FOR OPENERS

- Virginia and North Texas meet for the first time.
- Virginia is playing its sixth game in 12 days.
- The Cavs have held their last two opponents under 50 points and are 20-1 in the Tony Bennett era when holding the opposition under 50.

LAST TIME OUT

- Virginia beat Lamar, 63-44, last night at John Paul Jones Arena.
- Junior guard Joe Harris led the Cavaliers with 17 points and has led the team in scoring in four of five games.
- Akil Mitchell reached double figures in scoring for a career-best fifth consecutive game.
- Mitchell also led the team in rebounding for the fourth consecutive game.
- Teven Jones had six points, two rebounds, one block and one steal in his first collegiate start.
- Jones also became the fifth UVa freshman to start this season.

AGAINST THE SUN BELT CONFERENCE

- Virginia is 4-1 all-time vs. teams in the Sun Belt Conference (1-0 vs. Arkansas State, 1-0 vs. Louisiana-Monroe, 1-0 vs. Middle Tennessee and 1-1 vs. Western Kentucky).

HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Head coach Tony Bennett has posted a 56-43 mark in four seasons at UVa.
- Bennett is 35-16 vs. nonconference opponents at Virginia.

PLAYER NOTES

- Paul Jespersion tallied a career-high nine points and tied a career-high with five rebounds last night.
- Joe Harris is averaging a career-high 15.6 points and five rebounds per game.
- Harris shooting a career-high 47.8 percent (11-23) from three-point range.
- Akil Mitchell is averaging a career-high 12.4 points and 10.4 rebounds per game.
- Harris and Mitchell are the only Cavaliers to start all five games this season.
- Evan Nolte is averaging two steals per game.

TEAM NOTES

- UVa has tallied 31 points off turnovers in each of its last two games.
- Virginia has led at halftime in its last two games after trailing at the half in its first three games.
- The Cavaliers have held their opponents under 20 points in the first half in each of the last two games.
