and camera operators must wear a visible credential issued by the Virginia athletics media relations office. Photographers work from the baselines at both ends of the court at John Paul Jones Arena. Live television is given top priority for courtside space.

#### PRESS PARKING

Press parking passes are provided upon request on a limited basis. If you need a parking pass, please be sure to inform the UVa athletics media relations office when making your press or photo credential request.

#### INTERVIEWS

All requests for interviews with Virginia basketball coaches and players should be made through Erich Bacher in the athletics media relations office. It is requested you allow the athletics media relations staff at least one day, preferably longer, to arrange an interview.

#### **POSTGAME INTERVIEWS**

Virginia head coach Tony Bennett and the visiting head coach will meet with media representatives in the press room after each game at John Paul Jones Arena. The first coach will be available in the press room approximately 10 minutes after the conclusion of the game and the second coach will be in the press room approximately 20 minutes after the game. Virginia players will be available in the team meeting room adjacent to the men's basketball locker room after home games.

#### RADIO

Each visiting school is allowed one free radio broadcast from John Paul Jones Arena. The Virginia athletics media relations office provides two ISDN lines and three business touchtone lines for use by the visiting broadcast crew. Radio network crews work from a courtside location at the scorer's table. Three seats are available at the table and one seat behind the visitor's broadcast location.

#### GAME SERVICES

Information packets are available before each game at John Paul Jones Arena, and a full statistical summary and play-by-play sheets are distributed at halftime and after the game. Quotes from both coaches and two or three players from each team will be available at the conclusion of the game. A pregame meal is served for working members of the media in the press room on the event level of John Paul Jones Arena.


